Mini-Baby

Crochet Pattern

Material:

- crochet hook size 2,5
- Catania wool from Schachenmayr in different colors
- fiberfill
- safety eyes 4,5 mm (0,18 inches) or you can embroider the eyes
- sewing needle

Size: The baby has a height of 7 cm (2,76 inches)

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

st - stitch

R - round or row

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet
(or a dc, hdc ...) in each stitch

inc - make two sc in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together with a sc

rep - repeat all stitches until end of round

sl st - slip stitch

sc with color change: change the color on this sc (when you make this single crochet stitch, grab the new color of your wool and pull it through the two loops on your hook).

Note:

Unless indicated otherwise, the parts are worked in rounds. You can start with 2 ch or make a magic ring. The rows should be marked with a thread. Start with the arms and the legs first, because they will be crocheted to the body.

Arms (2 x)

2 x ch

R 01 5 x sc in second chain from hook, **sc with color change** **6**

R 02 4 x sc, dec **5**

R 03 sc in each stitch **5**

R 04 sc in each stitch **5**

sl st, cut the thread and sew it or make a knot. Do not stuff the arms.

Legs (2 x)

2 x ch

R 01 6 x sc second chain from hook **6**

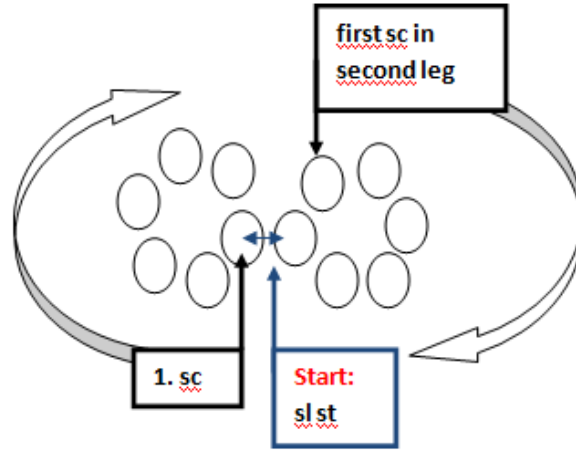
R 02 sc in each stitch **6**

R 03 sc in each stitch **6**

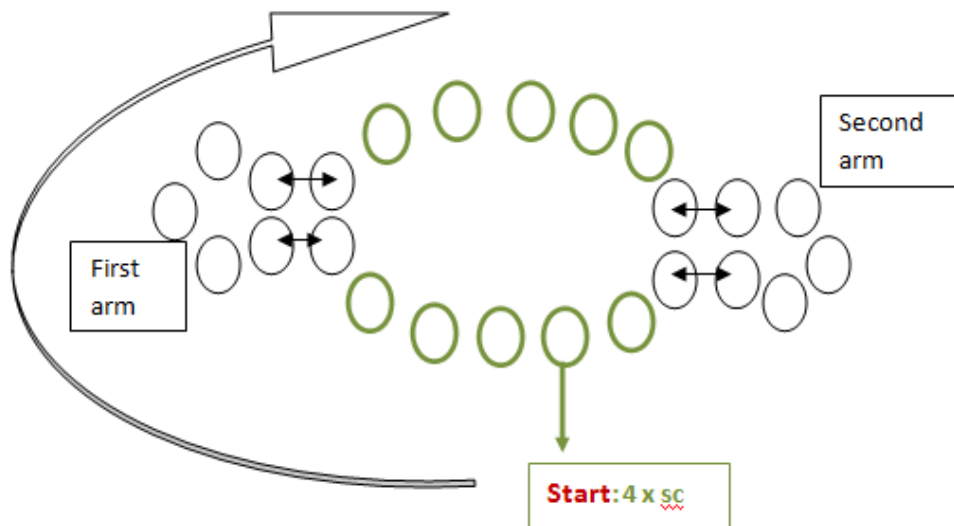
sl st, cut the thread and sew it or make a knot.

Body and Head

- R 01 Hold the legs together and connect them with a sl st.
Then crochet in the same stitch a sc and go ahead and make 5 x sc on the first leg.
Go to the second leg and make 6 x sc on the second leg, put your thread marker inside to mark the rounds. **12**



- R 02 sc in each stitch **12**
R 03 (inc, 5 x sc) x 2 **14**
R 04 **4 x sc,**
hold the arm to the body and crochet the stitches of the arm and the body together with: 2 x sc
then only over the body: 5 x sc,
hold the second arm to the body and crochet the parts together with: 2 x sc,
then make the last stitch only on the body: **sc** **14**



- R 05 sc, dec, sc,
now crochet only over the stitches of the arm: 3 x sc,
then on the body: 2 x sc, dec, sc,
again crochet only over the stitches of the second arm: 3 x sc,
then on the body: **sc with color change** **14**

Congratulations !!! Now you have finished the hard part and the rest is easy!

R 06	(dec) x 7	7
R 07	inc in each stitch	14
R 08	(sc, inc) x 7	21
R 09	(2 x sc, inc) x 7	28
R 10	sc in each stitch, stuff the legs and the body	28
R 11	sc in each stitch	28
R 12	16 x sc, if you use safety eyes, then places the first thread marker for the eye here, 6 x sc, place another thread for the second eye, 6 x sc	28
R 13	sc in each stitch	28
R 14	sc in each stitch	28
R 15	(2 x sc, dec) x 7	21
R 16	(sc, dec) x 7, attach the safety eyes and stuff the head	14
R 17	(dec) x 7, stuff the head again	7
R 18	sc, 2 x dec, sl st	
cut the thread and sew the opening		

Ears bunny(2 x)

2 x ch

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	2 x sc, inc	8
R 03	sc in each stitch	8
R 04	(2 x sc, dec) x 2	6
R 05	sc in each stitch	6
sl st, cut the thread and sew it		

Ears puppy (2 x)

2 x ch

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	(2 x sc, inc) x 2	8
R 03	sc in each stitch	8
R 04	sc in each stitch	8
R 05	(2 x sc, dec) x 2	6
R 06	sc in each stitch	6
R 07	sc in each stitch	6
sl st, cut the thread and sew it		

Muzzle puppy

2 x ch

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	(inc) x 6	12
R 03	(3 x sc, 3 x inc) x 2	18
R 04	(7 x sc, dec)	16
R 05	16 x sl st	16
cut the thread and sew it		

Tail puppy

2 x ch

R 01 5 x sc in second chain from hook 5

R 02 – R 04 sc in each stitch 5

sl st, cut the thread and sew it

Ears kitten (2 x)

2 x ch

R 01 4 x sc in second chain from hook 5

R 02 inc, 4 x sc 6

R 03 inc, 2 x sc, inc, 2 x sc 8

sl st, cut the thread and sew it

Tail kitten

2 x ch

R 01 5 x sc in second chain from hook 5

R 02 – R 06 sc in each stitch 5

sl st, cut the thread and sew it

Finishing

Baby:

Embroider the nose and pull in some threads on the head for the hair.



Dog: pin the ears and the tail to the body and sew them. Embroider the nose to the muzzle, stuff it and sew it on the head. Embroider the eyes if you haven't used safety eyes.



Cat: Pin the ears to the head and the tail to the body and sew them. Embroider the nose and if needed, the eyes.

Bunny: Pin the ears to the head and sew them. Embroider the nose and if needed the eyes.

Here you can see the babies with embroidered eyes. First I didn't like them and so I started another try with safety eyes. But afterwards, I think that both of the eyes are cute 😊
