

StartCon announces six of the world's top entrepreneurs & growth marketers to fly to Sydney in initial lineup for Startcon 2016

SYDNEY, March 23, 2016: <u>StartCon</u> (formerly SydStart) today announced international top speakers from Survey Monkey, Zillow, BitTorrent, 500Startups, Hubspot and META as part of the initial lineup for Australia's largest startup & growth conference, to be held at Sydney's new \$152 million dollar five-star grand-stand at Royal Randwick Racecourse on November 26 and 27, 2016.

The new venue is the world-class Queen Elizabeth II Grandstand and surrounding facilities. Stretching 110m alongside the race track and towering five levels above the finishing post, the venue hosts the largest LED screen in the southern hemisphere, eight new restaurant and dining spaces, four undercover terraces on each level facing west over the Theatre of the Horse, and provides CBD views across Centennial and Moore Parks and high-capacity WiFi throughout.

Ben graduated from the University of Sydney where he met co-founder Meron Gribetz and started META. Ben raised a Series A of \$23M from renowned investors including Tim Draper and Horizon's Ventures among others. Ben is also a Graduate of Y Combinator (Summer 2013).

This first lineup of speakers follows on from the 2015 conference, which showcased international tech industry superstars, including 9GAG CEO and co-founder Ray Chan, Megaupload and Internet entrepreneur Kim Dotcom, the Godfather of Growth Hacking Sean Ellis, and <u>Freelancer.com</u> CEO Matt Barrie.

In 2016, the conference expands to a capacity of over 3,000 attendees, and will feature even more world-class international speakers in entrepreneurship and growth marketing, on top of high quality workshops and a 100-booth expo showcasing the biggest tech names and high-growth startups in Australia.

The event will include a pitch competition, Capture the Flag (network security challenge), and a two-day hackathon, with thousands of dollars in prizes.
