EHR net Fun and all-news pubcaster France Info were the two winners during the September-October 1993 ratings sweep, with both achieving record audiences. Fun's cume share jumped to 6.7% from 5.8% in the same period last year, while France Info's

rose to 9.2% from 8.1%. according to researchers Mediametrie.

NRJ Close To Buying Munich's Radio Xanadu

French radio giant NRJ is close to clinching a deal to buy Munich-based classic rock station Radio Xanadu. NRJ is already represented in the Berlin and Sachsen markets of Germany (Energy 103.4 Berlin and Energy Saxony) and its entry into the important Munich market will bolster the network's position in that market.

Xanadu MD Horst Bork comments, "We have been negotiating with NRJ for some time now. Now we are just waiting for the final decision from the media authority BLM before the deal can go through." Bork says BLM is expected to give its decision sometime in December. Having a successful, Europe-wide operator like NRJ behind Xanadu will open up many new advertising

and marketing opportunities and will strengthen the station's position in the competitive Munich market. "NRJ has proved itself as a very successful network," says Bork, "and there is no reason why it shouldn't be equally successful here in Munich."

Says BLM press spokesperson Wolfgang Flieger. "We don't yet know how much of a stake NRJ wants to buy in Xanadu. We still haven't been presented with a contract setting out the operator's intentions and what percentage of Xanadu it wants to have. Once we get this then we will be in a position to come to a decision.

Though NRJ MD Alain Weill says it would be "premature" for him to comment on Radio Xanadu at the moment, he adds, (continues on page 24)

French Nets Await New Belgian Media Law

French-speaking Belgium could be on the brink of a major change in its broadcasting landscape if proposals put forward in a major report "Le Carrefours de l'Audiovisuel" are carried through. The head-to-toe review of the brandcasting system commis-

sioned in August this year proposes withdrawing current obstacles to private radio networks. The resulting frequency plan. expected early next year, could open the territory up to major French radio operators, who are currently queuing up for permission to extend their operations.

The Belgian launch of powerful French TV company TF1 last

year was proof of the country's powerlessness to protect its market in the face of European TV legislation, and, although a European charter on radio is far from completion, general European trade directives prevent the territory from excluding foreign broadcasters from its cadio land-

All the major French net-

work operators are currently represented in the region to some extent via local stations: NRJ (EHR) and its subsidiary Chérie FM (Francophone), Europe 2 (ACE), Nostalgie (Gold), Fun (dance/EHR), M40 (EHR) and Skyrock (Rock/dance). Some, such as Nostalgie and Europe 2, have

French Broadcasting White Paper EUROPE AT A GLANCE **Receives Ministry Approval**

FRANCE

Long-awaited changes in French broadcasting law have moved one step nearer following the approval of the white paper by minister of communications Alain Cariguon on November 10. The paper will be discussed in parliament before the end of the month.

Fun president Benoît Sillard welcomes the approval, calling it a major step forward for the radio industry. It will allow France to stay one step ahead of the other European countries in the global race by creating strong broadcasting groups.

Radio is only one of the sec-

tions in the 10-paragraph paper. which primarily covers television. The most important element is the already highly publicised lifting of ownership restrictions. The amendment will allow operators to own as many networks as they want, as long as they do not exceed a cumulative audience of 120 million. There have even been reports that this restriction could be upped to 150 million.

For both TV and radio services, the paper proposes the implementation of a simplified licence renewal system, whereby the five-year radio licence could be automatically renewed, with no new call for offers. This effectively means an extension of

broadcasting authorisation (granted by the CSA) to 10 years. unless operators have been sanctionned by the CSA for "repeated wrongdoings," In this case, the CSA will be entitled to withdraw the licence.

This change has been welcomed by radio executives as a means of allowing operators the time to set up long-term policies.

Meanwhile, another clause in the paper stipulates that the CSA should be allowed to impose a minimum quota of Francophone music. Although this requirement already existed unofficially, the clause makes the quota mandatory and gives the CSA more power to enforce the policy.

