- 5. Talk to outsiders who have special knowledge or appear frequently in the news
  - Minority groups
  - Public officials
  - Business leaders
  - College professors
  - Librarians
- 6. Form in-house committees to address specific questions
- 7. Compile a small library of reference books, and use them
  - Dictionaries (several of them)
  - Language books
  - An atlas
  - Almanacs
- 8. Be able to defend every item in the book
- 9. Brace yourself for lots of tedium in the research and writing
- 10. Be prepared for lots of grumbling and criticism
