WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

President Bush has announced that he will renominate Jim Quello to another five-year term as FCC Commissioner. Quello, now 77, has been on the Commission since 1974; his current term expires June 30.

A House Appropriations Subcommittee has voted to delete from the FY 1992 federal budget the \$14 million operating budget of TV Marti. The U.S. government-run propaganda outlet, tethered to a balloon above the Florida Keys, has been plagued by political controversy and technical problems since its inception in 1987. The cuts may still be restored later in the budget process. Money for VOA-operated Radio Marti, also broadcasting to Cuba from the Florida Keys, was not affected by the vote.

The FCC has upheld its grant of a new station application to First Class Communications in Chatham MA. The applicant was originally granted the facility and signed on as WFCC-FM five years ago. Along with other appeals, the competing applicant, Cannon Communications Corp., had sought to expand issues to include First Class's financial qualifications, on the grounds that WFCC-FM has subsequently gone into bankruptcy. Cannon's appeals were all denied.

Also upheld this week: denial of a request by WLBE-790 Leesburg FL for a daytime power increase. WLBE had wanted special temporary authority to raise both day and night powers to counter Cuban co-channel interference. The night power was granted; in denying the daytime increase, the FCC noted that STA changes must still meet regular co-channel interference standards, and WLBE's proposed daytime power would have interfered excessively with co-channel WMRZ-790 in South Miami.

The Commission also denied reconsideration of its recent amendments limiting the amount of money that can be paid out to competing applicants in settling a new station or amended facility proceeding. And, the FCC upheld its previous grant of a new FM in Waco TX to Kennelwood Broadcasting Co., Inc.

ELSEWHERE

More new applications for technology: Montauk NY's FAX-MAX services has asked the FCC for spectrum space to develop data transmissions to remote fax machines. The company wants at least three broadcast channels around 930 MHz to be designated as the "Public Facsimile Broadcast Service." FAX-MAX hopes to have an experimental system on air in the New York City area by October. Transmissions could be received by an unlimited number of fax machines at the same time; the company makes its money off selling the small portable receivers necessary to get the transmissions - and from developing a lucrative new advertising service as well.

ELSEWHERE (Cont'd)

Another new satellite programming service was announced this week. Boston-based "City FM" will be a personality-based hot AC format using prominent Boston-area air talent. Breaks will all be pre-recorded and customized for affiliates. No station signings have been announced yet.

The Radio Advertising Bureau's April ad revenue figures for the radio industry showed a 5.2% increase over April 1990 figures. Revenue figures varied widely from previous months and among different regions of the country. Leading the growth were the Southeast and Southwest regions, both of which have had severe sales slumps in the first quarter of 1991; April figures showed increases over 1990 of 10.9% and 20.0%, respectively.

Press Releases from Hades, Part I: (We read our mail, so you don't have to.) Tom Gammon's KRTY-95.3 Los Gatos CA (San Jose) was placed in a court-ordered receivership May 24. The station's celebratory press release, among other things, quotes KRTY GM Greg Herpin: "...the uncertainty is behind us, we have debt relief and a new funding source. This will allow us to capitalize on our recent gain in ratings and our increasing presence in the San Jose market...a new buyer [will] be able to step into a turn-key operation, with a unique format, strong staff and excellent prospects."

Press Releases from Hades, Part II: KROQ-FM has announced that its three murder-hoax disc jockeys will serve their court-ordered community service sentences providing food to the homeless. The three will spend 149 hours each working for the L.A. Countywide Coalition for the Homeless. M Street wonders: what kind of criminal charges would be facing persons who perpetrated this sort of stunt on the job if they weren't media celebrities? And would their employers be inclined to fire them, or milk the incident for free TV and newspaper publicity all the way through the sentencing process?

