

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in San Joaquin County was 11.4 percent in September 2020, unchanged from a revised 11.4 percent in August 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 10.8 percent for California and 7.7 percent for the nation during the same period.
