EASY LACE SCARF

Finished size: About 8" by 54". You can increase or decrease the length of the scarf by follow the pattern until the scarf is the desired length. You can increase the width of the scarf by casting on more stitches in multiples of 4.

General Guidelines Glossary of terms

Materials:

Needles: Size recommended on yarn wrapper Yarn: Any soft, warm washable worsted weight

Tapestry or varn needle for weaving in ends

Directions:

Cast on 32 stitches.

Pattern Row: * Knit 2, yarn over, Knit 2 together through the back loops*. Repeat from * to * to end of row.

Repeat this row until have reached until desired length, being sure your finished length is a multiple of 3. Bind off loosely. You can add fringes at top and bottom.

Finishing:

Weave in all ends.

Bless your completed project with a hug and your love. It will provide comfort, healing, and hope for the recipient.
