Change in the air is the theme of the first two albums released by MCA's Toronto-based Ontario label. The first is the 11th National Progressive Conservative Party in support of the Conservative Party's All Over Canada.

The Toronto Blues Band will continue this tradition in the future. Making a guest appearance with them for their February date was Tony Hock, a blues singer who has worked with Dusty Childs and Sidetrack.

Half Back Program for records and films this spring

Ontario's record and film industries will get a significant boost and the implementation of the Half Back Program, the Ontario Spring Wintark ticket can be used for many units on admission to eligible Canadian films and on the purchase of record albums by Canadian artists. Re-entry tickets will be back from a law to be provided by Ontario lottery sales, consistent with the objectives of Ontario proceeds for cultural and recreational purposes.

Bruce Taylor, Director of Culture and Recreation reports that in addition to the idea from the film and recording industries has been highly positive and we are participating in a creative and successful program. We expect that during the short period of the program (the Half Back concept may apply to Canadian books and magazines for a three-month test period last spring) 67% of the population have a copy of Half Back. An information and public relations campaign will be undertaken across the province to build on that success.

McLaurin Media Services Limited has been employed to handle advertising and promotion for the program, and material is now at the creative stage including posters, decals, stickers, and leaflets. An animated film trailer is being filmed for exhibition in participating theatres. Ontario lottery tickets provide approximately 35% of Ontario's budget for the program. The potential of public involvement on a grand scale.

"We believe that this Half Back program will help the record and film industries," continued Taylor. "It can help particularly in developing new markets by focusing the attention of the public on the achievements of talented Canadians in the film and recording areas."

Participation in the program on the part of Ontario record stores is voluntary and stores accepted for participation will be required to sign an undertaking to abide by the rules of the program. Letters inviting Ontario retailers to participate have already been mailed, with a fact sheet providing details concerning promotion and how the program operates at the retailer/agent level.

OBITUARY Jonathan Edward Wideman

Ed Wideman, popular country music backup vocalist, suffered fatal injuries in an auto mishap Tuesday February 27. The accident occurred near his home in Richmond Hill, Ontario. In his 30th year, Ed Wideman had enjoyed a successful career in the music industry and was highly respected for his contribution to the country, rock and bluegrass forms of music. He was well known in Nashville circles where he was a member of the Stamps Quartet and supplied backup for several Elvis Presley record sessions. Mr. Wideman was also a popular member of the Ronnie Prophet CTV Television show, Grand Old Country. Ironically, Mr. Wideman was on his way to a sound check for Prophet when the fatal accident

occurred. Considered an expert in the field of sound, Mr. Wideman founded the firm of Spectrum Audio, providing sound systems for many shows including Opry North and last year's Big Country Awards in Regina. He was also heavily involved in radio and television commercials.

Mr. Wideman is survived by his wife Carol, four year old daughter Stephanie and two year old son Jared. He also leaves his mother and father, Mr. & Mrs. Lloyd Wideman, sisters Ann, Marie and Esther, and brothers David, Ken and Danny.

Funeral services were held Friday, March 2nd.

Producer/writer Mollin pacts with Chappell

Chappell Music Vice President Irwin Schuster, Sr., has announced the signing of an exclusive co-publishing agreement with Fred Mollin for his Fred Mollin Music (ASCAP) and Songs of the Pioneers Music (BMI).

Mollin, who co-produces with Matthew McCauley, is probably best known for his contributions to the success of Dan Hill, for whom the team has produced four LPs. Current projects for the producing duo include a Randy Edelman album, due for March release on Arista, and a new album

with veteran singer/songwriter Jimmy Webb.

Mollin is presently working on his first feature film score, for the forthcoming Quadrant production, Fast Company.

In making the announcement, Schuster stated, "Fred Mollin's great abilities in writing, record producing, and film scoring make him a much sought after talent in today's music world. We are very proud that Fred has chosen Chappell Music to work with."

