- Pursue a robust Tourism Marketing plan that is vertically integrated to the tourism product
- Reinvigorate the Yachting Industry
 - 1. Guaranteed safety at the ports
 - 2. Greater collaboration with stakeholders to attract more yachts to Antigua and Barbuda

AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES:

- Focus on achieving an acceptable degree of food and nutrition security
- Greater incentives to farmers to grow more food and help reduce the import bill, including providing secure leases for farmland with the right to construct their residences thereon
- Create all necessary conditions to encourage a shift towards the agricultural sector as a means of promoting self employment
- More support to farmers in terms of subsidies, water supply and infrastructure such as agricultural feeder roads
- Strengthen the framework of the Central Marketing Corporation so there is greater linkage and collaboration with farmers. The CMC will be transformed into a "One Stop Shop" to purchase designated crops from farmers and market these locally and abroad
- Designate a number of cash crops that farmers and backyard gardeners will produce for sale to the CMC to be processed into secondary products in production facilities that will be established for such purposes. These cash crops will include: corn, aloe vera, sea island cotton, sugar cane, and cannabis
- Review existing commodity platforms to enhance access to local and regional markets
- Revamp the schools' feeding program with an emphasis on purchasing from local farmers
- Assistance to fishermen with regard to the cost of fuel and the duty on imported equipment
- Encourage the creation of farmers and fisherfolk cooperatives

EDUCATION AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT:

- Implement a comprehensive Early Childhood Education structure whereby every child between the ages of 0 to 3 years will be afforded the opportunity of a government subsidized early childhood education
- Place greater emphasis on creative arts in primary and secondary schools
- Assistance to parents to offset CSEC costs
- National after school programme where students will be able to pursue cultural and vocational interests
- Prioritize technical and vocational education
- Improve facilities for lifelong learning through continuing education
- Erect Community Centres and Libraries as part of the infrastructure of the Parish Councils
- Stablish a National Internship Council (NIC) and a Youth Training Council
 - Establish a National Skills Development Centre targeting primarily teenage mothers and young parents
 - Develop National Youth Entrepreneurship and Apprenticeship programs

- Improve Sporting infrastructure across Antigua and Barbuda
- Ensure proper maintenance of existing sports facilities
- **Expand existing sports facilities to include a wider variety of sporting disciplines**
- Greater financial support to athletes in all spheres of their professional development
- Greater collaboration internationally to assist more Antiguan and Barbudan athletes to gain International Sports scholarships
- Redesign and improve all facilities to accommodate differently-abled individuals
- Tailored Sports programs to deal with "At Risk" youth
- Encourage the development of Athletic Clubs and strengthen National Coaching Programs

HUMAN DEVELOPMENT AND SOCIAL SERVICES:

- Increase the number of magistrates assigned to the Family Court
- Improve Child Protection Services
- Reform the Juvenile Justice System
- Strengthen the programme that provides for the special care and protection of senior citizens through the government funded "care-givers" program
- Extend maternity leave from the current three months to six months
- Restructure and redesign the programmes at the homes for juveniles in need of protective care
- Undertake all necessary measures to reduce the cost of living to ensure all residents are able to achieve and maintain a decent and comfortable standard of living
- Pursue a comprehensive programme of poverty reduction, alleviation and eradication
- Strengthen social safety nets
- Protection of the vulnerable

HEALTH CARE:

- Strengthen all pillars of the Universal Health Care System from Primary Care to Specialized Services
- Establish a Bureau of Health Standards to strengthen national quality systems at all health facilities
- Enhance research in healthcare to build capacity and promote research in the use of traditional medicine
- *Establish linkages and build partnerships in the area of international health care*
- *Ensure equity in access to healthcare so that no one is turned down or left behind*
- Ensure the healthcare system has sufficient specialists in all areas of healthcare delivery
- Devise a system for early interventions with respect to mental health challenges for juveniles
- Ensure specialists in psychiatric care are available to all clinics and schools
- Optimize the ratio of psychiatric specialists to patients with mental health issues

GOVERNANCE AND ADMINISTRATION:

- Pursue a rigorous and people centered Constitutional Reform
- Enact legislation to establish fixed election dates
- Establish an All Party Tax Reform Commission to design a comprehensive taxation policy based on equity and fairness to all. This Commission will complete its work within the first 6 months of the DNA administration
- *Restructure the public service to eliminate wastage and improve efficiency*
- Devise a project for Public Service Reform with a view to combine all Established and Non-established public servants into a single Civil Service
- Implement a sound local government framework to empower communities and promote civic participatory democracy
- Improve industrial relations and dispute settlement capabilities
- Strengthen oversight of the work of statutory bodies to ensure greater transparency and accountability
- Enact legislation to control, monitor and rigourously police the financing of elections campaigns by political parties
- *Greater collaboration with the media to ensure it plays a critical role in the democratic process*

