## **Historical Data**

This hotel was the first commercial hotel erected in 1871. Originally designed by architect CG Smith and later additions attributed to Hugo Durietz in 1881. The building was destroyed by fire in 1890 before a new building was designed in 1892 by Richard Gailey.