Stonebolt making gains with new PolyGram single

Stonebolt, Vancouver based commercial rock group who record on Casablanca's Parachute label, are currently making solid coast-to-coast gains in Canada with their new single, Was It You, a follow up to their major international hit I Will Still Love You. The single is taken from the group's self-titled debut album. It has been added at major and secondary stations throughout Canada.

The U.S. company has released a different single, Lovestruck, from a forthcoming second album. PolyGram Canada are releasing a double A sided single containing both cuts. In Canada, Lovestruck has been added

by CKLG Vancouver and CKLW Windsor, with the other stations playing Was It You (including CFUN Vancouver, where it is charted).

Several other Canadian artists released in Canada by PolyGram are preparing new recordings for future release. Barde's second album, Images, is now out on the Polydor label. The Montreal folk group's first release was on Direction. Two Capricorn recording groups, Garfield and the Cooper Brothers, are currently in the studio recording new albums, and of course, Stonebolt are readying their second album for Parachute.

PolyGram release Suzi

Quatro/Chris Norman 45

Stumblin' In, new single by Suzi Quatro sung as a duet with Chris Norman, has been released on the RSO label by PolyGram. The single has become one of the most added tunes in the U.S.

Norman is a member of popular rock group Smokie (Living Next Door To Alice). Quatro, established as a star in Britain, is well-known in North America through her role as Leather Tuscadero on the Happy Days TV series. Both acts are produced by Mike Chapman, who has also been instrumental in the careers of Nick Gilder and Exile.

Zon denies rumoured discord

Following a statement which appeared in the Canadian column of a U.S. trade publication (February 10), stating that "things are not all that well in the Zon camp between band members," Director of National Publicity Joe Owens, acting as spokesperson for CBS Canada, stated that the rumours of discord were totally unfounded.

Denton Young, lead singer of Zon, said, "We've never been tighter as a group, both musically and personally. This new album project has helped us explore a lot of new ideas in our music, and as individuals, we are each looking forward to what looks like a very exciting 1979."

The group has just completed recording a new LP, their second for the Epic label, and are planning major Canadian and U.S. tours to coincide with the early spring release of the new album.

"Rumours are like politicians," concludes Young. "You should never believe them."

Montreal's Stephen Barry

Band record live debut

Montreal-based publishing firm McMitty Music have announced the formation of a production company and recording label under the name of Fix It In The Mix Music. The label was formed by McMitty owners Gordon Gibson and Mitchell Cohen.

The label's debut release will be a live-recorded album by noted Montreal blues group the Stephen Barry Band, a four-piece Montreal group which includes bassist Barry, guitarists Jorn Reissner and Andrew Cowan, and drummer Paul Paquette. The group's material ranges from obscure blues to rock standards to original material contributed by Barry and Reissner.

The album, produced by Gordon Gibson, was recorded February 4 at the Iriquois Hotel in Old Montreal, using the 24-track Filtrason Truck, which has been acclaimed as being among the best mobile recording facilities available.

The Stephen Barry Band have earned a major following in the Montreal/Ottawa/Quebec region over the years, and since news of the recording became available, about 200 fans contacted the firm to order albums. Fix It In The Mix are currently looking for distribution. In the meantime, product will be available from the company at 6010 Durocher, number 2 Outremont, Quebec, H2V 3Y6, or telephone (514) 279-5085.

Bee Gees' LP up to triple platinum upon release

Spirits Having Flown, the new RSO album by the Bee Gees, was originally announced as being shipped double platinum. Between the time of the announcement and release last month, additional pre release orders had brought the total to over 300,000 units, or triple platinum, with sales now beyond 500,000 units and still moving at a rate of up to 17,000 units a day.

PolyGram who distribute the RSO label in Canada, are currently scoring with a new single from the album. The single, Tragedy, is a follow-up to their recent smash hit Too Much Heaven, which is approaching platinum status in Canada. Over 80,000 units of the single Tragedy were shipped, the biggest pre-order ever from PolyGram on a single.

