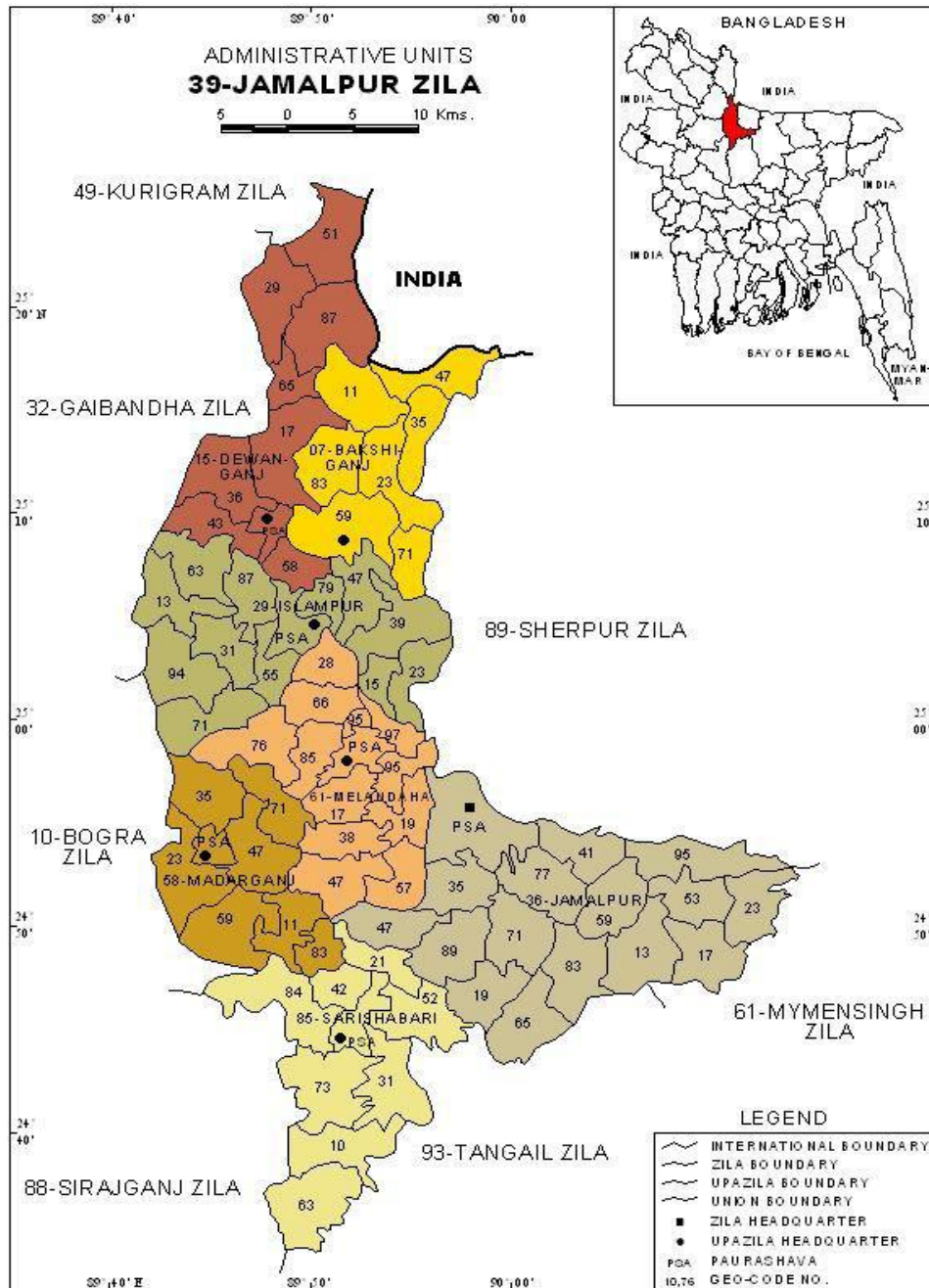

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Jamalpur is a district in Dhaka Division. It is situated on the northern part of Bangladesh. Jamalpur district was established in 1978. It is said that during the reign of Emperor Akbar, a Saint named Hazrat Shah Jamal (R.) came from Yemen to preach Islam with 200 followers and set up a hermitage at Singhajanee mauza located on the southern bank of Brahmaputra River. It is believed that the name of the district had been derived from the name of that Saint.

