

Industrial System Designation Order 23975-D02-2018

Inter Pipeline Propylene Ltd. (Inter Pipeline), pursuant to Order 23543-D03-2018,¹ was granted an industrial system designation for its operation at the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Project industrial complex located northeast of Fort Saskatchewan in the southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 55, Range 22, west of the Fourth Meridian.

Fengate Central Utilities Block GP Inc. (Fengate), by Application 23975-A001 registered on October 15, 2018, requested approval from the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to the industrial system designation to reflect the transfer of ownership from Inter Pipeline to Fengate.

The Commission, pursuant to Section 4 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and sections 2(1)(d) and 117 of the *Electric Utilities Act*, approved the application in Decision 23975-D01-2018,² and granted to the operator this order for an industrial system, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, the *Electric Utilities Act*, and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The industrial system shall be comprised of the following major electric facilities:
 - A 102-megawatt (MW) power plant consisting of two 51-MW natural gas-fired cogeneration units, designated as the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Central Utility Block Power Plant.
 - 240-kilovolt (kV) Heartland Petrochemical Complex Central Utility Block Cogeneration Plant Substation.
 - A 13.8-kV and 4.16-kV distribution system.

2. Fengate shall apply to the Commission for approval, pursuant to sections 14 and 15 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, for the additional transmission facilities that are included in the subject industrial system.
3. The electric energy produced from and consumed by the subject industrial system is exempt from the operation of the *Electric Utilities Act*.
4. Fengate shall notify the Commission of any proposed changes to the subject industrial system, including changes in ownership that may result in contravening the principles and the criteria set out in Section 4 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and applied by the Commission in its decision to grant the application.
5. Fengate shall notify the Commission of any proposed changes to the subject industrial system that may affect other parties and (or) adjacent occupants, and shall make an application for the proposed changes pursuant to relevant sections of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, if the Commission so directs.

Order 23543-D03-2018 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this order, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this order, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