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission acted this week to revoke the license of WAST-1600 Ashtabula OH. WAST had sale and technical applications pending, but has been off the air without FCC permission since 1984. Also this week, the FCC's grant of a frequency change for WYMB-1410 Manning SC (see "Facility/Parameters: Grants") suggests that the mutually exclusive license renewal application of WAZQ-920 Orangeburg SC has been denied. WAZQ has also been off the air for several years.

The FCC has told its general counsel to file on the Commission's behalf in a civil court case for the purpose of requesting referral to the Commission questions involving possible "lowest unit charge" rule violations in political campaigns.

CANADA THIS WEEK

The CRTC has announced a plan to review student and community radio station policies to consider possible licensing changes in the next decade. Until the review is completed a freeze is generally in effect for student and community stations; the exceptions are community stations where no other local service is available, and Native community stations.

CKAT-101.9 North Bay ON has applied to change its format from country to pop/soft rock (Group I). The country format would move to CKAT's AM, CFCH-600, which is currently AC. CRTC approval is required for Canadian format changes.

Radio One, Ltd., licensee of CKHJ/CIHI Fredericton N.B., has applied for a network license to rebroadcast CKHJ's country programming from midnight to 6 AM. Radio One this week purchased CJCJ-920 Woodstock N.B.

The CRTC has revoked the license and deleted calls for CIRB-1240 Lac Etchemin PQ. CIRB had been silent for several years.

North American Broadcasting Co. has applied for a license to start a new shortwave station at Morden, Manitoba, with studios in Winnipeg. The new station would operate primarily as a relay facility for various foreign shortwave stations, with two separate transmitters targeting the western and eastern United States.

ELSEWHERE

What do you get when a radio station is all formats to all people at one time? The answer is KDEO-FM Honolulu, as it introduces "Radio Free Hawaii." The plan is to play the top 36 songs each week in heavy rotation, as voted by listeners through in-store voting. About 300 other songs from previous weeks will be included in lower rotations. The station is prepared to play classical and heavy metal if that's what people vote for. According to the Honolulu Star-Bulletin, KDEO hadn't been pleased with the performance of its country simulcast on FM. The format's originator, Norm Winter, runs a chain of comic book and record shops and concedes that "I don't think anybody who's even had any programming experience would ever do something like this."

UPI Wire Service Guild members have accepted a third round of pay concessions through September 14. The vote clears the way for a new consortium to purchase UPI; a deal has been in the works for months.

Technology corner: now comes a car radio that takes voice commands. Sanyo's new prototype, due to be included on a new receiver model and in the stores by fall, responds to call letters or any other commands recorded into the radio's memory and matched with the driver's command. It can also remotely switch to tape or CD. One minor problem: so far, the receiver can only respond to one person's voice.

"Maybe It Will Help Listener Recall" Dept.: New York's Z-100 was hit last week with a firestorm of bad publicity over a morning zoo contest that invited listeners to become a "JAP for a Day." The contest drew a heated public complaint from the Jewish Anti-Defamation League, and other New York media went to town. The worst was a front-page, three-inch Daily News headline: "Vile on the Dial," with the Z-100 logo.

More bad PR for stations: Inside Radio reports that Unidyne's syndicated "Incredible Prize Catalogue" is defaulting on cash prize guarantees to previous years' winners. Winners of part of the million-dollar pot were to receive annual installments for 20 years - but at least some of the 30+ stations that ran the contest in the mid-80's are now having to deal with stiffed listeners.

