Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organiser are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

It is mandatory for players on the reserve list that wish to be considered for promotion, to submit the pre-arrival negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate to spainworldtour@badminton.es and events.admin@bwfbadminton.org dated 72 hours prior to arrival in Spain This also includes players living in Spain. This test is at the player's own cost. If the pre-arrival negative test certificate has not been submitted for a player on the reserve list, the next eligible reserve (i.e. reserve who has submitted pre-arrival certificate) will be contacted instead.

All reserve players must then arrive in Huelva and undertake the arrival test at the official hotel by **12:00 on Monday 17 May** in order to be eligible to compete on Tuesday and / or Wednesday. This test will be paid for by the host, for players who are promoted to the main draw.

A limited number of additional accreditations passes for approved Team Officials will be available for purchase at a fee of USD\$150, charged to the respective Member Association, and payable at the tournament. The additionally accredited Team Officials will have to bear the cost of the mandatory PCR tests conducted in connection with the tournament. The current price of a PCR test in Spain is between 90-120 €.

The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be USD\$100 on each occasion, charged to the respective Member Association.

The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation, or to anyone refusing to take a COVID-19 test when requested or, if there is a serious breach of COVID-19 safety measures, or any other breach of regulations.

The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.

Medical Services

A medical officer and physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament, free of charge to players.

Anti-Doping

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any

	medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

4. Travel & Visa Details

Transport

Due to COVID-19 testing arrival is allowed only on Saturday 15, Sunday 16 May or Monday 17 May (12:00 latest).

Please be aware that arrivals on Monday 17 May are very unlikely to be able to practice in the competition hall before their first-round match on Tuesday or Wednesday.

Arrival is allowed only with a negative PCR test (not older than 72 hours) in English.

<u>Updated April 8th</u>: Pre-arrival negative COVID-19 PCR test means 72 hours from the moment that the sample is taken until your arrival to Spain.

Visas

If a visa is required to enter Spain, we can provide a letter of invitation to assist with your application.

Please complete and return the Visa Support Request Form by Saturday 1 May 2021.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association will only communicate with a Member Association, and the hosting Member Association will only provide a visa support letter if the form is completed accurately and comprehensively, and supporting documentation is provided, where requested.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association accepts no responsibility for withdrawals made due to late or refused visa applications.

It is the responsibility of the Member Association to apply for the necessary visas in sufficient time, and all matters should be directed to the Embassy in charge. Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into Spain; the final decision is made the Government of Spain.

COVID-19 Protocols

1. Spain Entry Requirements

1.1. All information about the current requirements to entry to Spain is available here: https://www.spth.gob.es

What do I have to bring with me to pass the sanitary control at the airport?

Before traveling to Spain, make sure you have signed the form, on the https://www.spth.gob.es or in our mobile app. With this you will get the Health QR Code that you will have to show (paper or mobile) at the airport health control to be able to continue your trip.

If you sign the form from the app, it will appear in the 'My Travel' section, in addition to receiving an email that you can print.

All players and team entourage must submit a pre-arrival negative Covid-19 PCR test **72 hours before their arrival** to Spain to the following e-mail: spainworldtour@badminton.es and events.admin@bwfbadminton.org. This includes players living in Spain. It is recommended to keep a physical copy of the certificate in case it is needed at the airport or arrival point.

<u>Updated April 8th</u>: Pre-arrival negative COVID-19 PCR test means 72 hours from the moment that the sample is taken until your arrival to Spain

If travelling from a designated risk country then it is also a requirement to show the test result to the immigration authorities on arrival in Spain.

1.2. **Countries under travel restrictions:** As of 1 March 2021, people travelling on flights and ships from UK, Portugal, South Africa and Brazil are not permitted to enter Spain. The prospectus will be updated as and when new information is available.

<u>Update April 8th:</u> People travelling from the **UK** are now permitted to enter Spain to participate in the Spain Masters however a letter is required from the organising committee. Please complete the **non-Schengen form** and return to the organising committee by 1 May.

People arriving by flight from any airport located in Brazil, South Africa, Botswana, Comoros, Ghana, Kenya, the Mozambique, Tanzania, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Peru and Colombia to any airport located in Spain, with or without intermediate stopovers, must be quarantined for the ten days following their arrival, or during their entire stay in Spain if it is less than that period. It may be suspended on the seventh day if the person undergoes a diagnostic test for active infection with a negative result. **Participants of the Spain Masters are not exempt from this policy.**

1.3. **Non-Schengen countries:** All participants travelling from outside Schengen Area need a certificate from the Spain Masters organization to travel to Spain, so each team must fill and send, in advance, **the applicant form** with their names, surnames, passport ID and travelling dates (arrival and departure). Deadline for sending this information is Saturday May 1st.

2. Insurance

Specific COVID-19 insurance is not currently required to enter Spain. However, all participants must have personal insurance covering any situation included Covid-19 hospitalization, quarantine and any other costs. The Local Organising Committee is not responsible for any insurance costs related to COVID-19 during the tournament.

3. Hotels

It is a condition of entry that all participants must stay in the official hotels listed below.

4. COVID-19 testing

The COVID-19 testing programme will be carried out as follows:

- All players and team entourage must submit a pre-arrival negative Covid-19 PCR test **72 hours before their arrival** to Spain to the following e-mail: spainworldtour@badminton.es and events.admin@bwfbadminton.org. This includes players living in Spain. It is recommended to keep a physical copy of the certificate in case it is needed at the airport or arrival point.

<u>Updated April 8th</u>: Pre-arrival negative COVID-19 PCR test means 72 hours from the moment that the sample is taken until your arrival to Spain.

- On arrival to the official hotel an arrival Covid-19 PCR test will be carried out. Players and team entourage are not permitted to leave their hotel rooms until a negative result has been obtained (up to 24 hours). For this reason, players are not allowed to practice until a negative PCR test is received from the local host.
- On Friday 21st May all players and entourage will be tested again to ensure the Green Zone is continuously free from infection. Players do not need to quarantine whilst waiting for the results.

5. Face masks

Faces mask are mandatory in Spain, at all times everywhere at any place except in your hotel room

More information will be distributed before the tournament.

6. Positive test protocol

In the event of a positive test the participant and direct/close contacts are required to follow the instructions of the LOC, BWF and the local authorities at all times which may result in players being withdrawn from the tournament More information on these protocols will be released closer to the event.

7. Reserves

It is mandatory for players on the reserve list that wish to be considered for promotion, to submit the pre-arrival negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate to spainworldtour@badminton.es and events.admin@bwfbadminton.org dated 72 hours prior to arrival in Spain This also includes players living in Spain. This test is at the player's own cost. If the pre-arrival negative test certificate has not been submitted for a player on the reserve list, the next eligible reserve (i.e. reserve who has submitted pre-arrival certificate) will be contacted instead.
