

CNN October 07, 2020 Debate Reaction Poll (Poll 13)
The study was conducted for CNN via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted on October 07, 2020 among a sample of 609 registered voters who watched the vice-presidential debate. The margin of sampling error for total respondents is $+/-5.3$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The design effect is 1.80 .

Survey respondents were first interviewed as part of a random national sample conducted October 01 to October 04, 2020 for CNN. Respondents were also recruited September 30-October 01, 2020 via the SSRS Opinion Panel, a nationally representative panel of U.S. adults age 18 or older. In those interviews, respondents indicated they planned to watch the debate and were willing to be re-interviewed after the debate. Unless otherwise noted, results beginning with the March 31-April 2, 2006 survey and ending with the April 22-25, 2017 survey are from surveys conducted by ORC International. Results before March 31, 2006 are from surveys conducted by Gallup.

Question text noted in parentheses was rotated or randomized. Values less than 0.5 percent are indicated by an asterisk (*).

Members of demographic groups not shown in the published crosstabs are represented in the results for each question in the poll. Crosstabs on the pages that follow only include results for subgroups with a minimum $\mathrm{N}=125$ unweighted cases. Results for subgroups with fewer than $\mathrm{N}=125$ unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "SN" because samples of that size carry larger margins of sampling error and can be too small to be projectable with confidence to their true values in the population.

## MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of $\mathbf{6 0 9}$ adults were interviewed by telephone nationwide by live interviewers calling both landline and cell phones. Interviews were conducted in English and Spanish. Interviews were conducted October 07, 2020. Among the entire sample, 38\% described themselves as Democrats, 29\% described themselves as Republicans, and 33\% described themselves as independents or members of another party.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $+/-5.3$ percentage points.
