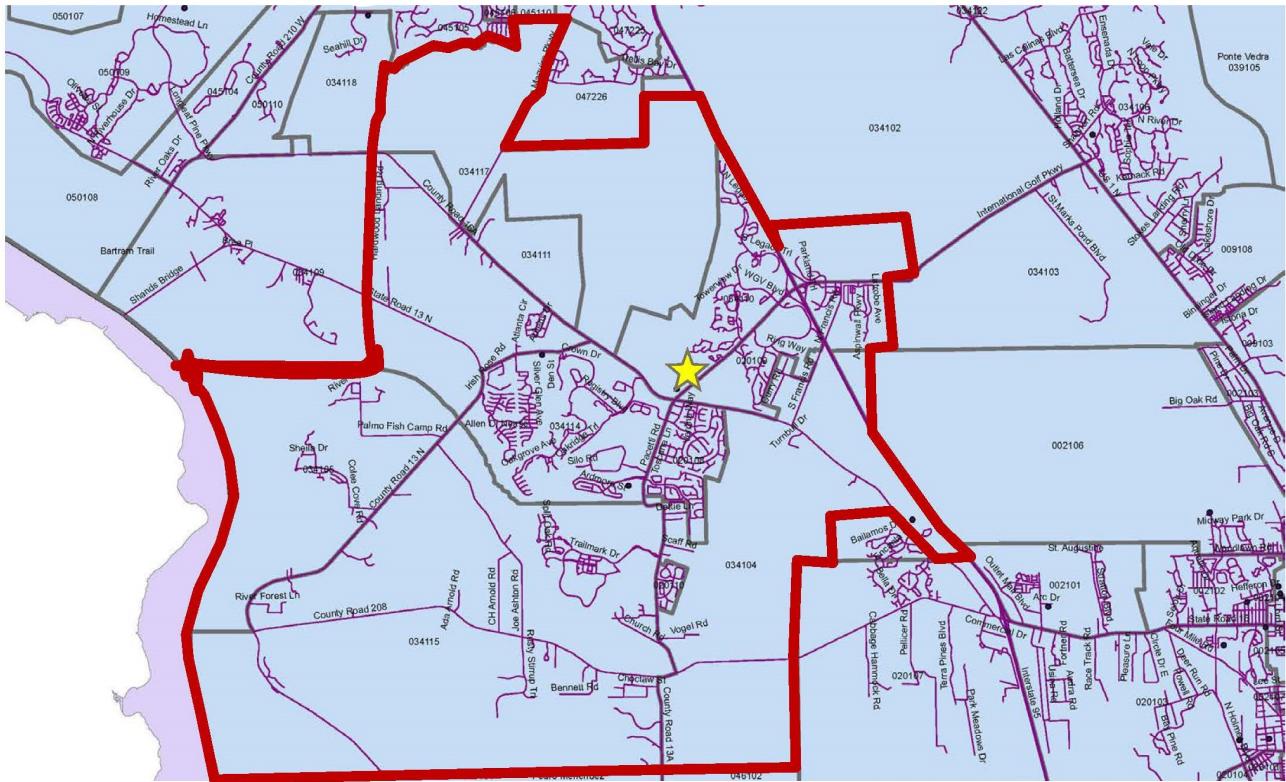

Curriculum Information

TCHS will offer three diverse academies and collegiate program of study. As you read about the choices and opportunities below, consider where you will best fit as a student, a parent, or a community partner.

Programs of Choice:

Academy of Future Healthcare Professionals - The electives in this academy will offer students an opportunity to explore careers in healthcare. Students will be able to visit healthcare facilities, participate in shadowing rotations and gain real-world experiences in the medical field.

Academy of Innovation in the Built Environment - The electives in this academy will provide a foundation in construction management, engineering and project-based coursework designed to foster creative and innovative learning experiences.

Academy of Leadership in Emerging Technologies - The electives in this academy will emphasize the use of emerging technologies and leadership, entrepreneurial and technical skills needed to be successful in rapidly changing industries (robotics, drones, coding) using future technologies.

Tocio Creek Collegiate High School Program of Choice - Student completing this program will graduate with 60 college credit hours, resulting in an Associates Degree from [St. Johns River State College](#).

Academics - TCHS students will have the opportunity to explore many varying levels of academic instruction. Advanced Placement, Honors, Standard, and Support courses will be offered at all grade levels. Students interested in Dual Enrollment who are not a part of the Collegiate High School will be able to begin DE courses as early as sophomore year. We understand that each student comes to us with varying needs. Our goal is to ensure that all students at Toco Creek High School are exposed to the highest level of rigor to meet those individual needs.

Arts - Once completed, TCHS will be blended with a premier performance building for The Arts. We will open our 2021-2022 school year with full performance band, orchestra, and jazz ensembles. Our exquisite auditorium is set to host outstanding dramatic productions with intricate stage designs as well as superior vocal and dance performances highlighting our TCHS thespians and performers. Student artwork created in our Drawing, Digital Design, and Ceramics courses will soon be highlighted throughout the building and our Toros will be ever-informed as our communications department brings news and print media to life at Toco Creek.

Student Information

Beginning February 1, 2021, all students zoned for Tocoi Creek High School will be able to choose electives via Home Access Center. The window closes February 19, 2021.

What if you don't have HAC?

Students not currently enrolled in a SJC school will not have access to HAC. These students will need to pre-register on the CTE website to apply for a Program of Choice by February 5, 2021. If your child is entering the 11th grade and/or is not interested in an academy, the general registration begins March 1, 2021.

Choosing Courses Online

Please use the instructions below to choose electives for the 2021-2022 school year.

Step 1: Beginning 2/1, log into student HAC account using student username and password, NOT parent's login.
Step 2: Select "Classes"
Step 3: Select the "Request" tab
Step 4: Any course that is teacher recommended has a lock symbol next to it and cannot be changed. If students feel they have been recommended for the wrong course, students can fill out a core re-evaluation form.
Step 5: Choose elective classes. Be sure to choose 4 electives.
Step 6: All courses that students can choose from are listed under the "Electives" tab.
Step 7: To select a course, click edit on the department row and select the box next to the class or classes you wish to ADD. Then select SAVE.
Step 8: If there is an elective course in HAC that a student does not want on their schedule, student can discuss it during registration appointment.
DEADLINE: February 19th at 3:00

Core Re-Evaluation Form

All core courses must be recommended by the student's current teacher in that subject. If students feel they have been recommended for the wrong course, the students may fill out the core re-evaluation form

Academy Courses

A notification email will go out to students who applied to an academy during the last week of February. If a student has been accepted into an academy, the student should see the first course in the progression in HAC by the end of February. If a student no longer wants to be in an academy, please email Chassity Johnson. Academy courses are only added to a student's schedule through the district application and approval process. If a student applied and was accepted but does not see the academy course on the schedule request tab by February 28th, contact CTE office at 904-547-4870.

Virtual Classes

Planning to take a virtual class next year? Please complete this [FORM](#) to have the TCHS course removed from HAC and the virtual lab added. Students must also request the course on FLVS or SJVS, with an August 10, 2021 start date, by June 10, 2021. It is very important that students change their school of record in their FLVS account to Toco Creek High School during the summer.

Please Note: Students may only take one virtual period on campus at TCHS due to seat availability. Students can opt to take more than one course virtually but will not have more than one virtual lab.
