Pub sales of beer struggled against a continued fall in consumer spending. However, consumption stabilised after a number of years of decline, production increased and exports grew.


The report shows how important it is to encourage people back into the great Irish pub, protect the domestic market, and to help foster one of Ireland's great export success stories.




