	The player's name on the back of clothing shall be identical with the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database. Last Name is defined as the family name, surname or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member count. (GCR 23.3)
	 MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS 1. Name of player is MANDATORY from the first day of the event. 2. From Quarter Finals onwards, doubles partners must wear clothing of the same color. 3. From Quarter Finals onwards, opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colors.
On Court Doctor	On Court Doctor will be on duty throughout the competition at the tournament Venue.
	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of- competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
Doping Control	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

	 Covid-19 Protocols Only fully vaccinated participants (including players, team managers, coaches, technical officials, an any other tournament support personnel) are permitted to participate in this event as per the Bahrai government guidelines. In addition, participants MUST submit an official vaccination certificat approved by the participant's home country. Participants entering the tournament from Red List countries MUST apply for a visa at least 30 day before the tournament fart date. PLEASE NOTE that entering the tournament DOES NOT GUARANTEE a visa. It is subject to approval from Bahrain's Ministry of Health. All participants MUST submit a negative PCR test conducted by an authorized testing agency in th home/departing country of the participant, which is not older than 72hours from their date of arrival is the kingdom of Bahrain. All participants entering the Bahrain International Airport will be charged an amount of BHD 36 (Approximately 100USS) as Covid -19 test charges (3 mandatory tests). All participants must stay at the official Hotel and use the official Hotel. Upon arrival, participants will be transported to the official Hotel. Players and team entourage as well as the bus drivers are required to wear face masks at a times during transport. After the on-arrival PCR test, participants are required to stay in isolation while waiting for their test results. Participants must stay within the bubble areas at all times - these are limited to specific parts of the Hotel, enue, practice hall, and tournament transport. The organizers will formulate necessary guidelines to minimize unnecessary contact between attendee to be event. For example, only personnel who have been properly tested will be allowed to come i close contact with the players.
