# **INTERNATIONAL MERCHANDISE TRADE STATISTICS**

(Second Quarter 2019)

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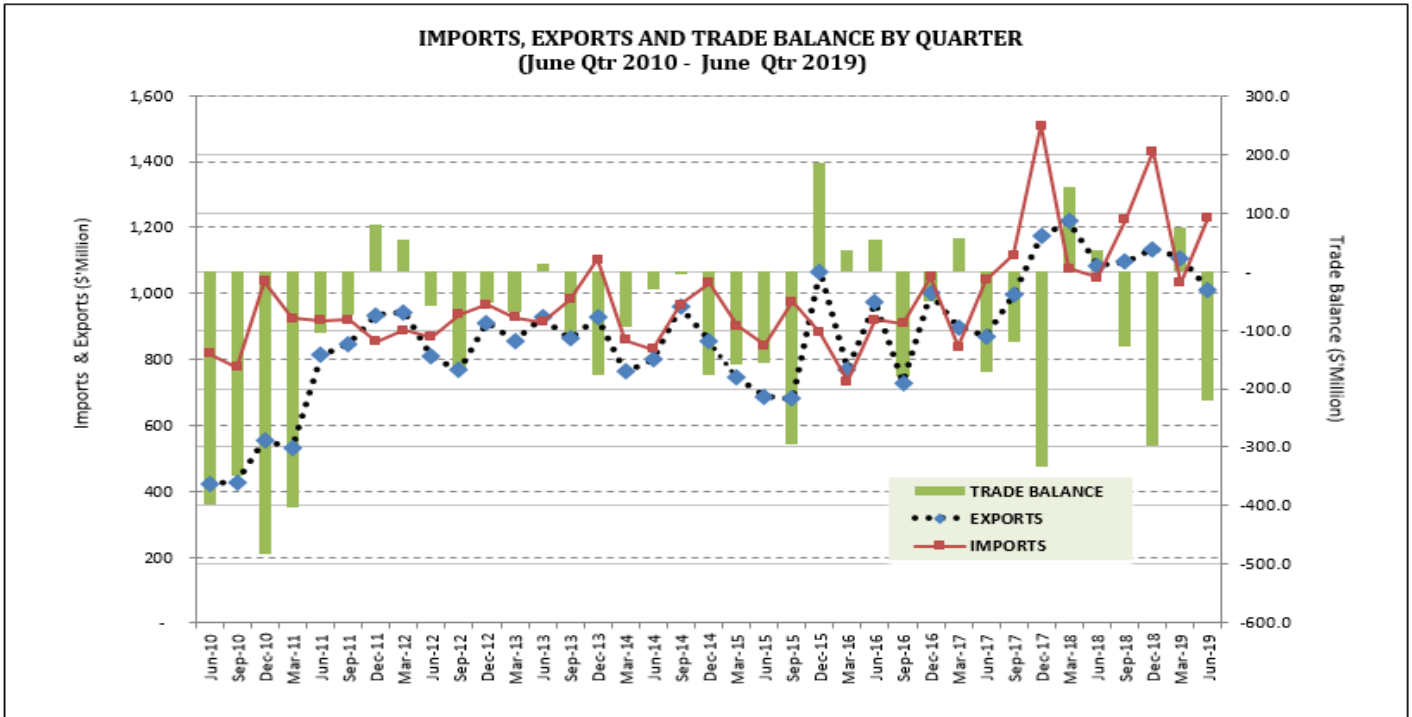

