

# WILL CONTEST HULL'S SEAT.

DES MOINES, Iowa, April 6.—Capt. J. A. T. Hull, Chairman of the Committee on Military Affairs and one of Speaker Cannon's lieutenants in the House in Washington, will have a fight to retain his seat in Congress. To-day W. O. Payne of Nevada, an insurgent Republican, announced himself a candidate in the Seventh District against Capt. Hull.

Charles Grilk, an attorney at Davenport, announced his candidacy in the Second to succeed Congressman Dawson, resigned.
