There are four (3) possible file transfer options based on your **laptop** and **preference**:

- Option #1: Windows
 - o File Explorer
- Option #2: Windows
 - FileZilla FTP software
- Option #3: Mac
 - FileZilla FTP software

Please note that the FileZilla FTP should use the "Plain FTP"

encryption and not SFTP or TLS.

Option #1: Windows - File Explorer

These steps will apply to *Windows versions 7 and up.*


Step 1:

- Right-click on the Start button and select "Open Windows Explorer".
- On recent versions of Windows it will be called "File Explorer".




Step 2:

In the address/path bar, type - "ftp://ftps.computer.org" and press the "Enter" key.



Step 3:

- Your User name will be provided by the IEEE Computer Society, along with the password.
- Enter your User name and Password and click on the "Log On" button.



You should now see your conference folder, with any content that might already exist within.

You can drag and drop, or copy/paste into your FTP account at this point.

Option #2: Windows - FileZilla

We will use the FileZilla FTP client for these instructions, but any Windows FTP client should work.

If you already have the FileZilla client installed, you can go to Step #3.

Step 1: Download the FileZilla application if you don't already have it.
