

ARCHBISHOP CHRISTOPHE PIERRE

Archbishop Christophe Pierre was born on January 30, 1946 in Rennes, France. He completed his primary education in Antisirabé, Madagascar, and his secondary schooling in Saint-Malo, France, and in Marrakech, Morocco. He attended the Major Seminary of the Archdiocese of Rennes (1963-1969) and the Catholic Institute of Paris (1969-1971).

He did the Military Service from July 1965, to October 1966. He was ordained a priest on April 5, 1970, in Saint-Malo, France and incardinated in the Archdiocese of Rennes. He was Parochial Vicar of the St. Peter and St. Paul Parish in Colombes, Diocese of Nanterre, France (1970-1973).

He has a Masters in Sacred Theology (Paris, 1971) and a Doctorate in Canon Law from the Pontifical Lateran University, Rome (1973-1977).


He completed his studies at the Pontifical Ecclesiastical Academy, in Rome (1973-1977), and started his service in the Diplomatic Corps of the Holy See on March 5, 1977.

He was appointed first to the Pontifical Representation in New Zealand and the Islands of the Pacific Ocean (1977-1981). Subsequently he served in Mozambique (1981); in Zimbabwe (1982-1986); in Cuba (1986-1989); in Brazil (1989-1991); at the Permanent Mission of the Holy See to the United Nations in Geneva, Switzerland (1991-1995).

He was elected Titular Archbishop of Gunela on July 12, 1995, and received the Episcopal Consecration on September 24, 1995, in Saint-Malo, France.

Archbishop Christophe Pierre was appointed Apostolic Nuncio to Haiti, on July 12, 1995, where he served until 1999. He has been the Apostolic Nuncio to Uganda (1999-2007) and then, the Apostolic Nuncio to Mexico (2007-2016). He was appointed as Apostolic Nuncio of the United States of America by His Holiness, Pope Francis on April 12, 2016.

Archbishop Pierre speaks French, English, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese.

Unofficial translation of the Apostolic Letter of Appointment of Msgr Jerome Feudjio as Bishop of Saint Thomas, Virgin Islands

FRANCIS BISHOP SERVANT OF THE SERVANTS OF GOD

To Our beloved Son, **Jerome Feudjio**, from the clergy of the Diocese of St. Thomas and, until now, Vicar General there and Rector of the Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul, appointed Bishop of the same See, greetings and Apostolic Blessing.


Foreshadowed by many events of the Old Testament and established by Jesus Christ, the Catholic Church diligently proclaims the Good News to those searching for God and, through the ministry of bishops and priests, offers to them the blessing of eternal salvation. Consequently, the principal and complete responsibility of the Roman Pontiff in his administration for the universal Church of those matters pertaining to instruction and guidance throughout the world, demands that suitable Shepherds be appointed to dioceses lacking an Ordinary. For this reason, We at this time, direct Our attention to the community of Saint Thomas, which owing to resignation of Our Venerable Brother Herbert A. Bevard, stands in need of its own rightful Bishop. And so, beloved Son, We have decided to entrust this office to you, given that you are outstanding in spiritual life, practical experience, sound faith, scholarship, charity and effective pastoral works.

Therefore, upon consultation with the Congregation for Bishops, from the fullness of Our Apostolic authority and by virtue of this Letter, We appoint you Bishop of the Diocese of **Saint Thomas**, conferring upon youthe rights and obligations, which belong to this mission. You may receive Episcopal Ordination anywhere outside the City of Rome from any Catholic bishop, the liturgical norms being observed. However, prior to this, as established by ecclesiastical law, you must make the Profession of Faith and take the Oath of Fidelity toward Us and Our Successors in this See.

Finally, it is Our heartfelt desire that you ardently carry out your ministry to teach the Catholic faith and to safeguard its doctrine, under the protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who "is not only an example for the whole Church in the exercise of divine worship but is also, clearly, a teacher of the spiritual life for individual Christians" (Saint Paul VI, Marialiscultus21).

Given in Rome, at the Lateran, on the second day of March, in the year of the Lord two thousand twentyone, the eighth of Our Pontificate.



Bishop of Saint Thomas in the Virgin Islands



Arms Impaled.

