#### **B.3** Type of Allocation of Quota Places:

The quota place/s is/are allocated to the NOC. The selection of athletes for its allocated quota places is at the discretion of the NOC.

## C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force and only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Olympic Games. This includes Rule 41 of the Olympic Charter (Nationality of Competitors).

#### C.1 Additional IF Requirements:

# C.1.1 Qualification Criteria Olympic Winter Games (OWG) (ref: IBU Event & Competition Rules Art. 1.4.3.1 - https://www.biathlonworld.com/downloads/)

To gain the right to participate in Olympic Winter Games (OWG) events, an athlete must have 180 IBU qualifying points or less as of 16 January 2022 (after the World Cup 6 in Ruhpolding/GER) or fulfil one of the following criteria during the current (2021/2022) or previous (2020/2021) season:

- a. Compete in two (2) competitions earning 150 IBU Qualifying Points or less at the IBU Cup, Open European Championships (OECH), World Championships (WCH) and/or World Cup (WC) in the Sprint or Individual events, or
- b. Two (2) finishes in the top half of the Junior World Championships (JWCH) not Youth or
- c. One (1) result from each of the criteria a. and b. above.

#### D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

For clarification the term "competition" means a single race (e.g. Sprint), "event" refers to a cluster of competitions held at one site during a contiguous period of days (e.g. WC).

#### **OWG NOC QUOTA LIST**

The "OWG NOC Quota List" is made up by the best 12 single results (Nations Cup points system, WC and WCH competition results) of the 2020/21\* and 2021/22 season and is the basis for the NOC quota allocation through D.1, D.2 and D.3.

Each National Federation (NF) will retain at least the same WC/WCH-Start-Quota (IBU ECR 12.6.1.1 & 15.6.1) as determined from the 2019/20 season World Cup Nations Cup Score throughout the whole Olympic Qualification Period (All WC/WCH from 28 November 2020 - 16 January 2022).

The best 12 results consist of:

- Six (6) Sprint competitions
- One (1) Individual competition
- Three (3) Relay competitions
- One (1) Single Mixed Relay competition
- One (1) Mixed Relay competition

If there is an equal number of points between any athletes on the list on 16 January 2022, the best placed athlete will be the one who won more first places, and if there is still a tie, who won the most second places, etc. If, after following this procedure, the tie cannot be broken, a tie will be declared in accordance to IBU ECR Art. 15.8.5.

<sup>\*</sup> Taking into account the possibility of changes in participation due to COVID-19 related issues, the IBU Event Task Force (ETF) may decide to exclude Nations Cup points and/or IBU Qualifying Points from a competition, for purposes of Olympic Quota determination, when six (6) or more NFs of the top 20 ranked nations, of the respective gender from the 2019/20 World Cup Nations Cup Score, are not competing. The ETF may also consider other factors in participation such as under-utilized quotas or other abnormalities that make the scoring very inconsistent with normal performance data for many NFs. This exception only applies to events taking place during the 2020/21 season.

#### Decision principles:

- 1. If not announced differently every competition pointed out in this document will count;
- 2. If after the final event registration/accreditation on-site the situation is obvious (six (6) or more NFs from top 20 Nations Cup Score 2019/20 not attending) the decision if the competition will **not** count will be made and announced before the event's first competition;
- 3. If an abnormal situation occurs at a competition (e.g. an usually high number of athletes that have not started or not finished) the decision if the competition will **not** count will be made and announced latest on the day after the respective competition.

#### Affiliation of two (2) or more IBU National Federations to the same NOC

In the case where two (2) or more IBU National Federations (NFs) are affiliated to the same NOC the following rules for quota allocation will apply:





For the OWG NOC Quota List ranking purposes only the best ranking NF will be taken into consideration for the allocation of quotas to the affiliated NOC for D.1, D.2 or D.3.

For IBU Qualifying Points List ranking purposes, the top athletes from the affiliated NFs of the NOC will be taken into consideration for the allocation of quotas to the corresponding NOC for D.4.

If the NOC which is affiliated to two (2) or more NFs earn quotas in D.1, D.2, D.3 or D.4, the selection of the athletes occupying the quotas are at the discretion of the NOC and the selected athletes will participate at the Olympic Winter Games as part of that NOC's delegation.

#### **HOST COUNTRY PLACES**

#### **Individual Competitions**

If the Host Country has not been allocated any quota places through D.1, D.2, D.3 or D.4 or has only been allocated one (1) quota place through D.4 and it has eligible athletes according to Section C, it will receive up to a maximum of two (2) quota places per gender issued through D.4 to start in individual competitions. In such cases, up to a maximum of two (2) quota places will be deducted from the overall quota of 12 allocated in D.4.

#### **Mixed Relay Competition**

The Host Country is eligible to start in the Mixed Relay Competition provided they have sufficient athletes meeting the Athlete Eligibility requirements listed in C above.

#### E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

Following each qualification event, IBU will publish the results on its website http://biathlonresults.com.

The final OWG NOC Quota List will be published on 16 January 2022.

For all NOCs earning quotas through the D.1, D.2, or D.3 above, IBU will inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places by 17 January 2022. The NOCs will then have until 19 January 2022 to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph **G. Qualification Timeline.** 

The final IBU Qualifying Points List will be published on 16 January 2022 after the World Cup 6 in Ruhpolding/GER.

For all NOCs earning quotas through the D.4 above, IBU will inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota place(s) on 17 January 2022. The NOCs will then have until 19 January 2022 to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph **G. Qualification Timeline.** 

#### F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

#### REALLOCATION OF UNUSED NOC QUOTA PLACES

IBU will inform the respective NOCs of their reallocated quota place(s) on 20 January 2022.

If any allocated quota place(s) is/are not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline on 21 January 2022 or is/are declined by the NOC, the quota place(s) will be reallocated to the NOC of the next best ranked athlete according to D.4. The quota place may be reallocated to NOCs that have earned only one (1) quota in that gender or to a NOC that does not yet have a quota.

## REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Unused Host Country Place(s) will be reallocated according to D.4.
