Property Description Church dedicated to the Birth of the Madonna referred to as Victory Church. It was rebuilt in 1724 replacing an older one which had already been built in 1575 during Mons Dusina's visit. The present church has a centralised plan and is topped by a dome. The church has a polychrome marble altar. The unique facade shows Portuguese-Spanish influence due to the curved pediment. The titular painting shows the Birth of the Madonna. In the church there are two statues of St Joseph and the Sacred Heart of Mary worked by Giuseppe Cali. There are two other statues dedicated to Baby Jesus and the Pieta.