Dexter, Arms of the Diocese of Saint Thomas, Virgin. Azure, semé of Mullets Argent, a Sword pointed to the chief over all two Keys in saltire Or, all behind bordure wavy of the second.

Sinister, Personal Arms of Bishop Jerome Feudjio. Tierced per fess, in chief Vert an "M" Azure and Argent, in center Gules Lion sejant Or, in base Or "Tree of Peace" of Cameroon Vert.

Explanation

The dexter impalement (on the viewer's left) displays the arms of the Diocese of Saint Thomas of the Virgin Islands (*Dioecesis Sancti Thomae in Insulis Virgineis*), which is comprised of the islands of Saint Thomas, Saint Croix, Saint John, and Water Island in the U.S. Virgin Islands. The blue field and the silver (white) wavy border around the dexter side of the shield, symbolize the Caribbean Sea where the Virgin Islands are geographically located. The thirteen five-pointed silver (white) stars represent the original thirteen colonies of the United States, of which the Virgin Islands are an unincorporated and organized territory. The diocese of Saint Thomas was established in 1977 and is within the ecclesiastical province of Washington, D.C.

The crossed gold keys are an attribute of Saint Peter and represent the keys of the kingdom of heaven (Matthew 16:19); the gold double-edged sword, an attribute of Saint Paul, is a reminder of his martyrdom. Peter and Paul are the patron saints of the cathedral in Charlotte Amalie, located on the island of Saint Thomas, which is the seat or *cathedra* of the bishop of the diocese.

The sinister impalement (on the viewer's right) displays the personal arms of Bishop Jerome Feudjio. The tri-colored field carries the colors of the flag of Cameroon: green, red, and gold. Bishop Feudjio was born in Fonakeukeu, Dschang, Cameroon. It is here, where his life in the Church began with his Baptism, first reception of Eucharist, and Confirmation. In Cameroon he began his education at Catholic institutions of learning and his seminary training. Ordained a priest for the diocese of Saint Thomas in 1990 at the cathedral of Saint Peter and Paul, the placement of the "flag" of Cameroon next to the arms of the diocese of Saint Thomas speaks of the beginning of his life in sacramental ministry to the Church. In a unique heraldic twist, one could see the two distinct arms as one in the ecclesiastical life of Bishop Feudjio.

In the chief green field, is the blue and silver letter "M," an emblem for the Blessed Mother. The letter has "fleury" or "fleur-de-lis" (quite literally, "flower of lily") shaped edges. The fleur-de-lis is also a symbol of Mary under her title of the Immaculate Conception. Blue and silver (white) are traditional colors of the Blessed Mother, symbolizing truth and sincerity, faithfulness and purity. The letter "M" also carries at its heart a cross, symbolizing the Cross of Redemption.

In the flag of Cameroon, green represents the rich and fertile soil of the country and the hope that it brings. Thus, the combination with the Marian "M" speaks not only of the devotion of Bishop Feudjio to the Blessed Mother, but also is a tender reminder of his time in Washington, D.C., when he was invited by then Father Sean O'Malley, O.F.M. Cap., whose Irish heritage is also recalled in the green field, to stay at San Francisco House of the Archdiocese of Washington. Jerome also attended the Oblate College which was then part of the Washington Theological Consortium and completed his studies in Philosophy and Theology for the priesthood. In 1987, he joined the Oblates of Mary Immaculate and made his temporary religious profession.


The center field of red speaks of the dignity of Saint Jerome, the patron saint of Bishop Feudjio. Saint Jerome (4th Century) is often depicted in the red of a cardinal. Though this office did not exist during his lifetime, the color is used to denote dignity. The lion sejant, here in gold, is seated on its haunches with forepaws on the ground. According to legend, while giving a lecture to his students in Bethlehem, a lion came to Saint Jerome, limping. Everyone fled except for the saint, who welcomed the lion and removed a thorn from his paw. The lion remained with Jerome until his death. The symbol of the lion is one of oldest designations for courage, and the color gold speaks of generosity.

The base field of gold, which represents religious freedom and peace in Cameroon, carries the emblem of the "Tree of Peace" of Cameroon. This emblem is of particular importance to Bishop Feudjio and is very close to his heart.

