SANITARY PROTOCOL

U23 Senior World Championships

World Championship - Grappling

Belgrade, October 28 – November 7, 2021

The health protection measures for all wrestling championships that take place under the auspices of the UWW are planned and implemented in accordance with the provisions of the Medical Regulations of the UWW. The COVID-19 pandemic, in addition to the usual measures, also imposes the need for new measures and activities.

In preparation of the Sanitary Protocol, the organizer considered the national guidelines, recommendations of UWW and WHO, in order to provide the best possible conditions for accommodation of the participants and holding the competition, and to reduce the risk of disease and transmission of COVID-19 to a minimum. Having in mind that no single measure provides absolute protection, various prevention measures should be simultaneously applied.

The competition shall be held in „bubble system“:

1. The participants shall be accommodated in hotels exclusively intended for this activity and without other guests.
2. Transport shall include special vehicles intended exclusively for the participants.
3. The participants shall restrict their movement to getting from the hotel to competition hall and vice versa.
4. Breaking the „bubble“system during the competition is strictly forbidden.
5. Each independent violation of these measures causes automatic disqualification.

The organizer will coordinate all activities and measures provided by the plan with UWW, through which it will distribute the document to all national selections of participants before arriving to the competition.

1. Obligations of national selection management

1.1. All participants – including vaccinated people - in the championship must have a **negative PCR** test to SARS-CoV-2 **not older than 48 hours at the time of entry into the Republic of Serbia**.

The test must be, in addition to the local language, translated into English.

All participants are required to prepare a printed copy of the PCR test.

1.2. All participants must be under constant medical supervision during the preparations, and a medical examination of all wrestlers must be performed no more than 10 days before arriving at the championship.

During the said medical examination, all the necessary clinical and laboratory tests shall be done, confirming that the wrestlers are healthy and capable of participating in the upcoming competition, and shall eliminate the suspicion of the presence of COVID-19 infection.

This medical report must be official, certified and signed by the doctor and the institution where the examination was performed.

The test must be, in addition to the local language, translated into English.

1.3. All participants in the championship must sign a statement declaring they have no symptoms that could indicate the presence of Covid-19 infection, as well as that they have not been in conscious contact with a COVID-19 positive person in the last 2 weeks (Appendix 1).

They shall deliver these documents at the accreditation point where they shall undergo an antigen test.

1.4. Participants who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19, as well as persons who have recovered from COVID-19 infection, should provide the evidence of vaccination/recovery. The documents will be taken into account when considering the measures to be imposed on close contacts of a COVID-19 positive person, in accordance with the applicable national recommendations.

1.5. It is necessary to adhere to basic preventive medical measures such as maintaining physical distance, wearing protective masks and hand disinfection. Wearing a mask is mandatory for all participants in the championship except during training, competition fights and during meals. It is necessary to change the mask at least 3 times during the day. Minimize contacts with other participants in competitions from other national selections.

1.6. During the championship, the team leader shall control the body temperature of all members of his/her selection, and in case of fever, or the symptoms indicating the COVID-19 infection, the team leader shall notify the Organizer without delay. The thermometer shall be provided by the Organizer.

2. Testing of the participants

Testing of all championship participants using a rapid antigen test on COVID-19 shall be performed immediately upon arrival. Upon receiving a negative test result, participants shall be referred to an accreditation point.

Participants tested positive for the rapid antigen test, shall be isolated in separate rooms, and additionally tested for SARS-CoV-2 using PCR test.

Participants with a negative test result shall be allowed to compete, while positive ones shall be referred to isolation under medical supervision.

3. Transport

Transport of participants shall be performed by special buses. Ventilation and disinfection will be performed daily before and after each transport.

Only accredited participants of the championship may enter the means of transport wearing appropriate protective masks.

The number of passengers in a means of transport is determined by the Crisis Staff's national regulations on the public transport.

4. Accreditation

Accreditation of participants shall be performed at the appropriate accreditation point, according to the established schedule, being large enough to provide physical distance, with provided hand sanitizers, additional number of protective masks, appropriate toilet space, bucket with lid for disposal of used masks. The Organizer shall make an effort to have only one national selection present during the accreditation, and all staff present shall be obliged to apply all recommended preventive measures, including the wearing of protective masks and hand disinfection.

5. Hotel accommodation

Participants shall be accommodated in hotel rooms supplied with a sufficient amount of hygiene and disinfection equipment. The Organizer recommends the use of double or single rooms for accommodation. Participants shall not be allowed to change rooms after getting them at the beginning of the competition.

Hand sanitizers shall be provided at the restaurant entrance. Meals provided shall be attuned to the physical, religious and other needs as required by UWW regulations. Meals shall be provided according to the schedule, in several halls, with food being served by the waiters and respecting the physical distance and other preventive measures.

The time provided for meals is 30 minutes.

In case the selection management needs to hold a meeting with its members, this should be communicated to the hotel reception in order to agree on the time of the meeting. Meetings shall be held in the hotel premises intended for that purpose.