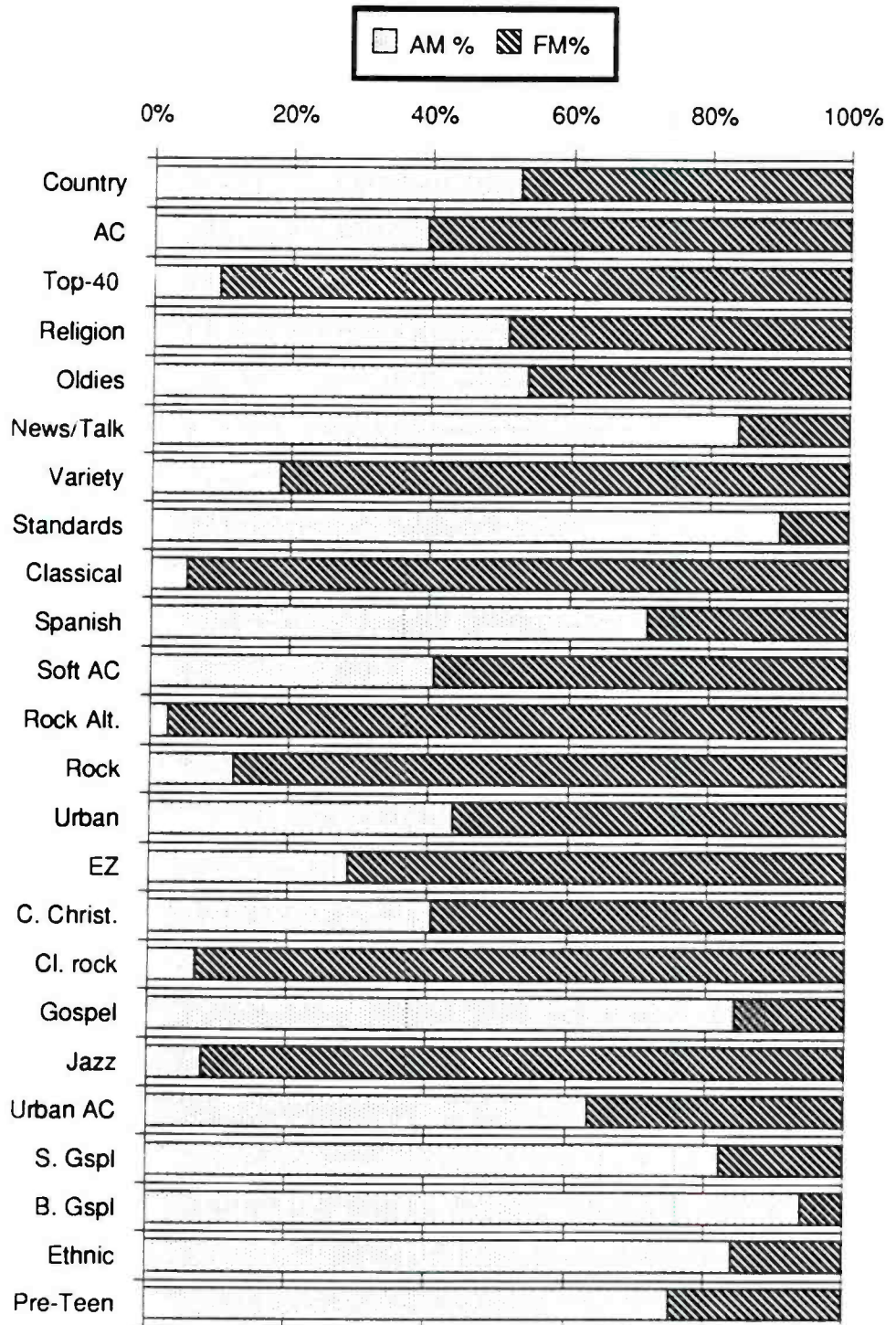

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In a long-awaited report, the FCC last Thursday (6/13) issued its recommendation for the U.S. position on spectrum use for digital audio broadcasting (DAB) to be taken at the World Administrative Radio Conference in early 1992. The Commission, ignoring the L-band recommendation of its own Industry Advisory Committee, came out in favor of setting aside space in both the L-band (1435-1550 MHz) and S-band (2360-2460 MHz) for both land-based and satellite-distributed systems - without specifying how either of the spectrum ranges might be divided. The eventual U.S. position will be a compromise between the FCC, the NTIA (which wants S-band allocations only), the State Department, and other interested bureaucracies (e.g., the Pentagon, which currently has most of the S-band spectrum reserved for hi-tech weaponry). There's no indication as to how quickly a compromise position might be reached. The NAB-endorsed Eureka 147 system would be dependant on new band space - and has had minimal testing in the L-band and virtually no testing in the very-high-frequency S-band. Several other systems under development would circumvent

the whole sticky mess by setting up distribution systems using stations' existing frequencies - but none of those technologies are proven yet, either.