Deliveries of vinyl albums amounted to 1.08 million, a 11.3% drop on 1992's July-September total of 1.22 million. BPI believes that the sales growth in CD albums is due to several factors. It says sales are increasing through non-traditional channels such as supermarket chains and mail order. Z Radio Shuts Down Radio P4 To Focus On Stockholm Stations

Unghanse says it also makes perfect sense for Z Radio to shut down P4 as the network is hoping to gain new frequencies in the Gothenburg/Malmo radio auction in December, "We didn't just start broadcasting on the Radio P4 frequency under the name of Z Radio, at u's a bad frequency and it wouldn't be good for the image of Z Radio to be broadcasting on such a poor frequency. We are taking a break in the Matmo area and will start up P4 under a new name and on a new and better fre-

Z Radio has been running a classic rock format on its new Stockholm frequency since Octo-ber 15 with "a mix of US AOR

and Swedish ACE." Unghanse says Z Radio plans to run "more ACE" format stations on any frequncies it wins in the Gothenburg/Malmo area.




ITALY: Networks Launch ID Campaign

Stations Receive Pre-Releases Via Ricordi's New Satellite System

ITALY

Many stations in Italy have started receiving new releases and artist information in record time thanks to the satellite service launched by Ricordi promotion manager Tony Vandoni.

Launched on November 20, the service uses the Eutelsat satellite to send music and information to subscribing stations fitted with a decoder and DAT recorder and paying a monthly subscription fee of some US\$85. This will enable specific stations to receive pre-releases early, says Vandoni, while offering numerous other possibilities to speed up and make distribution simpler.

"Each subscriber will have an individual code which allows special material such as exclusive pre-releases to be sent to specific stations only." he says. "Live studio-quality interviews can be arranged with artists anywhere in Europe using a portable uplink disk and the guest listening to the questions down a phone line. This could make enormous savings possible in both time and money for promotional interview tours."

The system can also handle hard copy for news and artists' biographies as the decoder has an output facility for a computer printer connection. Although it is possible to produce unlimited analogue copies via the receiver, the systems will be fitted with a spoil code allowing only one digital copy.

The project has been developed with Lugano-based company Ottosat, which will be uplinking via Switzerland to avoid the more expensive Italian state satellite company Telespazio.

Sony Italy promotions manager Riccardo Usuelli welcomes the new system and admits the company is considering the idea. "It is a very interesting development and an intelligent idea. We are evaluating the cost and interest in the system via stations on our mailing list. Although we don't have a policy of supplying individual stations with exclusive pre-release product, it will be very useful for interviews and special events."

ONCE Debuts Special Station For The Blind

Bfind people's organisation ONCE is launching a radio station for the blind this month. Called Canal II, the station will begin in November transmitting four hours a day Monday to Friday in Madrid, and by December 1 in other cities. Listeners will need a Pta-40.000 (app. US\$300) decoder in order to receive the station.

"Within two years, we hope to have 15.000 listeners who will receive special programmes on blind people's organizations and events in the world, and eventually we hope that all Spain's 40,000 blind folk will be clients," says director general of the net Jose Miguel Vila.

Besides news, the stations will report on the weekly ONCE lottery (one of the biggest in Spain), as well as on education, culture and sport. There will also be features, interviews, the reading of press articles, plays and debates.

ONCE already runs the Onda Cero radio nets, taking fifth place in the news/talk popularity stakes and third in EHR. Neither of the nets gave much coverage to specific information for the blind, however.

ONCE Business Group VP, Juan Carlos Lopez Cid-Fuentes, comments that after Madrid, stations would open in Barcelona, Seville and Valencia by December 1. Six of the Madrid station staff are blind.

Vandoni says, "All the major record companies in Italy are interested and we are hoping to commence full service next March depending on the response from the radio stations on our mailing lists."

COPE, Los 40 Princ. Take News/Talk Lead

SPAIN

Cadena COPE surged ahead of Cadena SER in the latest

news/talk survey conducted by Spain's Instituto de Comunicacion Publica (ICP-Research). The net rose 300.000 to 2.8 million listeners, while SER's news/talk climbed 100.000 to 2.6 million since the July-September period.

