

### Fall 2021 Restart Guidelines

1. **Social Distancing:** Classrooms return to 100% capacity, with appropriate social distancing where possible, after considering the latest CDC recommendations.
2. **Mask Use:** Complying with the Governor's latest Executive Order, Collin College will not require the use of masks or facial coverings, but we will leave it to the discretion of each student and employee if they choose to wear a mask. Masks will be made available in each classroom and at campus information desks. For faculty, KN95 masks may be available upon request from division offices or the provost's office.
3. **Vaccinations:** Collin College plans to continue facilitating vaccination clinics at different campus locations this fall. College students, employees, and family members have the opportunity to receive available vaccines on a voluntary basis. 4. **Dual Credit:** Dual credit students and faculty are required to adhere to Collin College COVID procedures when on Collin College campuses. While on ISD facilities or premises, dual credit students and faculty will follow ISD guidelines.
5. **Intramurals:** Intramural events may be limited and will follow these college restart guidelines.
6. **Athletics:** Collin College teams will follow NJCAA guidelines and follow the college guidelines in non-competition facilities. Guests will be allowed at games and matches, but they will be required to follow the college guidelines.
7. **Department-Specific Procedures:** Following current practices, faculty and administrators will continue to collaborate to develop alternate class or section procedures to ensure mastery of skills for specific workforce disciplines. These procedures may differ to some degree from the College's overall COVID response procedures but will be designed to prevent community spread while still achieving the learning objectives of the discipline.
8. **Enhanced Campus Cleaning:** Collin College will continue to provide the same level of PPE and cleaning supplies for all facilities and continue enhanced cleaning services on all campuses. The bipolar ionization and UV sanitization equipment are installed and operational at all of our campuses.
9. **Campus Services:** All Collin College campus services have been reopened for regular business hours.
10. **Faculty Office Hours:** Faculty are expected to resume on-campus office hours. Faculty may seek an alternate physical location on their campus other than their office to

facilitate better social distancing for office hour purposes. Faculty teaching online or in hybrid sections may use online office hours.

11. **Faculty and Staff Travel:** Travel for professional development is open to faculty and staff. Employees are advised to follow published travel and quarantine restrictions of the destination and airlines along with following safety protocols. Faculty planning to travel should follow the Council on Excellence's (COE) travel instructions and guidelines.
12. **Student Travel:** In addition to following the current student travel guidelines, published travel and quarantine restrictions for airlines and destinations will be followed. Student travel group sizes may be limited.
13. **Conference Facilities** are open to internal and external events and will follow the college guidelines.
14. **Case reporting:** Students, faculty, and staff who experience symptoms associated with COVID or who have been diagnosed with a positive Coronavirus test should continue to follow current reporting procedures available at [www.collin.edu/covid19](http://www.collin.edu/covid19).
15. **Spring & Summer 2022:** We will continue collaborating with the AY 2021-22 Restart Task Force to evaluate directions from the CDC and Texas State Health Services in developing guidelines for Spring and Summer of 2022.