6. Training

The trainings shall take place according to a set schedule delivered to each national federation at specially designated hotel rooms, as well as the competition hall. Disinfection shall be performed before and after the training. Only wrestlers, their coaches and medical staff may enter the mat. Before entering the mat, be sure to pass the appropriate disinfection barrier for shoes and hands. Such barrier shall be placed at the entrance to the training room. Showering - personal hygiene of each athlete shall be performed in their hotel rooms.

On the day of the competition, training and warm-up shall be performed in the hall connected to the competition hall. Each national team shall have its own locker room. The locker room is disinfected after each use. The size of the locker room is adjusted to the number of competitors.

7. Medical examination of competitors before measurement

The medical examination of the competitors before the measurement shall be performed by appointed doctors separately for each category scheduled for the fights on the given day. In addition to the examination prescribed by the UWW regulations, body temperature shall also be measured. Body temperature shall be measured in the hotel at 07:00 by an authorized person from the medical team of the championship. The place for measuring the temperature of the competitors shall be clearly marked in the hotel. A competitor with a fever above 37.5 degrees Celsius shall be excluded from the competition and referred to the Covid clinic.

8. Medical care

Medical care shall be performed according to the UWW Medical Regulations. One doctor and one medical technician will be present at each mat. During the competition, 1 orthopedist with the necessary equipment for possible immobilization will be present. Each team shall have the appropriate medical equipment to provide the necessary assistance. Each medical worker shall wear an appropriate protective mask, and when providing the necessary help to the competitors, special gloves that are thrown away after use.

The resuscitation team will be located next to the mat with all the necessary equipment for resuscitation procedures as well as the means for transporting the injured competitors to the appropriate medical institution. The team must include an emergency doctor.

A doctor and a medical technician shall be present in the mobile outpatient clinic located within the competition facility, who will provide the necessary medical assistance to other participants in the competition.

Two resuscitation ambulances shall be parked in front of the competition hall, which will transport the injured to the appropriate medical institutions, if necessary.

A special clinic for examinations of suspects of COVID-19, in which the infectious disease specialist shall be present, shall be located separately from the other rooms. There, the participants suspected of COVID-19 shall be examined.

In each confirmed case of COVID-19 infection, an epidemiological examination of close contacts shall be performed in accordance with national and WHO recommendations. All people with a confirmed COVID-19 infection shall be eliminated from the competition. Team members, for whom the epidemiological examination determines close contacts with a confirmed COVID-19 case, shall not be allowed to mix with other members of the selection, and other selections, until the end of the examination and obtaining a negative PCR test result. Transport of persons suspected of having COVID-19 shall be performed by special purpose vehicles.

Participants who are positive for COVID-19 and do not require hospital treatment, shall be accommodated on a special floor of the hotel with included special diet and activity regime. The period of isolation shall be adjusted to the applicable national recommendations. Medical care will be provided by an epidemiologist and an infectious disease specialist. Participants who show clinical signs of the disease that require hospital treatment shall be referred to an appropriate hospital.

9. Mat hygiene

Before entering the mat, all competitors must go through a disinfection barrier for shoes, with a material provided for wiping shoes from moisture, as well as hand disinfection. The mat shall be cleaned and disinfected immediately before the start of the competition as well as after each completed fight. The mat shall be disinfected using the disinfectants that do not irritate the skin or mucous membranes.

In case the opening and medal awarding ceremonies are to be performed on the mat, it shall be previously protected with appropriate covers, which shall be removed after the ceremonies are completed, and the mat shall be disinfected again.

10. Referees

Referees must adhere to all preventive medical measures as well as other participants in the competition.

They must not touch the athletes, there is no handshake between the judges and the wrestlers. The athlete bows to the referee instead of greeting. The winner shall be announced by a show of hands. The mat referee shall invite to consult only if necessary. Referees' sets are inspected without touching. A physical distance must be provided between the referee and the timekeeper. The point indicators must be disinfected after use.

11. Anti-doping control

Anti-doping control shall be performed according to clear WADA rules. A special addition to this is that the number of premises shall be increased in order to avoid a larger number of competitors for anti-doping control in a small area.

12. Pre-departure PCR test to Covid-19

PCR test/rapid antigen test to Covid-19 before departure shall be performed at the request and expense of national selections (the price of PCR test is EUR 80, and the price of rapid antigen test is EUR 35).

Testing must be announced at least 3 days in advance at the accreditation point where payment shall be made and a printed form with accurate data of test person submitted (Form for PCR test/rapid antigen test on request is attached hereto), while sampling shall be performed at the same point as rapid antigen testing as the beginning of the competition. All national selections shall receive the results in person or the results shall be sent to them electronically.

13. Medal award ceremony

The medals shall be awarded on a special podium and shall be handed out by UWW officials, without shaking hands with the medal holders and with each other. Congratulations shall be expressed with a bow and verbally.

Medals, plaques and possibly other awards shall be presented by the hostesses on a special tray, and the medal holders shall personally take them and put them around their necks.

Mutual congratulations of the wrestlers by shaking hand and physical contact on the podium are not allowed.
