## Rancho Santa Fe Residents for Safer Roads

Residents for Safer Roads, or RSF RSR is a group of Rancho Santa Fe Covenant residents who are deeply concerned for the safety of residents, preserving the rural nature of RSF, and protecting the value of our properties.

The RSF RSR feels that reducing the speed limits and monitoring the present road signs and rules would be a step in the right direction.

We propose the changes listed below:

- A maximum of 35 miles per hour speed limit be applied to more covenant roads. Many roads with 40 or 45 mph speed limits do not appear to have taken into account that residents' driveways open directly onto these roads or our increase in daily traffic.
- A review of the accident records in order to determine where to install additional road signs for safety, including but not limited to, roving electronic speed monitors, lighted "horse/pedestrian crossing" signs and additional stop signs on heavily accessed and thoroughfare roads.
- Increase CHP presence on highways in the Ranch. Could their part-time coverage be better distributed to provide a stronger deterrent to traffic violators?

Because traffic continues to increase on our roads as development increases, immediate action is required to preserve the safety, character and value of our rare and unique community.

We ask for action from our Association, its board members, and the RSF Patrol supervisors to address and provide additional solutions and funds to address these concerns.