Behind the arms is placed a gold cross pattée, symbolic of the rank of a bishop; the stem of the cross is wood, symbolizing the staff of a shepherd. Over the whole achievement is the green hat or galero of a bishop with twelve tassels pendent on each side in three rows.

For his motto, Bishop Feudjio chose, "Vivit in me Christus," taken from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Galatians (2:20), in which the Bishop expresses the essence of his life as a Christian and as a priest in service to the Body of Christ: "Yet I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me."

The Most Reverend Jerome Feudjio

The sixth bishop of the St. Thomas Diocese comes to his new position well prepared for the role, having spent more than 30 years working with, and dedicated to, Virgin Islands parishioners, and having learned early in life to deal with challenge.

Bishop Jerome Feudjio was born in 1955, to the late Justine Komegou and Tontsa Tonleu Etienne, in Fonakeukeu, Dschang, Cameroon, a country then striving for its independence.

"There was civil unrest in Cameroon," he said. "My father died when I was five years old." From his mother's arms, he watched his home burned. And then he began a "nomadic life," moving with his mother



from one uncle's household to another and growing up as much with his cousins as with his siblings. His older brother, Seraphin Tazoo, lived with an uncle in another city. His sisters, Martine and Christine, also went to live with other family.

A bright spot of his childhood, he says, was his Catholic education.

"The missionaries opened the door to us," he recalled. They offered schooling at an affordable cost. And more than that, they offered kindness and love. And, as it turned out, they set him on his life's path.

After graduating from St. Albert Catholic School in Dschang, he entered St. John College of the Christian Brothers of Quebec in Mbanga, graduating with a degree in bookkeeping in 1972.

"I met the Christian Brothers in school," he said, adding that he was impressed by their lifestyle. Their good example sowed the seeds of his vocation.

He became a postulant in the religious order, the Congregation of the Fathers of the Sacred Heart. In the 1970s, he attended Saint Apostles Seminary in Otelé, Cameroon, and the Major Seminary of Nkolbison in Yaoundé, Cameroon.

His journey to the priesthood was interrupted briefly when his brother died and he came under pressure from some relatives to abandon his path so he could marry and carry on the family legacy.

A cousin who lived in the U.S. sent him a plane ticket and he flew to Illinois to study accounting and English.

But his religious calling was intense.

In 1980, he had an encounter that strengthened his resolve and eventually led him to the Virgin Islands.

In Washington, D. C., he met then-Father, now Cardinal Seån O'Malley who encouraged him to complete his theological training, offered a place to stay at the San Francisco House for foreign seminarians, and enlisted him for a ministry to Haitians and French-speaking Catholics who had recently migrated to the D.C. area.

His interest in social justice and the rehabilitation of troubled youth led him back to Illinois to complete graduate studies in the Administration of Justice at Southern Illinois University, including an internship at a transi-

tional rehabilitation center, Southern Illinois Community Correctional Center. Many years later – well after he became a priest - he would return to pursue graduate studies in Rehabilitation Administration.

Throughout the 1980s, he continued his journey to the priesthood, making his religious profession with the Oblates of Mary Immaculate in 1987, a year before he first moved to the Virgin Islands.


Once again it was his mentor, Cardinal O'Malley, then Bishop of St. Thomas, who guided him. His first service in the Virgin Islands was as the campus minister at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic School.

In 1990, then-Bishop O'Malley ordained him to the priesthood, and he began a long and varied service to the St. Thomas diocese. Among the many positions he has held over the years are:

- * Both rector and administrator of Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral
- * Pastor of Holy Family Parish
- * Director of Vocations
- * Vicar for Clergy and Religious
- * Both Vicar General and Chancellor of the Diocese
- * Diocesan Finance Officer
- * Member of the Board of Consulters
- * Member of the Board of Directors of Catholic Charities of the Virgin Islands
- * Assistant Principal and religion and French teacher at Sts. Peter and Paul School
- * Coordinator of Prison Ministry
- * Coordinator of Catholic TV Ministries

In 2002, Pope John Paul II named then-Father Feudjio a Chaplain of His Holiness and conferred on him the honorific title of Monsignor.

