

A statement from Sky Channel has given the lie to recent speculations that Rupert Murdoch's News Corporation would be selling the majority stake in the European cable satellite service (see M&M issue 38). Sky is instead to be rescued from its financial difficulties

with a fund of £22.63 million pounds provided by Satellite Television.

The funds are to be raised by way of a rights issue and will be used to repay Satellite Television's overdraft and provide finance for the ongoing operation of Sky Channel.

US Radio Stations Get More Ad Income New Age Format Exploding

Los Angeles - A strong increase in advertising income discussions on the progresss of and the upsurge of the new age 'wave' format were the main topics of the fourth National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) Conference in Anaheim, California. A record attendance of 5.722 attended this year's congress. During three packed days from September 9-11, the attendees had the opportunity to sit in on 75 sessions on Radio '87 and to visit the 144 exhibition stands in the 27,000 square foot 'Celebration Of Radio' exhibit hall. Opening the congress, NAB Radio Board Chairman Jerry Lyman, said: "Whether you're looking for ideas on management, programming, sales or engineering you'll find it all on the programme.'

There were 39 panels on programming, 21 on management, 19 on sales and a full schedule of engineering sessions. At the opening session 10 radio stations received NAB's first annual Crystal Awards for excellence in local achievement, these were selected from a field of 50 finalists who had been chosen from more than 185 entries. The other highlight of the first day was Radio America, a multi-screen audiovisual panorama which took months in the making and comprised six-and-a-half minutes of original music written and scored by Otis Conners.




A lot of the sessions covered a number of radio formats, with the new age format in particular really exploding. Stations that introduced 'Wave' formats (a mix of new age, soft jazz instrumentals and gentle AC vocal rock) are meeting with great success. They do not use any on air personalities at all. NAB Executive Vice President John Able told attendees at a session on the last day that local advertising on radio should follow the trend of the '80s and increase 8.5% in 1987 and 9.5% in 1988. Radio network advertising, he said, should continue to grow 6% in 1987 and 9.5% in 1988.



Other issues raised at the conference were the proposal for additional voluntary standards to further reduce interference on the AM band. These plans were announced by the National Radio Systems Committee (NRSC), which is a joint NAB and Electronics Industries Association committee-

A joint announcement was also made with NAB and the US Department of Health and Human Services to initiate a move to help radio stations increase public awareness of AIDS by providing accurate and objective information through broadcasting media.




