In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.  This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF GCR 20 – 24. This includes restrictions of certain colors for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per GCR 21.7.

The entry deadline is Tuesday, September 14, 2021 at 23:59, BWF Headquarters time (+08:00 GMT). Late entries will not be accepted.

After the entry deadline, the BWF Online Group Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries.

Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday, September 8, 2021 at 12:00 BWF Headquarters time.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday, Thursday, September 9, 2021 at 23:59 BWF Headquarters time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.

#### Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organizer are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

If a Member Association needs to withdraw any entries once players have arrived in the host city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager in person to the Tournament Referee, or Deputy Referee(s), and must also be confirmed in writing to:

Players on Reserve List that wish to be considered for promotion, must submit pre-arrival negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test certificate to <a href="mailto:teamservices@yonexifb.com">teamservices@yonexifb.com</a> and <a href="mailto:events.admin@bwfbadminton.org">events.admin@bwfbadminton.org</a> dated 72 hours prior to arrival in France. This also includes players based in France. This test is at the player's own cost. If the pre-arrival negative test certificate has not been submitted for a player on the Reserve List, the next eligible reserve (i.e. reserve who has submitted pre-arrival certificate) will be contacted instead.

All reserve players must arrive in France and undertake the arrival test at the official hotel no later than Sunday, 24 October 2021 at 7:00 PM.

#### Transport Information:

Dedicated buses will be available for transfers from the official hotels to the venue and practice hall throughout the week.

#### Procedure:

Courts will be allocated under the referee control on an equitable basis, taking into account the number of entries per Member Association, arrival date and time, PCR test date and time, match schedule, and Team Manager preferences.

Requests for October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> should be made using the <u>THE ONLINE FORM</u>. From October 26<sup>th</sup>, requests should be made with the Team Liaison Officer while arriving in Paris.

Although every effort will be made to meet requirements, we cannot guarantee to accommodate all requests

Before the arrival in Paris, the organization will send the approved schedule to team managers for the first two days.

All players should arrive in Paris on Saturday, 23 October and Sunday, 24 October. Only players competing in the Denmark Open final should arrive on Monday, 25 October. This is due to the COVID-19 arrival test and quarantine until negative result protocol. Any players arriving on Monday must arrive before 11:00 to undertake an arrival COVID-19 test and will most likely not be able to practice in the main hall before their matches on Tuesday / Wednesday.

Where separate Academies or Groups exist, the full allowance will firstly be given to the registered Member Association representatives as referenced in the BWF Statutes. Beyond this, the Academies or Groups must agree who is responsible for the charges and pay prior to receiving the passes.

A limited number of additional accreditations passes for approved Team Officials will be available for purchase at a fee of 150 Euros (incl. VAT), charged to the respective Member Association, and payable at the tournament.

The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be 150 Euros (incl. VAT) on each occasion, charged to the respective Member Association.

The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation.

The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.

The cost of the COVID-19 tests for additionally accredited Team Officials must be met by the respective Member Associations. The cost is **70 €** per test (TBC in the Covid Protocol document), charged to the Member Association.

#### **Medical Services**

A medical officer and physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament, from the 26<sup>th</sup> of October 2021, free of charge to players.

Ice will be available on demand on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to Team Liaison Officer.

## 4. Travel & Visa Details

#### Transport

Due to COVID-19, all transportation must be booked by the organizer in advance of arrival into France. It is essential that you do not use public transport during your time in France.

Complimentary transportation will be provided by the tournament between the official venues: competition venue, official hotel(s), practice venue, and the following transportation hubs:

- Airports: Paris Charles de Gaule Airport (CDG), Orly Airport (ORY),
- Train stations: Gare de Lyon, Gare d'Austerlitz, Gare du Nord, Gare de l'Est, Gare Saint Lazare.

Transport requests should be made through our Accommodation & Transport partner SPARTNER after booking your accommodation and **no later than Tuesday, October 5, 2021, to** <u>transport@yonexifb.com</u>.

Visas

If a visa is required to enter France, we can provide a letter of invitation to assist with your application.

Please complete the <u>VISA SUPPORT REQUEST FORM</u> online no later than Friday, September 17, 2021.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association will only communicate with a Member Association, and the hosting Member Association will only provide a visa support letter if the form is completed accurately and comprehensively, and supporting documentation is provided, where requested.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association accepts no responsibility for withdrawals made due to late or refused visa applications.

It is the responsibility of the Member Association to apply for the necessary visas in sufficient time, and all matters should be directed to the Embassy in charge.

Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into France; the final decision is made the Government of France.

EMA authorized vaccine (Pfizer – Comirnaty, Moderna, AstraZeneca – Vaxzevria, Johnson & Johnson – Janssen, or AstraZeneca – Covishield) :

- Seven days after the second shot for two-shot vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca (Vaxevria and Covishield));
- Four weeks after the shot for one-shot vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);
- Seven days after the shot for vaccines administered to people who have already had COVID-19 (only one dose is necessary).

People who are not vaccinated as descripted above will not be considered as being "Vaccinated" by the French Authorities and must follow the rules specified for "Not vaccinated" people.

## Country classification:

- "Green list" countries or territories: Countries where no active viral circulation has been reported and no relevant variants identified. These are European area countries, plus Albania, Australia, Bahrein, Bosnia, Brunei, Canada, Hong-Kong, Israel, Japan, Jordan, Kosovo, Lebanon, Montenegro, New Zealand, North Macedonia, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Singapore, South Korea, Taïwan, Ukraine, the United States, Union of Comoros and Vanuatu.
- "Amber list" countries: Countries where active viral circulation in controlled proportions has been reported, albeit with no spread of relevant variants. These include all countries not featured on the "green" and "red" lists.





"Red list" countries: Countries where active viral circulation has been reported, including relevant variants. These include the following countries: Afghanistan, Algeria,
Argentina, Bangladesh, Brazil, Colombia, Costa-Rica, Cuba, Democratic Republic of Congo, Indonesia, Maldives, Morocco, Mozambique, Namibia, Nepal, Oman, Pakistan, Russia, Seychelles, South Africa, Suriname and Tunisia.

COVID-19 Protocols on the event and general information will be published by the end of September in order to provide the most recent information about the sanitary situation and the government restrictions the tournament host should expect for the end of October.

The tournament host will however in any case follow the BWF Covid Protocols in order to make the event as safe as possible for the participants. It will be mandatory to use official tournament transport services and stay at the official hotels during the tournament.