Onda Cero came third with nearly 2.4 million, while Antena 3 radio continued its slump to 1.3 million, down 300.000 from the summer and a huge two million down on its 3.6 million audiences in April-June 1992. State-run RNE's Radio 1 was fourth in the news/talk league with 1.9 million.

Los 40 Principales is still by far the leader in music radio nearly 3.3 million listeners. Next highest is the all-Spanish Cadena Dial, also part of the SER group, with one million. The struggle for the third spot is a close race between EHRs, with SER-owned M-80 at 674.000 listeners and COPE's Cadena 100 with 624.000. Fifth formula net was Onda Cero Musica with 579.000.

ICP figures, based on a telephone survey of 6.602 people, showed a fall in total radio audience of 300.000 from the summer to a total of 18.1 million in September and October, with 11.4 million listeners for news/talk, 6.7 million for EHR and the others for mixed formats. The figure is well below the 20 million reached in January-March 1993.

CSA Increases Checks On Morals On The Air

Broadcasting authority the CSA has been gathering a reputation as moral guardian in the French radio industry, following clampdowns on programmes at Skyrock and Fun, and the issuing of a recent letter to Fun complaining about its programme "Les Delires Des Cauet."

Fun president Benoît Sillard received a letter from the CSA after a DJ at the station told a listener to pull out the receiver in a public phone booth. Writes CSA president Jacques Boutet, "This kind of incitement to wreck public property is unacceptable and reflects an irresponsible attitude, especially since Fun targets a young public."

Sillard says that this specific sequence in the programme was a sketch, that the listener had to prelend to earry out the action, and that no damage was done. He calls the letter "ridiculous," adding, "The least the CSA could

have done was to call me to inquire before writing to me and making this letter public."

The move follows other episodes in which Skyrock's "Turlututu" programme about sex was dropped after CSA criticism about crude language, and Fun's evening programme "Diffooloir" was finished in October.

Comments one French radio executive, "It was about time to think about who is appointed at the CSA and how. The CSA has been very useful in pacifying the radio and TV world. The way members of CSA are currently picked (three members, including its president are appointed by the President of the Republic, three by the president of the House of Representatives and three by the president of the Senate) doesn't reflect the audiovisual world and the changes it is facing. A real change in the selection of members is needed. I suggest that the CSA should be composed half of professionals and half of members named by the government.

Germany's Burgeoning Dance Market

With artists such as Haddaway, Snap, Culture Beat and Captain Hollywood Project dominating the charts across Europe, Germany has now established itself as one of Europe's leading dance markets. There has been a proliferation of dance artists with crossover appeal from Germany over the last two years, securing their entry into sales and airplay charts, their commercial sound securing success in other territories.

Once the stronghold of the independents. dance music is now increasingly becoming a priority for major record companies. The majors are investing more and more m dance music, seeing it as one of the most successful areas of international exploitation. Many have set up their own dance labels, while others prefer to leave

mercially-oriented label. We aim to mirror new trends and produce our own produet, The advantage of being an independent is that you are closer to the cutting edge of the music scene and can recognise new trends much earlier than majors. We live the music that we work-we are much closer to the scene and to the pulse of the dance market. Martinsohn says that securing a joint

Sony Germany's latest dance coup has been with Culture Beat whose single Mr. Vain has topped sales charts in nine countries across Europe and in Australia and is presently number 44 in the US singles chart. (Torsten Fenslau, the DJ/pro-

ducer behind the act, was tragically killed in a car accident earlier this month, see M&M. November

Culture Beat is not only Sony's best-selling dance act, but also its biggest local act this year. Mr. Vain has sold over two million copies, while the album Serenity has sold 600,000 over copies

Sony established its own in-house dance label Dance Pool some five years ago. Says artist marketing director Hubert Wandjo, "We were the first major company to create our own dance department. About seven years ago we realised that dance was becoming very important so we decided to give it more attention. We then started up the Dance Pool label, bringing in dance experts who knew the scene and now the dance department functions as a microcosm within Sony Germany. Dance is treated on a level footing with other genres in the company, whereas 10 years ago it played a very minor role within CBS.