The company is expressing cautious optimism the album will become a million seller in Canada. It is breaking out faster than the company's previous RSO million sellers, Grease and Saturday Night Fever.

Hardy a hit in Calgary

Attic recording artist Hagood Hardy's January 23 Calgary concert was a huge success in more ways than one. The show was sold out more than two weeks in advance, and the net proceeds for the date were donated by Hardy to the CKXL/CHFM Children's Fund.

Following the show, Hardy presented Keith James, Vice President and General Manager of stations CKXL and CHFM, with a cheque for \$8,000 for the fund, which hopes to raise \$150,000 this year for a blood dialysis machine for the Southern Alberta Children's Hospital.

The concert received outstanding reviews, and CKXL reported a deluge of phone calls the following morning from listeners inquiring about future Hardy appearances.

RCA signs rockabilly artist Robert Gordon

RCA Records have signed noted rockabilly artist Robert Gordon and are releasing a new album and single.

Gordon, an energetic performer who until recently was teamed with guitarist Link Wray, has two previous album releases on the Private Stock label. A native of Washington, D.C., Gordon is heavily influenced by the rockabilly music of the 50's. Living in New York since 1970, he connected with producer Richard Gottferrer, leading to his signing with Private Stock and a 1977 debut album with Wray. The duo returned last year with a follow up album *Fresh Fish Special*. During the run of the two albums, the deep-voiced Gordon and intense R&R guitarist Wray made the rounds of highly successful tour dates in North America and Europe, including Canadian debut dates in Toronto and Montreal.

Gordon's music runs the range of 50's rockabilly delivered in an honest, non-nostalgic style. His songs have included classics such as *Sea Cruise* and *Red Cadillac & A Black Moustache*, as well as the first recorded version of Bruce Springsteen's *Fire*, now a Pointer Sisters hit. His new



album, again produced by Gottferrer, features British guitarist Chris Spedding on lead and Nashville session ace Scott Turner on rhythm guitar. Titled *Rock Billy Boogie*, it is slated for a late February release. RCA have released the title cut as a debut single from the album, backed by Conway Twitty classic *It's Only Make Believe*.

A GUIDELINE AS TO HOW THE RPM 100 IS COMPILED

The RPM 100 is a national chart compiled weekly from national sales and radio station airplay and chart action. The top 50 records are computed from sales and airplay.

The computation of the records from 51 to 100 is based on early airplay, chart action and regional sales and breakouts. The chart is based on samplings from markets across Canada and indicates trends that may not be prevalent in all areas of Canada. Shaded numbers indicate a strong upward trend and gains in airplay or sales. This chart is offered as a guide to new product and an indication of trends in Canadian markets.

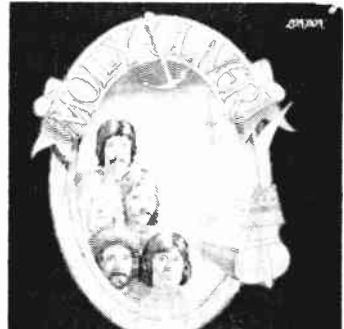

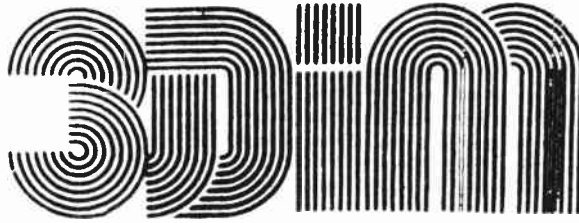

IAN KEMP

Ian Kemp says it is almost impossible to categorize a piece of music. He feels it is more accurate to label an artist's roots or to name the formats of radio stations playing his music. "I call my own music 'country music', because I come from a country background, and I write for the country

venue," he says. Kemp's latest single on Change Records, *Love Catch Fire*, started off as a MOR tune but soon crossed over to country stations and currently sits at 19 on RPM's Country Chart. The single is also on the album *Ian Fletcher Kemp (Writer)*, which has just recently been released by Change Records.

