This summary of the results of the April 1992 Parliamentary General Election was compiled from information provided by and returns made by the Deputy Returning Officers for the various constituencies. Their names and the addresses of their principal offices for the purposes of the election are given on page 2.
- 2. On pages 5 to 21 the candidates' descriptions given are those contained in the candidates' nomination forms.
- 3. The electorate figures given are the actual numbers of persons entitled to vote on 9 April 1992.
- 4. + before the name of a candidate indicates a member of the previous Parliament.
- 5. \* before the name of a candidate indicates a forfeited deposit.
- 6. Percentages where given are rounded up or down to the first decimal place.
- 7. Averages where given are rounded to the nearest whole figure.
- 8. The total number of candidates was 100.
- 9. 17 of the candidates standing were members of the previous Parliament.
- 10. 16 of the successful candidates were members of the previous Parliament.
- 11. 38 candidates forfeited their deposits.