JUSTICE AND NATIONAL SECURITY:

- Undertake a total revamping of the justice system in an effort to restore confidence in the institutions of justice
- *Strengthen community policing structures*
- Conduct a critical review of the structure and operations of the Police Force, Defense Force and the Prison system
- Reform the management of prisons with the goal of reducing the incidence of recidivism while imparting productive, marketable skills to inmates with a view to promote their rehabilitation on their reentry to society
- *Improve border control facilities to police and improve security at ports of entry*
- Improve technological capabilities within the various systems to facilitate better record keeping across the board
- Ensure that all agencies within the system are given all necessary resources to execute their duties effectively

CULTURE, HERITAGE AND IDENTITY:

- Consolidate the "Antigua & Barbuda Brand" by celebrating the Antiguan dialect as a patrimonial resource
- Advance the incorporation of Antiguan Studies and history as an integral part of the Primary and Secondary school curricula
- *Extend greater support to the national museum and create a national art gallery*
- Encourage youth involvement in the creative arts as a viable and sustainable means of self employment
- Greater effort to preserve national heritage sites and monuments of cultural significance
- *Establish a Cultural Development Foundation*
- Redesign the annual Carnival festivities to reflect a more profound and comprehensive celebration of our people's emancipation from slavery
- Redefine, redevelop and consolidate an authentic Antiguan & Barbudan Identity

- Pursue the development of renewable energy sources. This project will ensure the reduction of the cost of electricity for households and businesses to less than a third of present cost.
- Undertake to build capacity and strengthen resilience to climate change
- *Improve disaster risk reduction capabilities*
- Strengthen legislation to ensure care and protection of the environment to include protection of marine and coastal areas
- Work in close collaboration with regional and international partners in the area of climate change, adaptation and mitigation
- Support the creation of a green economy in all aspects of production.

TRANSPORTATION - LAND, AIR AND SEA:

- Explore possibilities for the construction of new road networks to reduce congestion on major roads
- Undertake a comprehensive road audit with plans to repair and maintain all the nation's roads
- Strengthen the national public transportation system through dialogue with the National Council on Public Transport, the National Transport Board and all other stakeholders
- Implement the fuel price adjustment mechanism to reduce the cost of fuel with a trickledown effect to the consumers
- A reliable and modernized public transport system to serve the needs of residents and visitors alike

- Improved and more affordable transportation services between Antigua and the sister isle of Barbuda as well as neighbouring islands
- Subsidize air transportation costs between Antigua and Barbuda
- *Ensure Air Traffic control services with special emphasis on upgrading the Radar System*
- Ensure compliance with all regulations of the Eastern Caribbean Civil Aviation Authority (ECCAA)
- Enhance all services and systems at the VC Bird International Airport with emphasis on security, maintenance and repair and human resource capacity building in key areas
- Fully operationalize the range of services that can be offered by the Transport Board, including the Vehicle Repair Workshop



HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT:

- Undertake to increase the housing stock throughout Antigua and Barbuda (three tiers model: subsidized, middle income and luxury homes)
- Make residential land more readily available to the citizens
- Promotion of public-private partnerships in housing development projects
- Undertake to construct an efficient sewerage, waste disposal and treatment mechanism
- *Erection of green spaces, recreational parks and playgrounds*
- *Redesign and rebuild St John's as the Capital City of All Antiguans and Barbudans*
- Construct turnkey residential properties aimed specifically at the Diaspora

STRATEGIC EXTERNAL RELATIONS:

- Ensure Antigua and Barbuda's external relations are characterized by a rigourous assertion of the nation's independence and sovereignty
- Undertake to restore Antigua and Barbuda's image and reputation internationally
- *Continue to play a leading role in the regional integration process (OECS, CARICOM)*
- Advance the agenda for South-South cooperation
- Establish deeper diplomatic relations with non-traditional partners in Central and South America, Asia and Africa
- Pursue a rigorous economic diplomacy program based on respect for sovereignty and mutually beneficial development projects
- Restore the quality of Antigua and Barbuda's relationship with key international organizations such as the UNDP, IMF, UN and World Bank
- Restructure the Foreign Ministry and the Foreign Service to eliminate excesses and inefficiency caused by political patronage, to include a policy of rotation of Foreign Service Officers
 - Greater collaboration with and engagement of the Diaspora in promoting Antigua and Barbuda's foreign policy positions
 - Operationalizing the Office of Diaspora Affairs within the Office of the Prime Minister with a view to deepen the role of the Diaspora in national development
 - Greater representation of Antigua and Barbuda and its nationals in the various regional and international organizations.