Ian Kemp started picking the guitar at 14, and was so busy playing folk music that he dropped out of high school the same year. However, he values the education he received afterwards (on a cattle ranch in High River, Alta.) more. He traveled extensively throughout Canada and the United States, playing music and learning about the real world. "I can remember playing bars when I was underage," Kemp recalls. "I had people throwing beer bottles at me and things like that, but I was so naive that I thought it was part of paying your dues." During his travels, he was constantly writing and composing new music, and his country influences began showing more in his songs.

"I write story songs," says Kemp. "I leave out the emotion and write with a journalistic feeling." He goes on to say, "My songs deal with incidents and are life experience reflections." Kemp names Merle Haggard and Mickey Newberry as having an influence on his writing. "Bang-ing off 'I love you' at the end of a guitar riff isn't my style. It is a special phrase that is too important to grind out like yogurt," he says.

Kemp writes a song with a pencil and a piece of paper. He laughs and says that might sound obvious, "but I'll get an idea and scramble for a pen that is always there, but it's never there when I need it." He can't remember having written a song with a pre-conceived notion, but he feels he has reached the point where he could wing it. "I don't have to rely on inspiration to write on a specific subject," states Kemp, "but I won't accept anything less than inspiration for my own stuff."

Three hours daily are usually devoted to his writing, says Kemp. "I'll come up with about 20 songs a week, of which I'll maybe keep two," he explains. Kemp is submitting songs for other writers through Intersound Publishing. He is also writing material for other Change artists, and even



for a new wave band. "It's an outlet for my music that I can't perform on, although I say, 'It is hard, vicious rock and roll, which isn't really my style,' he adds. Kemp wants to make his craft as a songwriter and he hopes he won't get into a rut in Canada. "I don't want to write a million songs all day," he says, "but the writing comes easier than the other parts of the business like recording and performing."

Both Change Records and *Change* are pleased with the initial reaction the new album has received. Kemp says that the industry people have been impressed by this first EP. "I've spent ten years fighting up

through the dirt and it's a nice feeling to be finally recognized," he says. The single, *Love Catch Fire*, has done better than anyone thought it would be doing to Kemp, and he hopes the album will do as well. "We should be proud of the air with *Love Catch Fire* and going in a country direction, but it crossed over into MOR and AOR," he explains. "I've loved the album 120 times, and I hope you could fit it into any format as well." Kemp feels it will get 300 plays because of comments he's received from stations asking that format.

Kemp's next single, which will be released soon, is called *Jennifer Got a Fall*, with the flip, *Someone's Kissin' Linda*. Both are taken from the album, which was produced by John Stewart. "John's *Sounds Intersound*, Kemp feels, that Stewart is as much a part of the album as he is. "John is a great producer because he knows what to do and always gets it right," explains Kemp. Back in the album, Ian Fletcher Kemp (Writer) is an attempt to get into the market and Kemp's material is perfect. He has a hard time finding a concept album, so he says, "but since that one isn't right for that. He probably won't. EP will have to be a coin operation."

Kemp says that though he's a folk singer like James Taylor or Bob Dylan, he's sung by himself as well. They are more pop nowadays and are likely to be better. "I've a six piece band," Kemp says, "but it's a ballad writer's band, not a rock band. It'll probably get a good deal of air, but likely a radio. I'm not a radio star, but I hope," he concludes. "I'll be in the same league as Bruce Springsteen and I hope I'll be able to be able to play in front of a crowd. They'll need to be a little more like me."

B.C.'s Lucky Goose issue song to save Kootenays

Brian and Marlene Lodmell of B.C.-based group The Lucky Goose have released on their own, self-titled label, a single in support of a campaign to prevent the Kootenay Diversion in southern B.C. The Diversion, a proposed blockage of the Kootenay River by B.C. Hydro as a hydro-electrical project, would, its detractors claim, endanger wildlife and the economy in the Kootenay region.