The FCC also launched a major initiative this week to codify political programming policies and is seeking comments on those policies and on current broadcast and cable industry sales practices. Most critically, the FCC is looking for comments on how to handle lowest unit charge requirements, including "how to apply the lowest unit charge provision to a variety of industry sales practices, and the extent to which stations have an obligation to disclose and actually sell to candidates all types of spots and discount privileges made available to commercial advertisers." The proceeding will be accelerated so that a codification can be issued before the next general election; comments are due July 26, replies August 14, for Docket 91-168.

One more FCC inquiry launched: possible improvements in the Emergency Broadcast System. The Commission is seeking ways to incorporate new technology to make the EBS system more reliable and flexible. Among the possible changes: replacing or supplementing the current two-tone system with a more sophisticated system that could convey to receiver circuitry the nature and area of a local or national emergency and trigger the system only in certain locations.

WRSF-105.7 Columbia NC has been given 30 days to meet FCC main studio requirements. The Commission denied an appeal of a previous finding that WRSF was violating main studio requirements by keeping its main business and studio operations 51 miles from Columbia, in Nags Head NC. WRSF had argued, to no avail, that the presence of a full-time office manager and two part-time managers in Columbia constituted its main studio.

In other actions, the FCC: dismissed the appeal by Radio Associated, Inc. for a new FM in Brownsburg IN; denied the appeal of a dismissal for a new FM in Virginia Beach VA by Chesapeake Bay FM, LP; dismissed the petition for reconsideration of a previous dismissal for modification of facilities for KQMB-102.7's CP in Midvale UT.

Another pirate fined: "Radio Free Venice" in Venice, CA, ran at 107.9 MHz. Its operator, Tom Reveille of Venice, was fined \$1,000 for operating an unlicensed station.

CANADA THIS WEEK

The CRTC has denied the proposed sale of CHRC-800 Quebec PQ to Telemedia Communications, which currently operated CKCV-1280/CITF-107.5 in Quebec City. The CRTC objected to proposed overlap in the management of CHOI-98.1 (CHRC's current FM) and CITF; and to the market share the new CITF/CHRC combo would give Telemedia. Telemedia's application had specified that it planned to shut down its unprofitable CKCV-1280 regardless of whether the application was approved; there is no word as to whether CKCV is, in fact, still on the air.

The CRTC also came down hard this week on community station CHOC-92.5, giving the outlet a short-term licence renewal of only eight months. In that time, the CRTC will "give the licensee one last opportunity to demonstrate that it can fulfill the responsibilities of operating a...radio station." CHOC has been given two previous short-term renewals and cited numerous times for technical and program deficiencies.

A network license has been issued to Les Entreprises Radio Etchemin, Inc., for the purpose of rebroadcasting CFLS-920 Levis PQ from 6 PM to 6 AM daily on CJVL-1360 Sainte-Marie-de-Beauce PQ.

ELSEWHERE

Salem Broadcasting, whose principals have filed against the license renewal of WXRK New York, picked up another major market FM this week. Salem has agreed to purchase WAVA-105.1 Arlington VA (Washington) from the financially struggling Emmis Broadcasting, for an estimated \$20 million sale price.

