State Capitol, December 18th, 1917.

Minutes of the Second and Adjourned Seventh Acgular Monthly meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in its temporary offices aursuant to adjournment, The following members were present:

Curtis Hencock, Chairman, H. C. Odle, Thos. R. DeLean, Absent, Geo. A. Puren, State Highway Engineer.

The meetin was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hencock that State Aid be granted Floyd county not to exceed (2,666.66 on Fighway Mo. 28, beginning at Floydada and ending ten miles north. Motion carried.

Notion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock that Federal Aid be granted Calhoun county not to exceed \$15,804.00 on Highray No. 29, between Port Lavaca and Victoria county line. Motion carfied. (The \$10,000 appropriation on Movember 20th, 1917 was cancelled.)

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that a further designation of the Manry Exall route be made as follows: Beginning at Corsicane and following the route as heretofore designated, being No. 32 to Muntsville, and thence continuing from Muntsville through Montgomery county, following No. 19 to Houston, which shall be known as the Mastern Loop of the Menry Shall Memorial Mighway; and the Descritory shall certify the entire route from Denison to Calveston to the Menry Exall Memorial Association, and re-affirming the Menry Exall Route from Corsicana to Mourton via Bremond. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that an intercounty highway be designated beginning at Teague, thence to Freestone, thence to Donie, thence to Jewett, thence to Conterville. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Oile that state fid be granted Wilbarger county not to exceed [16,795.91, beginning at a point four and three-fourths miles least of the city limits, and running thence east for a distance of four miles. Notion carried.

Hotion by Mr. Hencock, seconded by Mr. Odle that an intercounty designation be made beginning at Jebb Grossing at Odell on the Red River in Milbarger county, thence south to Vernon, thence south to Seymour. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hencock, seconded by Mr. Odle that an intercounty highway be designated beginning at Abilene, the ce south through Cedar Gap, through Ovalo to Ainters to Ballinger and to vaint Rock. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that Runnels county be granted Federal Fid mot to exceed #12,500 on the bridge immediately vest of the town of Ballinger across the Colorado River. This to be under separate project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that Federal Aid be granted Runnels county not to exceed \$19,142.00 on Highway No. 7, beginning at the bridge across the Colorado River west of Ballinger, thence westerly along route No. 7 for a distance of ten miles. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that Federal Add be granted Wilbarger county not to exceed 46,853.45 on Highway No. 5. Hotion carried. Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock that State Aid be granted to Calhoun county on Highway No. 29 from Port Lavaca to Whittenburt Gate, not to exceed twenty-five per cont. Hotion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that State Aid be granted Runnels county not to exceed \$6,250.00 on construction of bridge across the Colorado River immediately west of the town of Ballinger. Motion carried.

Notion by Mr. Mancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that an intercounty highway be designated beginning at Higgins, thence to Canadian, Miami, Faupa, Penhandle to Amarillo. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock that Highway No. 7 be re-designated as follows: Beginning at Waco, thence to Elk, thence to Watt, thence to Prairie Hill, thence to Coolidge, thence to Tehuscana thence to Mexia, thence to Cotton Gin, thence to Teague, thence to Fairfield, thence to Palestine, thence over Highway Mo. 19 to Crockett.

Hotion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hencock that the appropriation of Federal Aid heretofore made by the Commission for the construction of Highway No. 7 between Waco and Mart shall remain, but that this Highway from Vaco to Mart shall be known hereafter as Spar of Meridian Road to be called Highway No. 2-b. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that allotment of Pederal Aid be granted freestone county for \$25,000 upon ten miles of highway between Teague and fairfield, upon condition that a concrete road be constructed. Notion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hencock that Federal Aid be granted Freestone county for \$25,000 to be used on construction of the castern portion of the Tail Highway from county line on the north to county line on the south. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hencock that State... Aid be granted Freestone county amounting to twenty-five p.r.cent of cost of construction for the construction of all the Western portion of the Emall Highway in Freestone county, some being approximately five hiles. Action carried,

Botion by Er. Hencock, seconded by Er. Offe that Addison county be granted redered 410 to the amount of \$65,000 on Buill Highway from county line on the north to the county line on the south. Hotion carried.
