Col. Jason N. Schramm is the Commander of Space Delta 1, Training, headquartered at Vandenberg Space Force Base, Calif. DEL 1 is responsible for developing U.S. Space Force personnel to prevail in a Contested, Degraded, and Operationally-Limited space environment through basic training, initial skills training, warfighter follow-on courses, and advanced training courses and events.

Col. Schramm was commissioned through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps at the University of Notre Dame in 1998. His career includes ICBM and space operational assignments in the satellite command and control and theater support mission areas. He also served in a variety of staff assignments at the NAF, MAJCOM, and Combatant Command levels, and deployed twice to the Middle East in support of OEF and OIF. He commanded the 533rd Training Squadron at Vandenberg SFB, providing technical training for all officer and enlisted Airmen entering the space operations career field.

Prior to his current assignment, Col. Schramm was Chief, Warfighter Communications Division, Joint Staff J6, the Pentagon, Washington D.C.
