My husband worked there for two years. They broke the law of human trafficking by forcibly coercing me into "volunteering" for them and refusing to hear my and my husband's refusals for me to "volunteer." They told me to put up or get out, that they would fire my husband, that they would kick us out of our home, that we would be destitute and financially ruined if I did not do every little thing they wanted of me, including sending me to town to work for the festivals so Agapé could make a profit off my labor as the owner herself told me she was always given money to incentivize her to send "volunteers" to the festivals. They viciously abused me mentally, emotionally, and verbally. They tried to discredit our marriage and they would try to control our social lives outside of work by prohibiting people from talking with us. It was hell, and I've been diagnosed with PTSD, major depression, and an anxiety disorder, all of which I take medications for.

This pushes the final deadline at this time for a guest sermon from any of you to November 30th, 2028 rather than December 31st, 2026 as shown below in previous message.
