

# Riding the Electric City Transit

It has never been more convenient for our senior citizens and disabled citizens. Every bus is now permitted to leave its regular route (up to 3/4 of a mile) to pick up and drop off these riders who live outside the regular routes.

## Request a Bus

You may request a bus by calling the Electric City Transit at least one hour before you wish to travel. Passengers should indicate if they require a wheelchair lift or other assistance. Persons with hearing impairments can use the Ready Line by calling 1-800-735-2905

Wait at a designated bus stop. A bus will pass a designated bus stop every hour.