Geographic Area and Location: Jamalpur is bounded on the north by Kurigram district and Meghalaya State of India, on the east by Sherpur and Mymensingh districts, on the south by Tangail district and on the west by Sirajganj, Bogra and Gaibandha districts. The total area of the district is 2115.16 sq.km. (816.66 sq.miles) of which 18.16 sq.km. is under forest. The district lies between 24°34' and 25°26' north latitudes and between 89°40' and 90°12' east longitudes.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: The annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 33.3°C to minimum 12°C. Annual average rainfall is 2174 mm.

Main River: The Jamuna, Brahmaputra, Jhenai, Banar, Jirjira, Chhatal are main rivers of this district.

Administration: Jamalpur district was established in 1978. The district consists of 7 upazilas, 68 unions, 844 mauzas, 1361 villages, 6 paurashavas, 57 wards and 225 mahallas. The upazilas are Jamalpur Sadar, Bakshiganj, Dewanganj, Islampur, Madarganj, Melandaha and Sarishabari.

Archaeological Heritage and Relic: Tomb of Shah Jamal, Tomb of Shah Kamal, Dayamoye Mondir, Five domed Raspal Jame Mosque at Sarishabari (nineteenth century), and Narapara Fort at Sarishabari (sixteenth century) are main archaeological heritage and relics of this district.

Historical Event: Fakir Sannyasi Rebellion (1772-1790), Indigo Resistance Movement (1829), Famine (1874) are memorable historical events of Jamalpur district.

Educational Institution: Numbers of educational institutions of this district are Government college 5, non-government college 46 government secondary school 7, non-government secondary school 326, madrasa 150, junior high school 38, government primary school 588, registered primary school 422, non-registered primary school 33 kinder garden school 177, law college 1, homeopathy college 1 and agricultural research centre 1.

Cultural organization: Numbers of cultural organisations of this district are club 510, public library 4, cinema hall 15, stadium 1, public hall 1, upazila auditorium 6, orphanage 36, literary society 4, women's organisation 5, theatre group 6 and shilpakala academy 1.

Main Crop: Paddy, jute, sugarcane, mustard seed, peanut, wheat, sweet potato, tobacco, betel leaf, chilly, pulse, vegetables, etc. are main fruits of this district.

Main Fruit: Jackfruit, banana, latkol, tetul, kodbel, bangi, etc. are main fruits of this district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Jamalpur district is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 546,075 holdings of the district, 336,784 (61.67%) holdings are farms and remaining 38.33% are non-farms. Non-farm holdings largely depend on non-agricultural activities. Despite the growth of agriculture activities, the non-farm holdings play an important role in the economy of this district. Farm-holdings produce varieties of crops, namely local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, spices, cash crops, pulses, oilseeds, maize and others. Various fruits like banana, jackfruits, guava, coconut, etc. are grown. Fishes of various species are abundant in the district. Varieties of fish are caught from local rivers, tributary channels and creeks and from paddy fields during rainy season. Popular fresh water fish species are ruhi, katla, mrigel, kalibous, airh, ghania, shoel, boal, gulsha, koy, shing, magur, etc. Crops, livestock, forestry and fishery are the main sources of household income.

Non-farm activities are very much significant in Jamalpur district. The following table-1 shows total establishments and persons engaged by sex and activity in the district.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: A part of the Jamalpur district lies in the physiographic sub-region. Brahamaputra–Jamuna left bank active floodplain consisting of the Diaras along the left bank and the chars within the river where the soils are mainly silty alluvium with extensive areas of sand in the chars. Another

part of the district lies in the sub-region, the old Brahamaputra floodplain where the soils are mainly loams on the ridges and clays in the basins.

Crops: The main agricultural crops of the district are rice, jute and sugarcane. Jute and sugarcane remain the main cash crops. Among rice crops, transplanted aman covers the largest area followed by boro and aus (Agriculture Census 2008). Rabi season crops include potato, sweet potato, pulses, different kinds of vegetables, spices, cheena, etc. Banana is grown thickly around the homesteads, especially in the newer accretions.

Fruits: There is a wide variety of trees in the district. Most of these trees are planted at the raised platforms of homesteads. The chief fruit trees of the district are mango (*Mangifera indica*), jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), jambura (*Citrus decumana*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), papaya (*Carica papaya*), wood apple, or bel (*Aegle marmelos*), ata (*Anona squamosa*), boroi or kul (*Zizyphus mauritiana*), kamranga (*Averrho karambola*), black berry (*Syzygium cumini*), labu (*Citrus carantifolia*), kodbel (*Limonia acidissima*). The most characteristics feature of the landscape is the palm, the commonest species being khejur (*Phoenix sylvestris*), betel nut (*Areca catechu*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*) and tal (*Borassus flabellifer*). On comparatively higher ground jackfruit or kanthal and lichi are the most frequent.