In addition to his spiritual ministry and pastoral duties, he has overseen and/or been instrumental in the completion of numerous construction projects, from the renovation of St. Anne's chapel and the Holy Family parish to the years-long restoration of the historic Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral. He credits the "visionary support" of the late Bishop George V. Murry at the inception of the Cathedral project and, for the last 10 years, the "ardent and passionate leadership" of Bishop Herbert A. Bevard, who made the cathedral restoration a priority of his tenure.



As Director of Vocations, he helped to recruit more than 60 percent of the priests now serving in the diocese and was instrumental in inviting members of the Daughters of the Holy Family from Cameroon to minister in parishes and Catholic schools in the Virgin Islands.

At the announcement of his appointment in March, the new bishop thanked Pope Francis "for the honor and trust he places in me" and his immediate predecessor, Bishop Bevard "for his leadership, love and dedication during his episcopacy."

He also thanked the people of the diocese, saying, "Your faith and your dedication to the Church have ignited my zeal and motivated me to joyfully offer my contribution to this, our diocese."

A BRIEF HISTORICAL OVERVIEW: THE CHURCH IN THE VIRGIN ISLANDS

The Catholic Church in the Virgin Islands began with the advent of Christopher Columbus, the first Catholic to land on the shores of the "Virgin Islands" in 1493, on the island of St. Croix. The actual history of the Church started in 1650 when a French expedition from St. Kitts invaded St. Croix and took the island away from the Spanish. Shortly after the island was conquered two Jesuit priests established a mission on St. Croix at the request of the French Regent. One priest died and the other withdrew to St. Christopher. There was sporadic visitation of clerics along the way but many did not remain long because of frequent illness and death.

In 1650, the French Dominicans signed a contract to establish a mission on St. Croix. Two priests, Frs. Mamez le Clerc and Fr. Dubois, stayed on the island until they were replaced by two other priests in 1666. One of the new priests died within a month upon arriving on St. Croix. Nonetheless, they did establish a mission in the Salt River area on St. Croix where the first church in the Virgin Islands was built. The exact location of this site, called Les Jacobin Estate, is yet unknown.

Circa 1672, the Danish West Indian and Guinea Company settles on St. Thomas and establish Lutheranism as the official religion of the Danish West Indies. Limited religious toleration was granted to other religions. Thirteen years later, in 1685 Denmark proclaimed religious tolerance for Jews and Catholics, allowing only private worship. In 1687 a census on St. Croix showed there were three churches, one male religious and 1,162 Catholics. Eight years later the number of churches on St. Croix increased to four, with two priests and 1,227 Catholics, of which 551 were slaves. While in 1701, Fr. Jean Baptiste Labat found only one white and a few black slaves on St. Thomas were Catholic.

Fast forwarding to 1752, a Catholic plantation owner name Nicolas Tuit, newly arrived from Montserrat, requested permission to build a church and invite sufficient priests to care for Irish and Englishmen working on his plantation. He appealed to the Irish Dominicans for help. The first Dominican missionaries arrived in 1760. In 1755 Nicolas Tuit built a church in Christiansted, St. Croix. However, because of the high demand for priests, Mr. Tuit invited secular priests to the mission. These secular priests were to be chaplains to the planters and as such did not interfere with the work of the Dominican mission.

In 1773, Fr. Peter Sellarolli was named the first pastor on St. Thomas, conducting Masses in rental homes. Five years later, in 1778, Fr. Cellon gave the first baptism on November 22 in the newly constructed church site of Sts. Peter and Paul in Charlotte Amalie. This was known as the French Church and records were kept in French. A disastrous fire broke out in the town in 1804, destroying 600 buildings including the Roman Catholic Church, as well as the Dutch Reformed Church and the Jewish Synagogue. In 1825 another massive fire in Charlotte Amalie once again destroyed the Catholic Church on St. Thomas. A new Church was consecrated in 1828.

In 1804, the Catholic Church in the Danish West Indies was placed under the Diocese of Baltimore, with Archbishop John Carroll as the Oridanary of the Diocese. Later in 1819 the Church was placed under the Diocese of Trinidad, under Bishop James Buckely.

