<b>Property Description</b>	This edifice is a small Baroque church, rectangular in plan with a small dome, which was heavily damaged in WWII, but has now been faithfully reconstructed in most of its parts and details. The church has a small underlying crypt with altar and floor burials. The latter was heavily vandalized and is now under restoration.

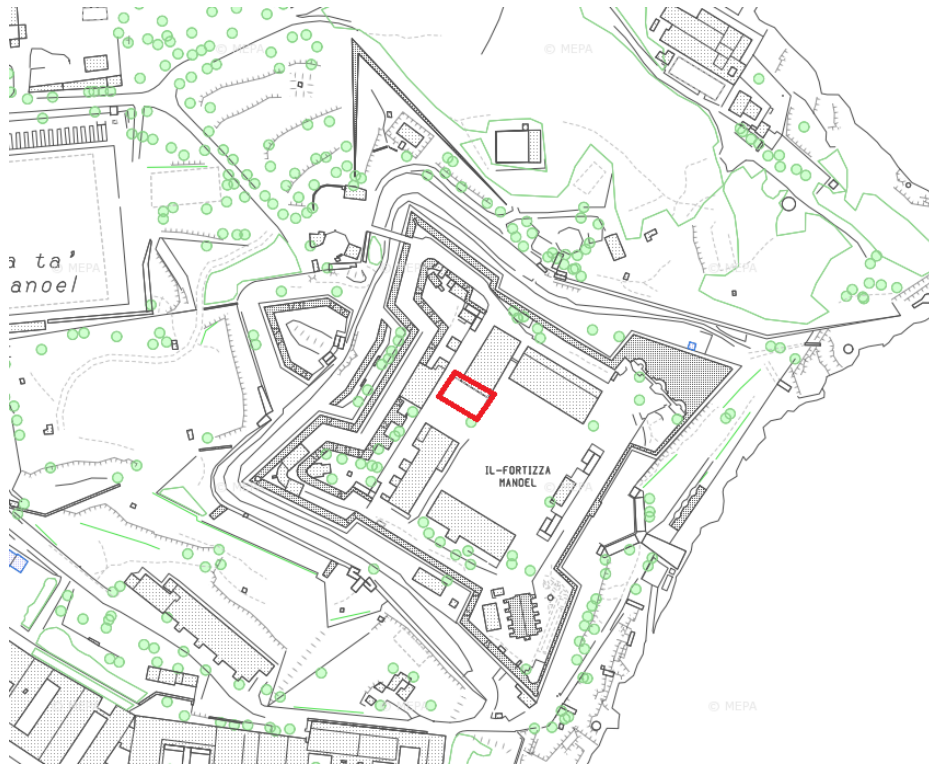