Trees: Along the water sources and water tanks, the mandar (*Erythrina variegata*), badi (*Lansea grandis*) and hijol (*Barringtonia acutangula*), kadam (*Anthocephalus cadamba*), neem (*Azadirachta indica*), pitraj (*Aphanamixis polystachia*), gab (*Diospyros precoloratus*), jalpai (*Elaeocarpus tectoris*), jarul (*Legerastroemia speciosa*), bakul (*Mimusops elengi*), mendi (*Lawsonia inermis*), gamar (*Gmelina arborea*), mitinga bans or bamboo (*Bambusa bambos*) and bora bans (*Bambusa balcooa*). However, various exotic trees like teak, mahagoni (*Swietenia macrophylla*), sissu (*Dalbergia sissoo*), etc. have been introduced as wayside trees as well as farm forestry. Mandar, a thorny tree mostly used as fuel and fencing, is seen in almost every household forest. Shimul (*Bombax ceiba*), palosh (*Butea monosperma*) katbadam (*Terminalia catappa*) and kadam trees are very common and are preferred for manufacturing match stick. The fruit or shimul or karpus is used for stuffing mattresses and pillows and has a silky appearance. Newly introduced trees include *Eucalyptus* and Pine.

Mango wood is not good as a timber, but owing to its being in abundance, it is much used. The wood of tamarind and kul is hard grained and of good quality. The amaltas is used for house and rough furniture. Jarul is used for boat building and pillars of house.

The luxuriant growth of palms is the most characteristic feature of the vegetation. Toddy palms or tal (*Borassus flabellifer*) and date palms (Khejur) are also very common. Date palm is valuable tree. The juice is extracted and made into gur, the leaves are used for making large fans.

Shady trees include banyan or bat (*Ficus benghalensis*), aswatha (*Ficus religiosa*), pipal (*Ficus religiosa*) and neem (*Azadirachta indica*). There are several varieties of cane, a good deal of

bamboo of different varieties and thatching grass (*chhan*) although their plantations are gradually decreasing steadily. Use of bamboo is widespread such as post and fencing of houses, making of baskets and trays of various kinds. Besides, roadside trees are represented by sonalu (*Cassia fistula*), debdaru (*Polyalthia longifolia*), krishnachura (*Delonix regia*), tetul (*Tamarindus indica*), etc. These trees are commonly seen everywhere.

Lichen/Ferns: The swamps, ditches and many of the village ponds contain a rich variety of species. The kachuri pana (*Telanthera philoxeroides*), topa pana (*Pistia stratiotes*), khudi pana (*Lemna paucicostata*), pani phal (*Trapa bispinosa*), the cucurious floating ferns, azolla pinnata and salvinia natans etc. are seen in these water bodies.

In older and shallower ponds are found species of padma (*Nelumbo nucifera*), shapla (*Nymphaea nouchali*), nil padma (*Nymphaea stellata*), the common aquatic leafy greens, kalmi (*Polygonum*), helencha (*Tilantha philoxeroides*), etc.

Fauna:

Mammals: Among the mammalian fauna the smaller species are usually seen in the countryside of Jamalpur district. They include chika (*Suncus murinus*), rat (*Bandicota bengalensis*), ground rat (*Mus booduga*), mouse (*Mus musculus*), sajaru (*Atherurus macrourus*), squirrel (*Petaurista magnificus*). Katbiral (*Collosciurus pygerythrus*), rabbit (*Caprolagus hispidus*), benji (*Herpestes edwardis*), jackal (*Canis aureus*), fox (*Vulpes bengalensis*), bat (*Rousettus leschenaulti*), indian pipistrelle (*Pipistrellus coromandra*), bengal mongoose or benji (*Herpestes auropunctatus*), etc.

Birds: The resident birds that are ubiquitous in the countryside and urban areas are bulbuli (*Picnonotus cafer*), sparrow (*Passer domesticus*), crow (*Corvus splendens*), vat shalik (*Acridotheres tristis*), kali pencha (*Glaucidium radiatum*), bhuban chil (*Milvus migrans*). Other common resident birds comprise punkaor (*Phalacrocorac niger*), korchey bok (*Ardeola grajii*), dove or tila ghugu (*Streptopelia chinensis*), horial (*Treron phoenicoptera*), tia (*Psillacula krameri*), pigeon (*Columba sp.p.*), cuckoo (*Cuculus microplerus*), nimpokh (*Otus bakkamaena*), laxmi pencha (*Tyto alba*), ababil (*Hirundo rustica*), kingfisher (*Alcedo atthis*), little kingfisher (*Alcedo atthis*), banashpati (*Merops orinetalis*), kaththokra (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), bharat pakhi (*Mirafra assamica*), jhuti shalik (*Acridotheres fuscus*), tuntuni (*Orthotomus sutorius*), magpie robin (*Copsychus saularis*), titpokh (*Parus major*), madhuchuski (*Nectariniaasiatica*), mautushi (*Nectarinia zeylonica*), babui (*Ploceus philippinus*), tila munia (*Lonchura punctulata*), etc.