Sony has around 12 local acts on its dance roster with the three priorities being Culture Beat, Jam & Spoon (see review page 10) and B.G. The Prince Of Rap.

Dance is high priority for the international exploitation department, says Wandjo. "We are much more aggressive with dance than with regular pop music in international exploitation as we have good local repertoire in this department."

Polydor Germany's biggest hit has been with techno band U 96. The single Das Boot topped the charts across Europe last year and now Poly-Gram US is tak-

ing a serious interest in the act. Comments head of Polydor's "Progressive" department Tim Renner, "Polydor 'Progressive' has been moving heavily towards the dance market over the last five years. Dance is a real priority of this department and we invest a lot of our budget in dance. We created the Urban label for our dance acts in January this year and in its first year, we scored a 3% share of the regular

German sales chart-mostly down to sales of our three biggest acts U 96, Intrance featuring D-Sign (see review page 10) and Leila K."

Urban has also linked up with two indie labels-Low Spirit (the label of famous DJ Westbam) and, since the start of November, Superstition Records, an

"underground" label in Hamburg. Renner says there are 15-20 dance acts on the Urban roster, with present priorities including new signing Cloud 7, Italian act Love 4 Sale, Marc 'OH, Pascal Device and East German DJ Marusha (Low Spirit), who hosts her own show in the former DDR. Renner says most of the dance acts have crossover potential. "Dance acts are particularly suited to crossover as dance fans aren't interested in where the music comes from, but whether it's good or not. A record either works on the dance-floor, or it doesn't." Renner sees the key dance centres as being Rotterdam, Brussels, Stockholm, Berlin and Frankfurt. "Dance music is very much a Continental movement now-dance music from the UK has become very dated."

East West Germany is now placing more priority on dance music, having established its own dance label Ultraphonic one year ago. Ultraphonic A&R manager Oliver Lübbering says Ultraphonic is doing very well for such a new label and has already scored national success with Deadly Sins licensed from Italy, whose debut single reached number 39 in the German charts and number six in Austria, selling over 50:000 copies. Other priorities on the label include Prince Etal (featuring Marky Mark). Weather Girls, Paris Underground, E.M.S. and Lonnie Gordon.

Warner Germany established a dance department three years ago. Warner distributes the Eye Q label, home of techno/dance DJ Sven Väth, who has already had cross-over hits in the UK and US with L'Esperanza. There are around 20 local dance signings at Warner with priorities including Sven Väth, Sir Prize, Energy 52, Back 2 Back and Damage Control. according to dance/black product manager Andreas Kebernik. All Warner dance product is worked under the banner of Club Culture. Warner will be placing more importance on thence in future and restructuring the Club Culture department says marketing director/deputy MD Bernd Dopp, "We'll be placing more emphasis on local dance product and its international exploitation. A major company, on the other hand, can offer an independent a larger distribution and marketing service, on a scale it could not otherwise afford.



The single crossed over to the US, reaching number 13 in the Hot 100 Singles chart (licensed to the Imago label) and is presently number 26 in the UK chart. The album Love ts Not Sex has sold 200,000 copies in Germany and has done particularly well in France and Seandinavia. A&R director Peter Cadern says that he does not see Intercord as an "indie" and that its structure is more like that of major companies. Creating internationally-successful nets is not the label's main goal, "As much as we like crossover hits, we like to concentrate on the underground scene too, as in many instances underground records eventually cross over, I see dance as today's popmusic, Intercord was among the first companles in Germany to recognise the importance of dance music and forge deals with international labels and to also build up local dance repertoire.

Major companies have such hig repertoires that they don't have the time to spend on individual acts." D. Bobo's album Dance With Me has sold 80.000 units, while the single Somebody Dance With Me sold 426,000 units, crossing over to become a hit across Europe and reaching gold sales in Sweden Switzerland and Austria. In December D.J. Bobo is performing alongside Od. ture Beat and Haddaway at a special dance festival tour in Germany.