St. Ann's Church on St. Croix was consecrated in 1823. St. Patrick's Church in Frederiksted, St. Croix, was dedicated in 1846 by Archbishop Richard Smith of Trinidad. The Catholic Church in Christiansted, St. Croix, was officially erected in 1849 and given the name of Holy Cross. Later, in 1850, the Diocese of Roseau was established and the Catholic Church of the Danish West Indies was transferred to the new Diocese.

Due to a schism in the church on St. Thomas, in 1856 Pope Pius IX requested the Redemptorists to take charge of the church of St. Thomas. The first Redemptorist arrived in 1858. The Redemptorists have been serving in our Diocese ever since. Fr. Louis Buggenmons, C.SS.R, started a parochial school, a Catholic hospital and a college on St. Thomas, which closed its doors in 1877. Meanwhile in 1865, construction of the Catholic School in Frederiksted was begun. In 1866 the Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny arrived in St. Thomas. They were the first administrators of the Catholic hospital and also opened a free school for girls. Of special note, in 1880, Fr. Michael Naughten, pastor of St. Patrick's Church in Frederiksted, was appointed bishop to replace Bishop Rene C.M. Poirier, CJM, of the Diocese of Roseau, who died two years before. In 1881, Fr. Charles Warren Currier, C.SS.R, who was born on St. Thomas was ordained a priest. He became the bishop of Montanzas, Cuba, in 1913. In 1891, the Redemptorists took charge of the church in Frederiksted and later in 1897 they took charge of the Church in Christiansted and built a school.

In 1900, Bishop Naughten died and was later replaced by Fr. Phillip Schelfault, pastor of Sts. Peter and Paul church on St. Thomas. Bishop Schelfault, in 1914, invited the Sisters of the Missionary Canonesses of St. Augustine, later renamed the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, ICM, to take charge of the Redemptorist schools on St. Croix. The chapel of St. Anne's on St. Thomas was dedicated in 1921 for the French speaking people. There was a transfer of the Virgin Islands from the Diocese of Roseau to the Diocese of San Juan, Puerto Rico, in 1924. Later in 1926 the Chapel of Our Lady of Perpetual Help at Estate Elizabeth was completed and dedicated. The first Catholic high school, Sts. Peter and Paul was started on St. Thomas in 1946 with the first graduating class in 1950. Also in that same year St. Joseph Chapel on St. Croix was built by Fr. Mark Knoll.

In 1960, the Prelature of the Virgin Islands was established with Redemptorist Fr. Edward J. Harper as the first bishop. Bishop Harper served in this capacity until his retirement in 1984.

The Prelature of the Virgin Islands was attached as a Suffragan to the new Metropolitan See of Washington, DC, in 1965. The Prelature of the Virgin Islands was established as a Diocese in 1977 with Bishop Harper as the first residential bishop of the Diocese of St. Thomas in the Virgin Islands. On August 2, 1984, the Rev. Sean O'Malley, OFM, Cap., from the Archdiocese of Washington DC, was ordained Coadjutor Bishop of the Diocese. This was the first time a bishop was ordained in the Virgin Islands. Bishop O'Malley was installed as the second Ordinary of the Diocese in October 1985. In the same month Bishop Edward Harper retired as Bishop, after 50 years of priesthood and twenty-five years as Bishop of the Diocese. Bishop O'Malley served until he was summoned by Pope John Paul II to the Diocese of Falls River, Massachusetts. On December 12, 1993, Fr. Elliott Griffin Thomas became the first diocesan priest of the Diocese of St. Thomas to be named Bishop of the Diocese. He served as bishop until 1999, when Bishop George Murry, auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Chicago, was named Coadjutor Bishop of the diocese. Bishop Murry was later transferred to the Diocese of Youngston, Ohio in March of 2006. Bishop Herbert Bevard was installed as the fifth Bishop of the diocese in 2008 and served until 2020.

Reverend Monsignor Jerome Feudjio, is being ordained as the sixth bishop of Diocese of St. Thomas in the Virgin Islands on April 17, 2021, where he has faithfully served for over 30 years.