The single, titled Save The Kootenays, was written by the Lodmell couple and self-produced in their studio on the banks of Kootenay Lake in Riondel, B.C. The single is solidly supported by residents of the area, who have bought out the entire first pressing. The single has also received radio support in B.C., and went to number one in Nelson and Creston within three weeks of release.

The Lodmells are currently producing a debut Lucky Goose album and readying for a cross-Canada tour in support of the single, which is adult-oriented. They are already confirmed for the World Sympos-

ium on Humanity in Toronto in April and Vancouver's Commodore in May, and they hope the tour will serve both to boost record sales and airplay and to stop the Kootenay Diversion.

PolyGram's Dire Straits near Canadian platinum

Four-piece British group Dire Straits, whose debut album has been released in Canada on the Mercury label by PolyGram, have already well surpassed gold in Canada with sales beyond the 70,000 unit mark and, according to PolyGram, are well on their way to Canadian platinum.

The group's follow-up album has already been recorded, but release is being delayed until mid-May. PolyGram are already projecting platinum. The group's debut single, Sultans Of Swing was just recently released. Already available in the U.S., the single has been added at a number of Canadian majors as an album cut.

Dire Straits are signed to Phonogram in Britain. Their product is released by Warner

Bros. in the U.S., but PolyGram has maintained their release rights in Canada. The group will be making debut Canadian appearances March 13 at Toronto's Convocation Hall and Montreal's Le Plateau the following night.

World Radio History

PolyGram readying new album by the new U.K.

PolyGram are preparing for release in two weeks a new album by British group U.K. The album, the group's second, will be titled *Danger Money*, and PolyGram feel confident it will achieve gold status in Canada. The first album a self-titled effort featuring noted British prog-rockers Bill Bruford, Allan Holdsworth, John Wetton and Eddie Jobson, moved about 30,000 units.

In the interim, Bruford and Holdsworth

have left the group and have been replaced by former Frank Zappa drummer Terry Bozio. Bruford has formed a new band, the Bill Bruford Band, which includes Holdsworth, Jeff Berlin and Dave Stewart. They will also be coming out with a new album. Both groups record on the Polydor E.G. label out of Britain.

U.K. are tentatively slated for a number of western Canada dates in April.

Saga gaining int'l attention

Polydor recording act Saga have been garnering attention in several breakout markets in the U.S., despite the fact that their self-titled debut LP has not yet been released south of the border. The album has been selling extremely well as an import item and KSHE-FM, a key breakout station in St. Louis, recently chose the album as the Number One Import Album of 1978. Saga has also been getting considerable airplay on WBAB-FM in New York and on KISS-FM in San Antonio, Texas, where the Program Director reported that listener reaction to Saga was stronger than any such response since the station first aired Rush.

Over 5,000 Saga LPs have been exported to Europe, and requests for licensing deals have come from PolyGram companies and affiliates from all over the world.

Back in their native Canada, the Toronto-based group have been building a substantial following via live performances and airplay. CHOM-FM in Montreal previewed the LP upon release and the phone-

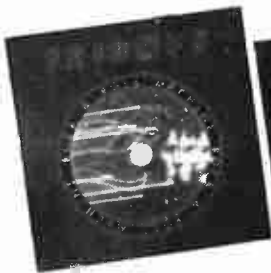

Klaatu animated short to air on NBC's Rock Concert

An animated short piece put together by Daffodil recording group Klaatu will be broadcast on the NBC-TV network's Rock Concert show March 10. The broadcast will mark the first performance ever by the four-piece Canadian group, whose individual identities remain unknown.

The animation is a 3½ minute piece based on the song A Routine Day, from the group's third album, Sir Army Suit. It is a full-fledged animation, created by a major Toronto firm at a large expense and overseen by the group. Klaatu are also supervising animated production on a number of other songs from their debut album 3:47 EST, and Sir Army Suit, for incorporation into a half hour special. There are tentative future plans for a full-length animated feature film based on their second album, Hope, a science fiction concept album.