Hot Chocolate Goes Strictly Euro Dance

Hot Chocolate? Wasn't that that group with the bald singer Errol Brown, with the distinctive silk voice, Al on every jukebox in the '70s with disco hits like "Emma, You Sexy Thing" and Every One's A Winner"? Yes, but Brown is no longer with the band, having embarked on a solo career. Replaced by longtime fan Greg Banis, the soulful pop outfit has re-emerged in Germany, and has subsequently undergone a style change to contemporary Euro dance, or "Strictly Dance" as their new album on Polydor says.

GERMANY by Robbert Tilli

The post-Errol Brown days of Hot Chocolate, surely radiate a lighter shade of brown, because new singer Greg Banis branches away from the beaten path of the old hits and confidently presents the curcently hip Euro dance style. This radical departure from trademark Hot Chocolate 70s style almost makes a new band out of them. Blindfolded, nobody would have said that Time Will Tell and You Got Love not that there is anything wrong with them-are Hot Chocolate songs. The clearest link with the past is to be found on the track Meganix, a medley of assorted past hits, originally recorded for promo for radio programmers to announce Hot Chocolate concerts in their town without having to fall back on the old Errol Brown vocal tracks.

One would think that marketing and promotion-wise two problems have to be overcome. It is hard to market a band without its public face, and it is even barder when the music is not what the old fans expect. The question remains whether the band had not better taken a new name or

changed its name slightly, just like Slade recently did by adding II to its name to avoid legal difficulties after frontman Noddy Holder had left the band.

Germany international Polydor exploitation/promotions manager Polly Schlodtmann denies any complications

and points to the 16.000 units already sold. "Brown is no longer with the band, so what can you do? Besides various 'Greatest Hits' compilations on have RAK/EMI] kept the name Hot Chocolate alive. In opinion our remaining band members have progressed with time. We hope that the audience is open-

minded for the new music, and the initial sales figures are very promising in that respect. We're now pushing the album like hell to our affiliates.

The band's manager, Munich-based

Heinz Gross has never considered a name change. "Brown sold the name to his old For reasons of continuity, new singer Banis is not that different from Brown. We wanted another falsetto, but for the rest it's all new. These people understand the market. Record buyers are mainly under 25 years of age, so that's what they go for. After a 10-year gap you can't rely on the old fan base anymore, because apart from the Christmas purchases most of them stopped buying records a long time ago.

Band leader, guitarist Harvey Hinsley wants to proof that Hot Chocolate-a dance outfit avant la lettre-is still relevant today's dance market. Adds Gross, "What they aim for is at least one 'Haddaway or Culture Beat success.' The

new single Cry Little Girl is even remixed by the latter. If they would be in it for the then they money, should have accepted the offers from varisupermarket chains to record an album in the old style, but that wouldn't be a challenge. set up Belgian companies, running an adaption of the French programming broadcast via PTT three from within Belgium; others have been able to advance little further than negotiating agreements with existing local stations, who pick up their satellite signal directly from the French headquarters.

Until now, private radio has hald to struggle for a position in the pubcaster-dominated market, and full-blown commercial networks have been an impossibility for legal reasons. Against this background satellite-delivered programming from French networks has proved a cost-effective

way for small stations in south Belgium to lure advertisers with successful formats. With private stations relegated to the 100-108 range on the FM band, transmission power of a mere IkW and a general restriction on full network link-ups with more than five stations (unless overruled by the CSA), private networks cannot cover the whole of south Belgium. The problem has been worsened by regulatory hiatuses which have left stations to battle it out on the cramped 100-108 FM band, and have lead to unregulated horse trading between local stations and large French networks,

The imbalance between the weak Belgian privates and the strong Prench programming, broadcast on signals as strong as

8kW is one of the main complaints raised by private broadeasters in South Belgium. Comments Daniel Soudant, secretary general of the association of French-language commercial sta-tions GRIB, "The private sector in France has enjoyed far more freedom than in Belgium, with much stronger signals and the economic strength of forming large networks. Adding an extra outlet over the border in Belgium is relatively cheap and easy for a large operator, but it represents a serious threat to the weak Belgian privates. Now that the broadcasting landscape is opening up and becoming more European, all operators should at least be given the same rights and technical freedoms to allow a fair and healthy competition."

