

# FULL OF BEANIES

## GARTER STITCH BEANIE

### MEASUREMENTS

To Fit Head cm Woman 56 Man 58

CLECKHEATON COUNTRY WIDE 14 PLY 50g balls

Quantity 4 4

- 1 pair 7.00mm (UK 2) knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seam.
- pom pom maker or piece of cardboard.

### TENSION

13.5 sts and 27 rows to 10cm over garter stitch (every row knit), using 7.00mm needles.

Correct tension is not essential.

### BEANIE (worked sideways)

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on **39** (42) sts loosely.

Knit in garter stitch (every row knit) until Beanie measures **51** (53) cm from beginning.

Cast off loosely.

### TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using mattress stitch, join cast-on and cast-off edges together, reversing seam for **8** (9) cm from one edge for turn back of brim. Gather top of beanie by threading yarn through garter stitch ridges across top edge, pull up firmly and fasten off securely. Make a large pom pom and attach securely to crown. Fold back brim. Sew in ends.