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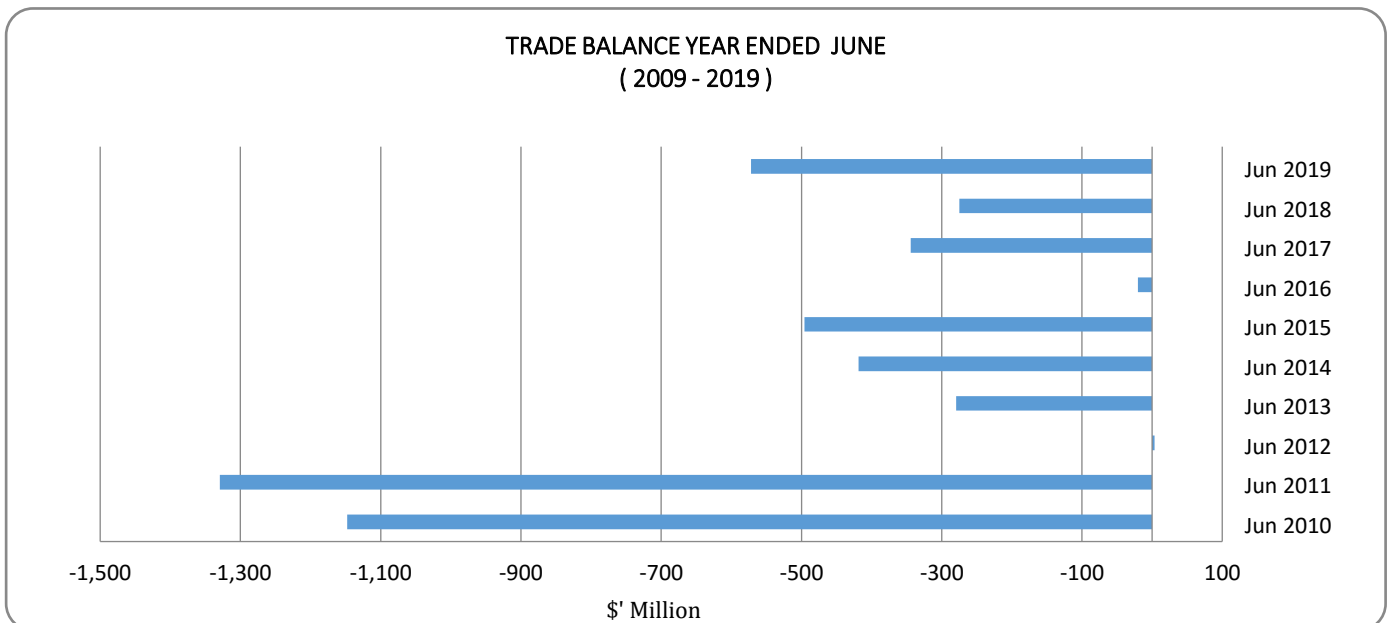
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## Highlights

The international merchandise trade balance recorded a deficit of \$221.1m in June quarter of 2019. This shifted from a surplus of \$75.7m in the previous quarter. A similar shift is recorded, compared to the same period a year ago, although the extent of the deficit has widened by about 6 times. During the June quarter, imports exceeded exports by 21.9% driven by major increases in imports of food (+33.5%), machinery and equipment (+32.4%) and chemical and related products (+34.1%) whilst riding on the decline in timber-logs exports (-12.7%). Increases in exports such as fish (+18.7%) and agricultural products (+17.2%) was overshadowed by rising exports during the quarter.



By the year-ended June 2019, compared to the same period a year ago, the trade deficit doubled from a deficit of \$274.6m to \$572.0m, and further widened, recording the highest annual deficit since 2011.



Merchandise trade movements by major commodity in the second quarter of 2019 compared to the previous quarter recorded the following:

### Major Exports

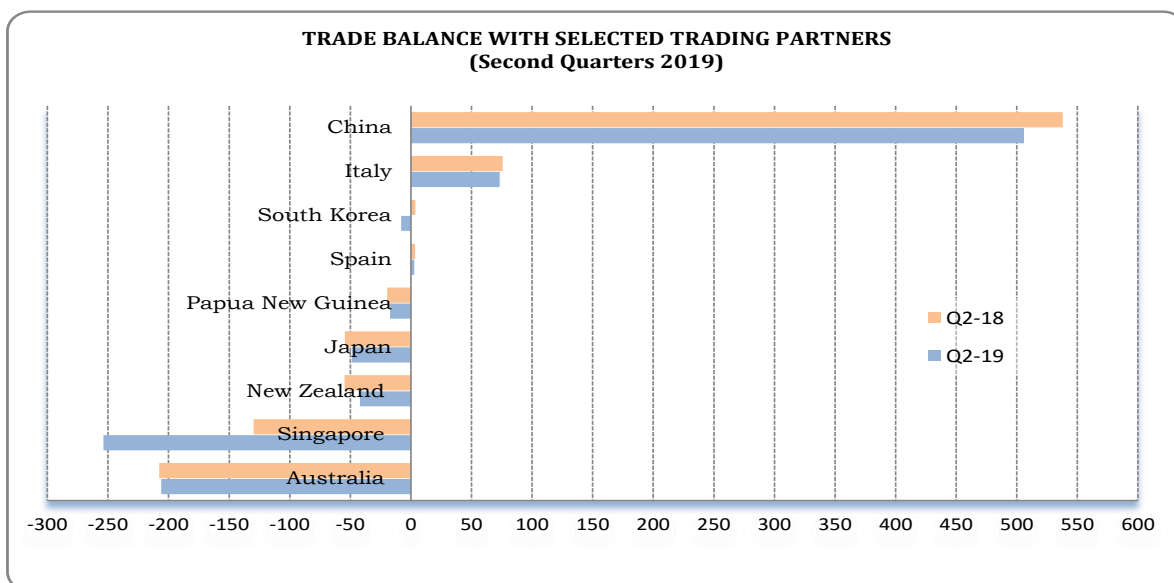
- Total timber exports comprising of log and sawn timber declined by \$99.5m (-12.0%) to \$733.0m. This was driven by a drop (-12.7%) in sawn timber.
- Total of fresh/frozen, canned and smoked fish rose by \$21.0m (+18.7%) to \$133.6m. This was attributed to an increase (+17.7%) in tuna loins (smoked).
- Total agricultural products increased moderately by \$10.6m (+17.2%) to \$72.5m as copra exports resumed, and cocoa more than doubling (+138.9%) including rises in Palm Kernel oil/meal (+31.4%); these discounted declines in coconut oil (-3.9%) and Palm oil (-6.4%).
- Gold exports more than doubled by \$1.1m (+118.7%) to \$2.0m.

### Major Imports

- Food imports increased by \$63.0m (+33.5%) to \$251.2m driven by increases in rice (+86.6%) and flour (+109%) offsetting declines in meat (-46.7%) and fish ((-47.0%) preparations, and sugar (-13.7%).
- Beverages and Tobacco decreased by \$372 (-1.5%) to \$24.1m driven by a decrease in unmanufactured tobacco (-25.5%), and beer (-25.0%).
- Mineral fuel and lubricants increased by \$27.3m (+11.0%) to \$275.6m. This was attributed to an increase in distillate fuels (+4.2%) and motor spirits (+26.4%).
- Machinery and transport equipment increased by \$77.2m (+32.4%) to \$315.7m at the back of a surge in vehicle imports (goods and special purpose (+4839.3%) and passenger vehicles (+13.6%)) outweighing decreases in outboard motors (-29.1%).

Merchandise trade balance with major trading partners in the June quarter of 2019 compared to the previous quarter records the following:

- Trade deficit with Singapore, the main origin for fuel imports increased by \$123.9m (-95.4%) to -\$253.8m.
- Trade deficit with Australia decreased by \$1.6m (-0.8%) to -\$206.1m.
- Trade deficit with Papua New Guinea reduced slightly by \$2.3m (-12.0%) to -\$17.3m.
- Trade surplus with China, the main destination of exported logs, declined slightly by \$32.1m (-6.0%) to \$505.9m.
- Trade surplus with Italy, the main destination of fish-loin exports declined by \$2.5m (-3.3%) to \$73.3m.

## About the Bulletin

This publication is a statistical report of the country's international merchandise trade statistics released periodically every quarter. The bulletin follows the United Nations definitions and compilation practice of international merchandise trade statistics with closer harmonization with regional compilation standards.

### Concepts and Definitions

#### Imports

Merchandise imports (cif) are goods bought by Solomon Islands residents and institutions from overseas. These goods are imported into Solomon Islands from other countries. The valuation of imports include the cost of insurance and freight (cif).

#### Exports

Merchandise exports (fob) are goods bought by residents and institutions that reside overseas. These goods are exported from the Solomon Islands as the place of origin to another country. The valuation of exports excludes the cost of insurance and freight (cif) and is valued free on board (fob).

#### Merchandise trade

Refers to all exports and imports of goods entering and departing the economic territory of the Solomon Islands that have an impact on the country's national stock of material resources as a result of trade. This excludes trade in service transactions classified as non-merchandise trade. See data quality section for more details.

#### Trade balance

Trade balance is the difference between exports (fob) and imports (cif) or calculated by deducting exports (fob) from imports (cif).

#### Re-Exports

This refers to merchandise exports that were previously imported or in-transit in the Solomon Islands and have an insignificant value or its contents have below half its value.