Besides, various species of migratory birds are seen in different open water bodies of the district. These are khonjan (*Motacilla cinerea*), Indian tree pipit (*Anthus hodgsoni*), booted warbler (*Hippolais caligata*), lalbok chotok (*Muscicapa parva*), badami koshai pakhi (*Lanius cristatus*), little stint (*Calidris minuta*), kadakhucha (*Gallinago gallinago*), chaga (*Gallinago stenura*), kalo hans (*Aythya ferina*), bhuti hans (*Aythya nyroca*), giria hans (*Anas querquedula*), lenja hans (*Anas*

acuta), chokachoki (*Tadorna ferruginea*), shachka (*Tadorna tadorna*), raj hans (*Anser indicus*), greenleg goose (*Anser anser*), gadwall (*Anas strepera*), plover (*Charadrius alencaster*), herring gull (*Larus argentatus*), common swallow (*Hirundo rustica*), etc. Raptorial birds include king vulture or shakun (*Gyps bengalensis*), lanner falcon or baj (*Falco biarmicus*), marsh harrier or gochila (*Circus aeruginosus*), pariah kite or cheel (*Milvus migrans*), several species of stork like pond heron or kani boga (*Ardeola grayii*), cattle egret or o boga (*Babulcus ibis*) and black bittern or kala boga (*Dupeter plovicollis*), and some other domestic species. Water birds include the little cormorant or pankawri (*Phalacrocorax niger*), waterhen or dauk (*Amaurornis phoenicurus*), watercock or kora (*Gallicrex cinerea*), etc.

Reptiles and Amphibians: The reptiles include different species of snakes are dhora shap (*Xenocrophis piscator*), meteshap (*Micropisthodon plumbicolor*), and painashap (*Enhydris enhydris*). The most poisonous snakes are variety of cobras. They are shankhini shap (*Bungarus caeruleus*) and jatshap (*Naja kaouthia*). Reptiles also include gui shap (*Varanus salvator*), hungui shap (*Varanus flaviscens*), kori kaitla (*Kachuga tecta*), dhum kasim (*Trionyx hurum*), tiktiki (*Hemidactylus brooki*), shanda (*Gekko gecko*), etc.

Fishes: The common varieties of fish that are found in different water bodies of the district are ruhi or salmon (*Labeo rohita*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalbous (*Labeo calbasu*), katla or carp (*Catla catla*), etc. shoal fish (*Channa striatus*), scorpion-fish or singi (*Heteropneustes fossilis*) are also found in large quantity in beels and khals. Many other species of river and fresh water fishes are also found in the district. Of these the principal varieties are boal/sheat fish (*Wallago attu*), dhain, chital (*Notopterus chitala*), ghona, airh (*Mystus aor*), bagair (*Bagarius yarrellii*), pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*), boal (*Wallago Attu*), rita (*Rita rita*), bain or eel (*Mastacembelus armatus*), chapila (*Gudusia chapra*), bhagna (*Labeo boga*), nandail bacha, pon, gargle (*Arius gogora*), kaulia, kapali, khorsols mehsir, golsha (*Mystus bleekeri*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chanda (*Mene mukulata*), tekchanda (*Gerres argyreus*), kachki (*Corica soborna*), baila (*Glossogobius giuris*), bheda (*Nandus nandus*), batashi (*Pseudotropheus atherinoides*), kakila (*Strogylura strogylura*), phali or flat fish (*Notopterus notopterus*), tatkeni (*Crosscheilus latius*), pabda or butter fish (*Ompok pabda*), chela (*Chela cachius*), gangchela, gazar (*Channa marulius*), koy or climbing fish (*Anabas testudineus*), kholisha (*Colisa fasciatus*), puti (*Barbus puntius*), sharputi (*Puntius sarana*), taki (*Channa punctatus*), walking fish (*Ophicephalus striatus*), malandi, bashpata (*Danio devario*), kakra (*Scylla serrata*), meani, shrimps, and prawn are found in the district. However, some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.

v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks, and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