Awareness of these inconsistencies has been heightened in the recent weeks by the shutdown of Chérie FM and Europe 2 in Brussels following complaints submitted to the Belgian PTT of interference of local signals. This appears, however, to be another episode in the mud-slinging which has intensified in the run-up to the new frequency plan, succeeding only in worsening entente cordiale. Says Marc Pullain, directors of Chérie FM holding company Pacific FM in Paris, "Chérie has been operating successfully in the area for over four years without causing any complaints, so the sudden sanctions on two French operators seems very suspect. Pressure has been building up against us ever since [Bel-RTL MD| Jean-Charles de Keyser's call to keep French operators out of Belgium, which is totally unfair considering RTL's huge stake in French broadcasting.

No frequencies have been allocated in south Belgium since January 1, 1992, and the radio community is now in a state of limbo since most radio licences expired in March 1993. The delay is partly attributable to changes in the south Belgium parliament last year, when culture minister Bernard Anselne moved to a regional government position, handing over his seat to new culture minister Ello DI Rupo.

The CSA received around 200 applications for private licences in November 1991, all of which are still pending decisions. An intermediate radio report published at the end of October (as part of the Carrefours de l'audiovisuel) identified 11 network operators present in the territory (see table, tight), of which some four or five will be authorised to expand full nets on the territory, if proposals contained in the report are carried through, on signals expected to be around 5kW.

Radio advertising revenues are healthy. In the French-speaking market, at around Bfr1.02 billion (npp. US\$2.9 million) for 1992 and media analysis estimate it big enough to support four to five commercial networks alongside the pubcaster. Revenues for 1993 for the whole of Belgium are expected to be 7% up on last

year, accounting for 8.5% of total ad expenditure—the third highest portion in Europe. Meanwhile, figures released by ad sales house IP reveal that advertising on private networks Contact. Nostalgie and Bel-RTL rose by some 50% this year.

this year.

Comments Jean Paul Deplus, assistant to the culture minister, "Belgium will open up to commercial networks such as they exist in France, Modifications to the wording in the radio charter will transform the status of radio in French-speaking Belgium. Until now the official charter has equated a radio with a single frequency; the term is now being changed so that a radio is conceived as a whole company. There will be no limit to the number of stations a network may operate."

This will radically change the halance of power in the pubcaster-dominated radio industry. State radio broadcasters RTBF and BRTN enjoy a range of privileges which ensure an unchallenged domination of audiences and ad revenues, including national use of 50 of the 350 frequencies across Belgium and access to both advertising and a government subsidy. RTBF advertising revenues for 1992 reached Bfr664 million, which was almost twice that of all private stations combined (Bfr356 million).

Industry opinion varies as to the significance of the radio review. Some see it as a political move on Di Rupo's part to appear to address problems and to allow dissatisfied broadcasters to express their gripes. Others fear that once a comprehensive overview of the private sector is available, the French nets will start a full-blown move to eat into Belgian advertising.

Meanwhile, the French operators are not in a position to formulate development campaigns until the outcome of the review. ACE web RFM has closed down its outlet in Liège in the face of the current uncertainty, but hopes to enter to the territory when the guidelines are clearer. Skyrock France development manager Jean-Michel Gaignard says the net has plans to expand in Belgium, but that there must first be the grounds for discussion. "If the legislation will allow us to open additional franchises in Belgium, we will be ready to talk with potential Belgian partners."

Europe 2 decided not to be put off by a lack of official permission and began full Belgian operations in September this year, having been transmitting French programmes from Paris since January. But, says network director Eric Degand, "It is very difficult to plan developments and investments without knowing what is going to happen. Things are out of out hands at the moment, and we can only hope we are one of the networks allowed to operate."

Whatever the current uncertainties, it seems sure that if the proposed changes go ahead, at least three French networks are likely to be included in the plan.



An ecstatic Benoit Sillard, president of Fun, admits the results "exceeded all our wishes. We made many radical programming changes in September and were waiting to see how they would fare. These ratings really strengthen our strategy."