#### Trade Deficit (-)/Trade Surplus (+)

A trade deficit is when the value of imports is greater than the value of exports. The opposite is referred to as a trade surplus.

#### Country of Origin

The country where the goods originated or was manufactured from.

#### Country of Destination

The country where exported goods reach its final destination.

#### Value

All imports and exports are expressed in monetary value in the Solomon Islands Dollar (\$SBD).

#### Changes to Current Bulletin

Changes were made regarding the percentage change of current quarter to same quarter of previous year to now reflect the percent change of current quarter to previous quarter, as with yearly change. This is due to ongoing revisions and user demands. The user has flexibility to still compute percentage changes as previously stated from the data provided.

<b>Relevance:</b>	<p><b>Data topic:</b> The main data items captured from the declarations made by importers and exporters include: commodity code and description, quantity, value, country (origin, final destination, and consignment), contract details of individual importer/exporter, domestic destination for imports, place of origin for exports, port of clearance, and mode of transportation.</p> <p><b>Level of geography:</b> The data is available by main ports of Honiara and selected provincial ports.</p> <p><b>Key Data Items:</b> The key data items currently compiled and published include international trade balance, value of trade by year and quarter, value of imports by country of origin, value of exports by final destination and value of imports and exports by commodity group. The unit record data is available at 8-digit level of classification. Imports are recorded on the date when the goods are released from SICED.</p> <p><b>Additional information:</b> Revisions are sometimes made to the statistics after its release if incorrect information is received and/or other related data quality checks are applied.</p>
<b>Accuracy:</b>	<p><b>Method of Collection:</b> The SINSO collects data from the SICED directly through a flash drive backup prior to mid-2015, and subsequently through the ASYCUDA data system. In addition, the SINSO requests large firms to provide their records on imports or exports for three months. Importers and exporters provide their import and export data through the customs declarations including through the recent electronic self-assessment document (eSAD) forms when they import and export goods.</p> <p><b>Data Adjustments:</b> Data is checked for quality by SICED, and by the SINSO. Adjustments to data are made where necessary, especially when dealing with data gaps or reconciling inconsistencies following standard statistical techniques. Duplicate entries are often removed, whilst noting that small discrepancies between totals and sums of commodities in tables are due to rounding.</p> <p><b>Additional information:</b> Following UN recommendations, goods relating to personal effects of travelers, temporary imports and exports, goods in transit, goods on lease for less than a year, and goods consigned to diplomats/diplomatic status are excluded from merchandise trade statistics compilation. Fishing data from the high seas are often unaccounted for in the data collected. Data on trade in service transactions are excluded including goods for repairs in imports. Data on illegal trading of goods, which may include significant quantities is not captured. Processing errors are minimized by using software to detect and remove duplicates. If the SINSO identifies errors in published statistics, SICED are contacted to help resolve the error and a revised figure is published in the next issue of the statistical bulletin.</p>

<b>Coherence:</b>	<p>There is consistent time series data although data from 1998-2000 and the first two quarters of 2009 are unavailable or incomplete and are estimated. Prior to the third quarter of 2015, data was collected from SICED who were using their own processing system until the introduction of the ASYCUDA system.</p> <p><b>Additional information:</b> There is no data available for 1998 to 2000 due to the period of civil unrest in the country ('Tensions').</p>
<b>Interpretability:</b>	<p><b>Other Supporting information:</b> The concepts and definitions stated earlier in the section 'About the Bulletin' should assist readers understand and interpret the statistics. In addition, the UN's international merchandise trade statistics classifications are available to help users better understand and interpret the data. It is calculated as the value of the current period less the value of the previous period, divided by the value of the previous period and multiplied by 100 (%). For example, taking the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter (December) 2016 and 2017 export figures ('000), we calculate percentage change (December quarter over same period a year ago) as: <math>(\\$117,3803 - \\$99,9014) / \\$99,014 \times 100 = 7.5\%</math>. This implies that the value of exports has increased by 7.5% (\$174,790) from December 2016 to December 2017 period. One can apply similar calculations depending on the period of choice, for example, year over year etc.</p> <p><b>Additional information:</b> Users are encouraged to firstly read the title of the tables to understand the content of the tabular presentation of the statistics. Table: 1 refer to both imports and exports while Tables: 2 (a, b), 4 and 5 refer to imports, and Tables: 3(a, b), 6 and 7 refers to exports.</p>