Capitol EMI of Canada, who distribute Daffodil product in Canada, report the half-hour special will be submitted for nomination in Canada for a film award in the category of best animated film.

The group's animated works will feature caricature versions of the members of the group, a step in their gradual revelation of themselves to the public. Parts of the animation are also being considered for inclusion in concert appearances the group hope to begin making early next year.

Toto's debut LP platinum

On February 4, Columbia recording act Toto were presented with their first platinum album award, by CBS Canada. CBS Canada Chairman Arnold Gosewich made the presentation between the group's SRO shows at the Agora in Cleveland. CBS staffers Joe Owens, Jean Desjardins, Bill Bannon, and Billy Anderson, newly appointed to the post of Artist Relations for CBS Canada, were also on hand for the occasion.

Following the Toronto screening of Cheap Trick in Japan to members of the media, the Global TV network has transmitted the film across Ontario, parts of Quebec and the northern U.S.

European tour set for Family Brown

Ottawa's Family Brown will be singing their way through Europe on an extensive tour that will take them to England, Scotland, Northern Island, Ireland, Holland and Germany. The four week tour, the last two weeks in October and first two in November, is being arranged by Lou Rogers, father of the popular British pop artist Claudia.

The Family Brown were recently in Toronto (Feb 19-20) to attend the Agri cultural Convention, which attracted Ontario fair buyers. The Family had a large suite

in the Royal York Hotel for the convention and firmed up much of the summer and fall for Ontario fairs.

Currently hitting country charts with their new single release, The Way I Love You, the Family Brown are showing indications of retaining the popularity that resulted in them being voted Canada's Top Country Group for three years running in the Big Country Awards.

Prior to their European tour, an album and single will be released for that market.

Big things happening for Comstock Records

Comstock Records of Kansas City have entered into an agreement with Broadland Records for an exclusive distribution deal. All Comstock product will be distributed on the Broadland label in Canada, with the first release being Alex Fraser's new single, Midnight Star. This follows Fraser's first single, Four States To Go, which was very successful, entering the top ten on RPM's Country Chart. It also received considerable airplay in the U.S., especially on border stations.

Comstock have also launched what is, according to the company's Frank Fara, possibly the first national premium promotion in the country music field. They have sent coffee mugs to all the country and semi-country music directors in Canada, as well as key music industry people. The artwork on the mug was designed by Kansas City illustrator Sean Bouvinett. The graphic is a framework of a star with a partial clock worked in to show the hands of midnight. Comstock were careful to make the mug and design subdued and non-blatant, making it something which the recipients would be pleased to use and have sitting on their desks.

Fara says one reason this type of promotion hasn't been tried before is cost. He says postage alone is over \$500, and then there is the additional cost of the cups, artwork, and packaging. The idea came from Comstock's PR firm in Hollywood, California. Even though the promotion is expensive, they figure a mug is more useful than a hat or a pen or T-shirt, which Fara

says are all overworked in pop music.

Comstock also placed teaser ads in the trades to help introduce the song. Parts of the ad were placed weekly, with the final one fully introducing the logo. Fara feels that the company's effort to build Alex Fraser into a major country and MOR force in both Canada and the U.S. will pay off.

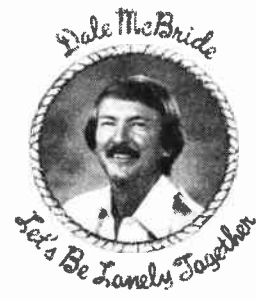

It will be a two album soundtrack called *Secret Life Of The Plants*, which will be rather unique when you realize Wonder has never seen a plant in his life. I understand there won't be too much disco on the soundtrack. Another soundtrack album comes from Stevie's ex-wife Syreeta Wright, titled *Fastbreak*. Billy Preston is now on Motown and will have an album out soon. A disco number that seems to be getting some action, according to Hochberg, is *Space Dance* by a group of studio musicians. The production was done outside of Motown and will possibly be the beginning of a Motown Disco Sounds series.

