The IACP Awards Program continues to strengthen and streamline its guidelines, implementing an even more rigorous multi-step recipe testing process, rules, fees, and categories to promote diversity and transparency in its award process.

This year, we launched new categories, including best food sections in a magazine or newspaper, restaurant criticism, and culinary recipe and travel websites. These changes included increased stringent and increased transparent processes and strict ethical rules, an awards advisory committee, and a free entry period, followed by some reduced entry fees to make it more accessible across the board.