Fun's 7.7% share of the 15-49 domographic has put it in third place in that category, behind full-service AM web RTL (15.1%) and NRJ (10.8%), but ahead of full-service net Europe 1 (7.4%).

The strategy to reach an older audience has paid off, says Sillard. A new demographic balance has been reached, with a third of the audience in the 15-19 group, and the remaining two thirds over 20. "We see major growth in the older demo," says Sillard.

At other music networks, Europe 2 added some 200,000 daily listeners to reach a 4.9% cume share. GM Martin Brisac says this rise owes a lot to the new schedule implemented by the new programme director Guy Banville. Gold webs Nostalgie and Chérie both gained slightly (+0.2%), while EHR M40 hit the 2% level.

Says M40 GM Javier Pons. Reaching the 2% mark for the first time is psychologically important and it means that the station now represents something in the eyes of advertisers. What pleases me is that we have also been able to increase our average listening time from 92 to 112 minutes. Now we have to confirm

Fabrice Carlier, in charge of the radio and cinema department at Mediametrie, says this ratings period "was a very good vintage for radio and for some stations that reached historic records."

Carlier says the increasing number of listeners is a "permanent" trend. "For the past years, we have seen an increasing number of listeners tuning in to radio," he says. "It has been more acute this time, maybe because the period was rather dense for

news programmes. Thi trend also affected other authoriting media such as TV."

Alain Neuville, marketing director for ad rep firm IP Radio, which sells ad space for RTI. Fun, M40. Sud Radio and Wit FM, adds that the increase in total audience occurred during "all periods of the day and all demographics."

or I AM to the soft rap of MC Solaar and Jimmy Jay, the galaxy of French rap is becoming as varied as the home of the genre, while a new French rap language is attracting international attention.

Right in the footsteps of MC Solaar, so far France's best-selling rap act, comes Soon E-MC, whose self-described "rap cool" is starting to invade airwaves not only in France, but in many European countries. EMI France has just issued his first album Atout... Point De Vue, which also includes tracks from last year's six-track EP Rap, Jazz Soul. The EP has sold 30.000 units in France and has been released in 17 countries. Atout was also simultaneously released on November 16 in 18 European countries, while the first single O.P.I.D. was sent out on November 2.

Soon E-MC is proving to be a strong personality, and his album reflects his interest in "real" instruments and his taste for fine melodies and eclectic grooves. EMI A&R director Jean-Jacques Souplet says what seduced him was Soon E's attitude, his musical vision and the intangible "some-thing different." He says, "I think French rap has now a real identity. But I didn't sign him because rap was fashlonable. I like this musical genre and I like the way he approaches it. He is a stage musician and I am convinced he has a capacity for international development. I think that he has changed a lot in a year. He has deliberately taken a jazzler turn. He knows where he has to go.

Adds BMI France GM Michel Liberman, "This mini-album started an international buzz. I think what Soon E-MC delivers is truly original. Rap is a strong musical movement and France is starting to be recognised as a source of talent, as highlighted by Guru's willingness to rap with MC Solaar in Jazzmatazz. Soon E-MC is one of these artists who has the capacity to cross the boundaries. France is a special country for this music; Arrested Development has done extremely well and we are breaking Guru's Jazzmatazz Volume 1 as well as US3's Hand On The Torch. There is something happening in France for this type of music."

Liberman says marketing and promotion for Soon E-MC will be centred on radio airplay, the video and live shows. A video, shot by German filmmaker Percy Adlon, was picked by music TV chan-nels M6 and MCM. The single has already been welcomed by many radio stations, including EHR outlets NRJ, Fun and Skyrock. "Hard to get better radio coverage." smiles Liberman.

Laurent Bouneau, pro gramme director for Skyrock, plays the song twice a day, as does Christian Lefebvre, music programmer for EHR web M40. Comments Bouncau, "Last year. we were one of the few and maybe the first of the national networks to play Soon E-MC. At that time, we felt we were alone in supporting him. As we are faithful to the artists we play, it was natural to play his new single. I would even say that it would have been hard not to play it. Besides, the song has a very catchy melody."

