

## OVERVIEW

The study was conducted for CNN via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from October 23 to October 30, 2020 among a sample of $\mathbf{1 , 0 0 6}$ respondents who live in Wisconsin. The landline total respondents were 350 and there were 656 cell phone respondents. The margin of sampling error for total respondents is $+/-3.7$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The design effect is 1.40 . For results among the 920 registered voters, the margin of sampling error is $+/-3.8$ and for results among the 873 likely voters, it is $+/-3.9$. ## NOTE ABOUT CROSSTABS

Interviews were conducted among a representative sample of the adult population, age 18 or older, of Wisconsin. Crosstabs on the pages that follow only include results for subgroups with a minimum $n=125$ unweighted cases. Results for subgroups with fewer than $\mathrm{n}=125$ unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "SN" because samples of that size carry larger margins of sampling error and can be too small to be projectable with confidence to their true values in the population.

## MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of 1,006 adults who live in Wisconsin were interviewed by telephone by live interviewers calling both landline and cell phones. Interviews were conducted in English and Spanish. Among the entire sample, 27\% described themselves as Democrats, $29 \%$ described themselves as Republicans, and $44 \%$ described themselves as independents or members of another party.

All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect Census figures for gender, race, age, education, state region, and telephone usage.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $+/-3.7$ percentage points. For the subset of 920 registered voters, it is +/- 3.8 percentage points. For the sample of 873 likely voters, it is $+/-3.9$ percentage points.