Talk to anyone at WEA and all you hear about is the upcoming release of *We Are Family* by Sister Sledge. It comes from the Chic people and Kim Cooke says "It will go down in the halls of disco fame." They say it will be hot, and who's going to argue? On the Sire label comes an album by Silvetti called *Concert From The Stars*. Silvetti is a keyboard player from South America who was previously on Salsoul. A promo 12" of the title track has gone to the discos. A semi-disco double LP is on the way from George Benson called *Livin' Inside Your Love*. From a group named *Stuff* comes the album *Stuff It* which was produced by Steve Cropper of Booker T & the MG's fame. And watch for the new Candi Staton album in early April. From Atlantic comes the new Tasha Thomas LP, titled *Midnight Rendezous*. An interesting tidbit - Thomas played *Aun:y Em* in the Broadway production of *The Wiz*. The *Average White Band*, who some feel opened the door for white disco artists, have a new album *Feel No Frets*. Pat Adams, who produced *Musique*, has a new LP on the way called *Phreek*. Another producer/arranger is Vince Montana of *Goody Goody*. His new album is called *Montana, I Love Music*. The first single will be the title cut, which is a re-worked version of the *Stylistics* hit. *I Want Your Love* is the new 12" by Chic and Boney M's new single is *Dancing In The Streets*. The flip of that 12" is the disco

remix of *Rasputin*. And finally, Peter Tosh has a new 12" reggae disco mix of *Don't Look Back/Don't Space Out*.

Recent releases from A&M include the 12" *Can You Read My Mind* (Love Theme From *Superman*) by Krypton and a 12" from Bell & James titled *Livin' It Up* (Friday Night). *Let Me Take You Dancing* is a 12" from Bryan Adams and rounds up A&M's current disco action.

PolyGram's readying *Village People's* new LP, *Go West*. Initial single release will be *In The Navy* with the flip, *Manhattan Woman*, both on the LP. *Pattie Brooks* has a new album on the way as well. *Alicia Bridges'* newest single is out on a 7" called *Body Heat*, and is a rock/disco crossover number. An album along that same vein is by *Chi-Chi Favelas* and is titled *Rock Solid*. It comes from England and one number on the LP is an interesting disco version of *Cocaine*. It is only three minutes long, however, and might not get too much disco action.

London Records have some new product that should be on the street very shortly. The single by the *Bombers*, *Everybody Get Dancing*, is now available on the Telson label in both 12" and 7". It's *All Over Now Baby* by Mick Rowley on Lollipop is on 12", as is *Ronnie Jones'* latest, *Groovin'*, also on Lollipop. *Jack Ferguson* has a new 12" titled *Skateboard Dancin'* which is on London, and so are the new 12" offerings by *Jason Lee* with *Do It Now* and the *Beck Family's* *Can't Shake The Feeling*. *Michael Lehman* will have a new 12" on WAM Records titled *Love Street* and *Santa Esmeralda* have a new 7" release titled *Learning The Game* on the *Foreign Exchange* label. London have decided to re-release *Hot Shot* because of the great demand. The release is on the Telson label. And finally, watch for a disco version

of *In-A-Godda-Da-Vida*.

Pickwick are releasing a new 12" single by *Con Funk Shun*. The single, *Get Down With It*, has been culled from one of their albums and marks the company's first single 12" release.