Adds Lefebyre, "We have never been afraid to play rap on M40. Acts like Arrested Development, Kris Kross and MC Solaar have found their share of airplay here. Rap is a style that has the support of the young public we target and I don't see why we shouldn't play it."

Rap is still facing some problems crossing over to softer formats, however, Christian Savigny, music programmer for ACE net Europe 2, says it's "hard for a station like Europe 2 to play rap. There is a big gap between our musical colour and rap, even when performed by people like MC Solaar or Soon E MC, but nothing is closed."

On the concert front, Soon E-MC's booking agent, Bernard Batzen from Programe, has set up a tour which will include three concerts in Pacis at the Passage du Nord Ouest in December and in the suburbs of Paris, followed by an international tour in January-February 1994 and a French tour in March-April. A series of performances in summer festivalsin France and abroad next summer will also be added.

Last year, Soon E-MC played as opening act for Gangstarr, Arrested Development and Alpha Blondy with a limited stage show. Now, he's supported by a 14-member band.

The German public in Cologne during last year's Pop. Komm got a glimpse of his live performances for two concerts one of them being an open air show before a crowd of thousands. "Public reaction was incredible, especially when you take into account that they had never heard of him," recalls Sophie Cayre, in charge of the international development of EMI France's local repentoire. She says international marketing, coordinated by EMI's continental European office in London, will be adapted to each country.

Liberman says each country will adapt its marketing to the local territories. "Some will focus on clubs like Spain or Germany, others on live appearances like Scandinavia, others will try to push it on radio like Italy. We will push him wherever is needed.

Janet Again

While Phil Collins once again breaks his own and M&M's record by collecting 147 playlistings with Both Sides Of The Story (one more than last week), Janet Jackson now enters the top 10, helped by the biggest point gain of the week. Again, the third single from janet, is doing especially well in the UK, Denmark, Finland, Holland and Poland (62-100% penetration in those territories). Jackson's current expansion is found in Norway, Belgium, Germany, the UK and Denmark. Her most successful single on EHR to-date was Thai's The Way Love Goes, which topped this chart during five weeks earlier this year (issues 21-25).

This week's new material in the top 20 includes Michael Bolton's Said I Loved You...But I Lied at number 14 and Mariah Carey's Hero at 15, positioned two places above its predecessor, Drean Lover. Carey's new offering is,tied with Ace Of Base as Most Added leader of the week (20 each) and also is the week's highest climber, jumping 14 places. Poland and the UK are the best supporters of Hero at the moment (over 90% penetration of reporters), while Denmark. Norway and Italy form the second league with less sensational, though still respectable figures.

Following their high entrance in the Chartbound section, Ace Of Base (the other Most Added leader) are set to enter the Top 40 next week. The Sign, the fifth single from their album Happy Nation, is playlisted at 42 EHR stations, 45% of which are reporting it for the first time—a good speed for a start. Denmark, Sweden, Germany and Norway are leading the way, with penetration ranging from 42% to 75%. Certain platinum pubcasters in Belgium and Finland, however, are also championing

the song (BRTN Radio Donna and YLE 2/Radiomafia, respectively)

As predicted last week, this week's highest new entry in the EHR Top 40 is grabbed by Elton John & Kiki Dee, whose rendition of the Cole Porter-written True Love lands at number 27, helped by 45 stations, one third of which are located in the UK. Other countries showing initial interest in the duet are Holland, Spain, Norway. Belgium, Italy and Portugal. True Love is clearly heading for a top 3 position during the Christmas season, if not the number one spot.

The remaining new chart entries are booked by **Heart** and Wet Wet Wet. Heart's Will You Be There (In The Morning) debuts at 32, with a 51-station roste. It is the lead-off single from Desire Walks On, the first new material in over two years from this Canadian, US-signed band and their first to join the EHR ranks. As yet. Denmark has jumped on the new record the most (90%), followed by the UK and Switzerland (over 60%).

Wet Wet Wet's Shed A Tear, the appetiser for their newly released End Of Part One - Their Greatest Hits, and one of the two sole new songs on that compilation, kicks off at 33, with emphasized airplay in the UK (86%).
