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Mid-2015 Parish Population Estimates

Introduction

This booklet contains estimates of the resident population for each Parish in North Yorkshire as at 30th June 2015. A companion booklet that provides an estimate of the resident population of each Ward in North Yorkshire is also available.

The estimates are the result of a statistical analysis based on changes in the number of registered electors. The effect of changes in the size of the dwelling stock, through building, demolition or conversion is not considered separately but are taken to be reflected in changes in the number of electors.

The methodology used to calculate the population figures has been revised for 2015 so the figures contained in this booklet are not directly comparable with those of previous years. In all cases, the sum of the individual parish population figures within each District are constrained to the Office for National Statistics Mid-Year Estimates.

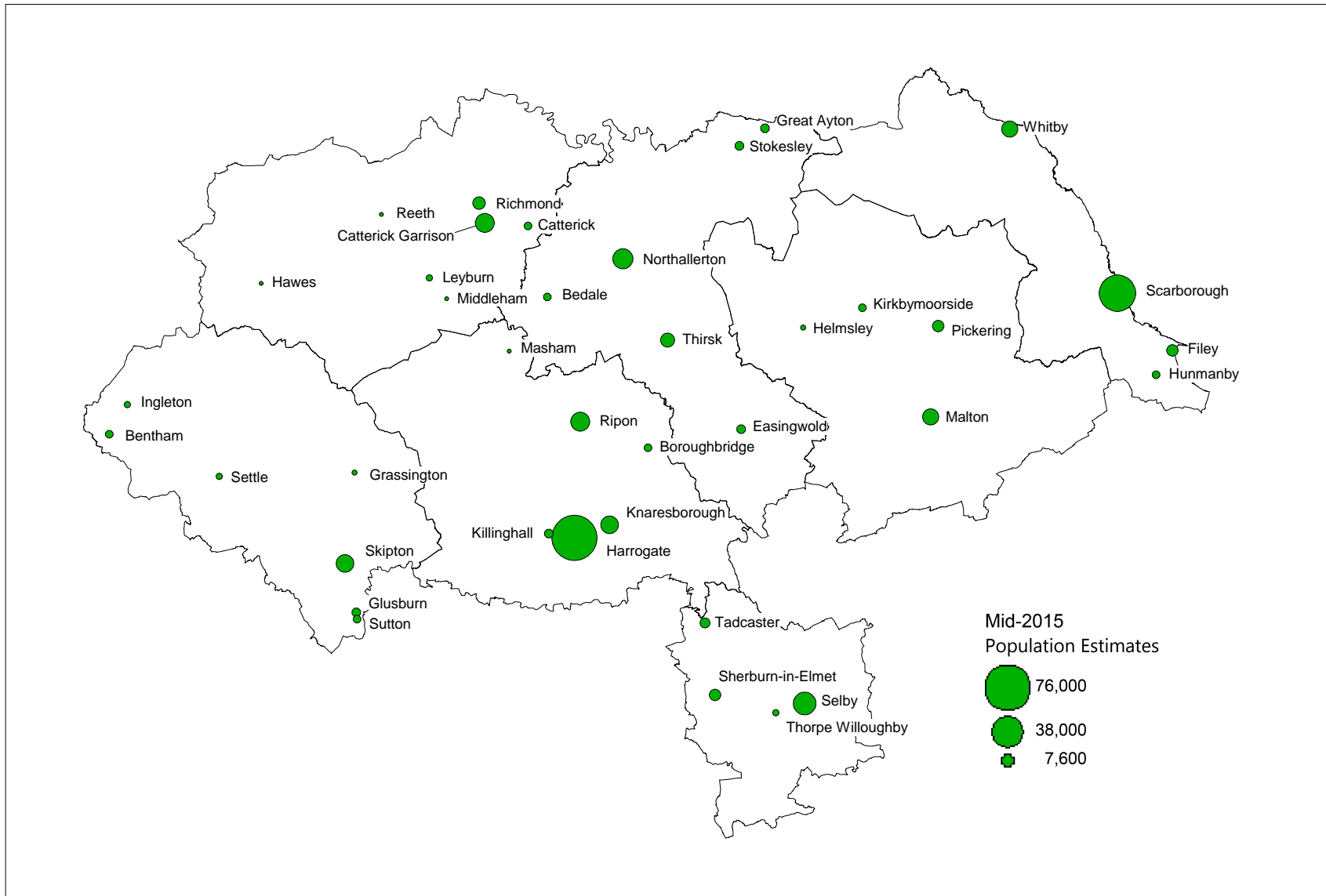