More and more radio stations are getting into disco coverage, with major market outlets joining the trend. CFTR in Toronto will be featuring *Studio 680*, a four hour show from 8 pm on Saturdays. Hosted by *Scott Miller* and *Connie Sinclair*, the show breaks the regular AM format with 20-minute plays and disco mixes. CFTJ in Cambridge, Ontario have programmed a six hour disco show every Saturday night that begins at 6 pm. *Geoff Banks*, the Music Director at the station, mentions that they need disco material badly, including *Cancon* disco material. *CHYR* in *Leamington*, Ontario are playing a heavier saturation of disco during the afternoon drive. Their four hour daily disco format also requires more product. *CKGM's* *Studio 98* program, on Saturdays from nine to midnight, has been on the air for over a month now and is a resounding success. Host *Alain Montpetit*, who is director of promotions at the *Montreal* station, says their program is not an imitation of a live disco, but is an exploration of the disco phenomenon. "It is the spirit of disco, available to everyone first hand."

A couple of things to watch for on the horizon include a group called *Stainless Steel* with a release titled *Can Can*. The record comes from the same people who produce *Donna Summer's* records. Also from Europe comes a hot number titled *Don't Stop The Music* by a girl named *Bonnie St. Clair*. More on her later. And look out for a very hot disc from the stable of *Willi Morrison* and *Ian Guenther*.

Disco Awards a big success

The third annual Disco Awards show, hosted by the Canadian Record Pool, was held last week in Montreal. The show was produced by *Michel Daigle* and *Gilles Vincent* at *Channel 10 CFTM's* studios, and was broadcast live by the French language station. Many of the major record companies had artists present, including *Rick James*, the *Village People*. *Dan Hartman*, *Patsy Gallant*, *Karen Young* and *Peter Brown*. The *Canadian Male Vocalist* of the Year was *Martin Stevens*, with the *Female* award going to *Patsy Gallant*. The *Canadian Group* of the Year were the *Raes* and on the international scene, the winners were the *Village People*, with a special award going to the *Bee Gees*. The *International Female Vocalist* classification also had a special award given to *Donna Summer*, with *Gloria Gaynor* winning the category. *Barry Manilow* won the *Top Male International Vocalist* and *Goody Goody* (*Vince Montana Jr.*) won the *International Orchestra* Award. In the *Most Promising International* category, the *Top Male Vocalist* Award went to *Dan Hartman* and the *Fe-*

male Award to *Alicia Bridges*, with *A Taste of Honey* winning the *Top Group Award*. The *International Song of the Year* was *Copacabana* by *Barry Manilow* and the *International LP of the Year* was *The Village People's* *Crusin'* album, with *Saturday Night Fever* winning the *Soundtrack of the Year Award*. The *Canadian LP of the Year* was *Love Disco Style* by the *Erotic Drum Band* and the *Single of the Year* was *Love Is In The Air* by *Martin Stevens*. The *Most Promising Canadian* award was won by *Rick James*, whose hit *You And I* and album, *Come Get It*, received excellent play on the air and in the discos. The best selling 12" of the year was *Let's All Chant* by the *Michael Zager Band*, while *Le Freak* by *Chic* was the best selling single 45 of the year. The *Top DJ of the Year* honours were shared by *Michel Simard* from *La Cles* and *Louis Cazabon* from *Studio 1*, both in *Montreal*. CTFM gave a special award to *Nanette Workman* for being one of the first Canadians to recognize the potential of disco.

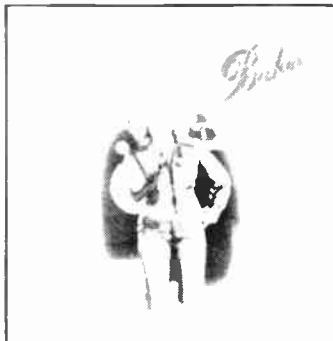

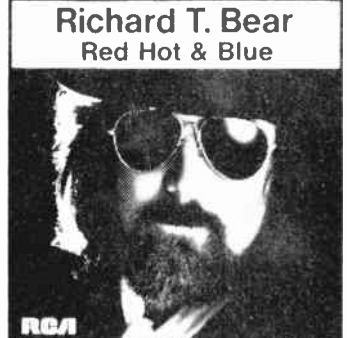
