71, 76, 81, 86)cm]

Length: 13¼ (14, 16, 18, 19½, 21)" [34

(36, 41, 46, 50, 53)cm]

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Daily Tweed Worsted (90% superwash wool/7% acrylic/
- 3% viscose; 100g/218yd) -731218-0006 Fraser Fir
- [1 (2, 2, 3, 3, 4) balls]: A
- -731218-0005 Celadon
- (1 ball all sizes): B
- -731218-0014 Obsidian
- [1 (1, 1, 1, 2, 2) balls]: C
- -731218-0003 Deep Sienna
- [1 (1, 1, 1, 2, 2) balls]: D
- -731218-0011 Stoneware (1 ball all sizes): E
- US size 7 (4.5mm) dpn or size needed to obtain gauge

• US size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge

- US size 7 (4.5mm) 24" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 5 (3.75mm) dpn
- US size 5 (3.75mm) 24" circular needle
- Stitch markers
- Waste yarn or stitch holders
- Yarn needle

Gauge

20 sts x 28 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in St st Save time, check your gauge.

Pattern Notes

- In stranded colorwork section there are spots with long sections in one color. Twist yarns tog every 3-4 sts in the back to carry unused color without leaving a large lp on the inside. Carry unused color loosely to ensure colorwork section lays flat.
- Sts on the chart shown in E should be k in C when working chart, then added with duplicate stitch in the finishing.

Instructions

Yoke

With A and size 7 dpn, CO 48 (51, 56, 59, 64, 69) sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist work.
Change to 16" circular needle, then 24"

circular as sts inc.

K 1 rnd.

Inc Rnd 1: *K2, m1; rep from * to last 0 (1, 0, 1, 0, 1) sts, k0 (1, 0, 1, 0, 1)—72 (76, 84, 88, 96, 103) sts.

Next Rnd—Size 12 only: K to last st, m1, k1—104 sts.

Work in St st until yoke measures 1¼ (1½, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2)" [3.2 (3.8, 5.1, 5.1, 5.1, 5.1)cm].

Inc Rnd 2: *K2, m1; rep from * around— 108 (114, 126, 132, 144, 156) sts.

Work in St st until yoke measures 21/4 (21/2, 3, 31/2, 33/4, 33/4)" [5.7 (6.4, 7.6, 8.9, 9.5, 9.5)cm].

Inc Rnd 3: *K3, m1; rep from * around—144 (152, 168, 176, 192, 208) sts.

Work in St st until yoke measures 2¾ (3, 3¾, 4¼, 4¾, 5)" [7 (7.6, 9.5, 10.8, 12, 12.7)cm]. *Cut A; join B.*

K 1 rnd (corresponds to Rnd 1 of chart).

Inc Rnd 4: Cut B; join C. K around, inc'ing 32 (40, 40, 48, 48, 48) sts evenly around—176 (192, 208, 224, 240, 256) sts (corresponds to Rnd 2 of chart).
K 2 rnds in C (Rnds 3-4 of chart).

Beg stranded color work.

Join D and work Rnds 5-16 of chart.

Note: on the final rep of the chart, each rnd ends at the red (blue, red, blue, red, blue) line.

Cut D.

K 1 rnd in C (Rnd 17 of chart).

Next Rnd: Cut C; join B. K around, inc'ing 6 (0, 4, 0, 4, 8) sts evenly around—182 (192, 212, 224, 244, 264) sts (corresponds to Rnd 18 of chart).

Cut B; join A.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: begin/beginning

BO: bind off **cm:** centimeter **CO:** cast on

dec, dec'd: decrease, decreased **dpn:** double pointed needles **inc, inc'ing:** increase, increasing

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

Ip: loop **m:** marker

m1: make one stitch

p: purl

pm: place marker
rem: remain/remaining
rep: repeat/repeats

rnd/rnds: round/rounds

ssk: slip, slip, knit these 2 stitches together—1 stitch decreased

st/sts: stitch/stitches
St st: Stockinette stitch

tog: together

Divide Sleeves and Body

With A, remove m, k across 53 (56, 62, 66, 72, 78) sts for back, place next 38 (40, 44, 46, 50, 54) sts on waste yarn or st holder for right sleeve, CO 6 (8, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts for underarm, k across 53 (56, 62, 66, 72, 78) sts for front, place next 38 (40, 44, 46, 50, 54) sts on waste yarn or st holder for left sleeve, CO 3 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts, pm, CO 3 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4) more sts for underarm—118 (128, 140, 148, 160, 172) sts.

Work in St st until body measures 5¼ (5¾, 6¾, 8¼, 9¼, 10¼)" [13.3 (14.6, 17.1, 21, 23.5, 26)cm] from divide, ending at m.

Bottom Edging

Change to size 5 circular needle.

Work for 3" (7.6cm) in garter st, changing colors as follows: *4 rnds B, 4 rnds C, 4 rnds D, 4 rnds C; rep from * to end.

BO all sts.

Sleeves

Place 38 (40, 44, 46, 50, 54) sts from holder onto size 7 dpn.

Join A in center of underarm CO sts, pick up and k3 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4), k across sleeve sts, pick up and k3 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4)—44 (48, 52, 54, 58, 62) sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist work. K 4 rnds.

Dec Rnd: K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Rnd every sixth rnd 7 (8, 9, 8, 9, 10) more times—28 (30, 32, 36, 38, 40) sts rem. K in St st if necessary until sleeve measures 9 (9½, 10, 11½, 12¾, 13½)" [22.9 (24.1, 25, 29, 32, 34)cm].

Cuff

Change to size 5 dpn.

Work for 2" (5.1cm) in garter st, changing colors as follows: *4 rnds B, 4 rnds C, 4 rnds D, 4 rnds C; rep from * to end.
BO all sts.

Finishing

Neck Edging:

With size 5 dpn and B, pick up and k48 (51, 56, 59, 64, 69) along CO edge.

Starting and ending with a p rnd, k 5 rnds in garter st.

BO all sts loosely.

With E, duplicate stitch stems onto pumpkins on stranded colorwork section. Weave in ends.


Block to even out sts.


