## **Historical Data**

This imposing brick building with an arched portico at the front was constructed in 1901 at a cost of £1,200 on the site of the old Gympie Hospital.

The designer of the hall was WP Hayes Architect. The building has since been extended.

## **Place Assessment**

Gympie lodge was established in 1897, before the development of the hall people met in the commercial chambers building.

Freemasonry commenced in Gympie in 1869.