The Radio Advertising Bureau has released its list of top radio advertisers in 1990. Sears-Roebuck was again the top radio advertiser in 1990, with over \$101 million in ad buys; the retailer was followed by Philip Morris and General Motors in the #2 and #3 positions. Other companies posting sizable increases included AT&T, Volkswagen, Coca-Cola, Marriott, and Hooked on Phonics.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC made the following decisions this week:

Partially denied the appeal of Amador S. Bustos, applicant for a new FM at Longmont, CO, of an ALJ order that he produce four specific documents, after rejecting Bustos' privilege claim it was found that one of the four documents was entitled to protection from disclosure. The FCC then upheld the ALJ dismissal of the application of Chesapeake Media Communications Corp. for a new FM at Virginia Beach, VA.

The NAB Radio Board held its meeting June 19th and came up with the following items. The Board voiced support for the FCC's re-examination of rules governing the ownership of radio. The Board supports changes in the multiple ownership rules to allow for more than the present 12-12-12 limit on individual ownership. They also supported relaxing duopoly rules that would allow the ownership or control of more than one station or combo in a market. The boards position on "joint ventures" is that they are a good thing, stating "The Radio Board believes that the opportunities for stations to engage in joint ventures of time brokerage can enhance broadcasters' ability to serve their communities, to the benefit of the public interest". They went on to request that the FCC set standards for

broadcasters to follow in establishing such arrangements. In the matter of Digital Broadcasting the Board reaffirmed its support for the policies and activities of the NAB's Task Force on Digital Audio. In other business the Board raised the rates for off air CP holders, set a minimum dues amount, and redesignated the rotation of networks to the Board so that at least two of the larger networks would be on the Board at any one time.

NAB elects new board members. Richard D Novik, of WKIP AM & FM Poughkeepsie, NY, was elected to a one-year term as chairman of the NAB Radio Board of Directors. Novik succeeds David L. Hicks. Richard H. Harris was elected to a one-year term as vice chairman of the Radio Board. Harris, retired chairman of Group W Radio, owns WSPB in Sarasota, FL. Gary R. Chapman was elected chairman of the NAB Joint Board. Edward O. Fritts was re-elected president and CEO. NAB senior vice president and chief financial officer Kenneth Almgren was elected to the additional post of secretary/treasurer.

The NAB delivered more than 22,000 letters to the Senate Communications Subcommittee during hearings on the broadcast industry's public service contributions. The letters were collected from the public files of stations around the country. The senators were also reminded that broadcasting's competitors have no requirement to serve the public interest.

ELSEWHERE

Inside Radio reports that Ed Atsinger and Stuart Epperson have withdrawn their competing application for the New York 92.3 now licensed to Infinity. The filing with the FCC disclosed that there was no settlement agreement or quid pro quo. No explanation was given for the withdrawal.

Arbitron has mailed ballots to its radio subscribers to poll opinion on its proposed three survey a year, sixteen week survey periods. Ballots are due by July 5th. Results will be announced after being reviewed by the Radio Advisory Council later this summer. The proposed survey dates for three books a year will be 1. January 7th to April 28th, 1993 2. April 29th to August 18th 3. August 26th to December 15th. the reports will ship in May, September and January. Changing from four to three books a year will result in a 33.4% increase in sample size at no additional cost to subscribers.

Frequently asked question: Why won't Gary Sandy play program director Andy Travis when "WKRP in Cincinnati" returns to TV this fall? Answer: because he wasn't asked. Besides he's actually on stage in Cincinnati starring in "A Streetcar Named Desire," reports Gannett News Service.

Business Radio Network (BRN), Colorado Springs, announced it will change its daytime format clock on July 15. The network is promising several new enhancements to its programming. This is the first major update to the clock in almost four years of operation. **M Street** speculates: could this be in preparation for a second tier of BRN service allowing for its use as a short form business update service.

The Radio Advertising Bureau will hold the 1992 Managing Sales Conference in Nashville January 30 through February 2. "Full Speed Ahead: Maximizing Your Share of the Economic Recovery" is the theme of the thirteenth annual sales meeting. For more information call RAB Meetings Department at (212) 254-4800.
