

CHAPTER 1 Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Habiganj was one of the sub-divisions of former Sylhet District was created in 1888. It was up-graded to a district on the 1 February, 1984. There are different views about the origin of the district name. There is a popular view that in the past there lived a prominent man named **Habibullah**, who set up a **Ganj** meaning trading centre in the present district headquarters. It is belived that the district name might have been originated from the word **Habibullah** and **Ganj**.

Area and Location: Habiganj district is bounded on the north by Sunamganj district, on the east by Maulvibazar district and Sylhet district, on the south by Tripura state of India and on the west by Kishoreganj district and Brahmanbaria district. The total area of the district is 2636.59 sq.km. (1017.00 sq.miles) of which 149.48 sq.km (57.72) sq.miles) are under forest. The district lies between 23°58′ and 24°42′ north latitudes and between 91°09′ and 91°40′ east longitudes.

Township: Habiganj Town Committee was established in 1881 and it was turned into a municipality in 1913. During the British period an embankment was constructed along the Khowai river to protect the town. The main business centre of the town is Chowdhury Bazar.

Temperature and Rainfall: The maximum and minimum temperature in Habiganj district varies from 33.2°C to 13.6°C. The annual average rainfall of the district is 3334 mm.

Main Rivers: Khowai, Sutang, Korangi, Kalni, Kushiyara, Gopala, Ratna and Barak are the important rivers of Habiganj district.

Administration: Habiganj subdivision was established in 1874 under Sylhet District and was turned into a district in 1984. The district consists of 8 upadistricts, 77 unions, 1255 mauzas, 2143 villages, 6 paurashavas, 54 wards and 188 mahallas. The upadistricts are Ajmiriganj, Baniachang, Bahubal, Chunarughat, Habiganj Sadar, Lakhai, Madhabpur and Nabiganj.

Historical Events: On 4 April 1971 Col. Ataul Ghani Osmany (Supreme Commander of the War of Liberation) and some officers of the 2nd and 4th East Bengal Regiment assembled in the Teliapara Tea Garden Dakbungalow to discuss war situation.

Famous Personalities of the district: Habiganj is the homeland of many nationally and internationally renowned personalities. Some of them are mentioned below:

- **Bipin Chandra Pal:** He was born in the then Habiganj District and was well known as a revolutionary activist against the British Rule. He participated in the swaraj and swadeshi movement.
- **Sir Fazle Hasan Abed:** He is a social worker and the founder Chairman of BRAC (Bangladesh Rural Advancement Committee). For his outstanding contribution to social improvement, he has received many honorary awards. Among them, Ramon Magsaysay Award, UNDP Mahbub ul Haq Award and Knight Commander of the Order of St. Michael and St. George (KCMG) are notable.
- **Dewan Farid Gazi:** He was a Bangladeshi politician and was elected as Member of Parliament for the Habiganj-1 constituency for three times-1996, 2001 and 2008. He served as Chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on the Ministry of Primary and mass Education.
- Shah Abu Muhammad Shamsul Kibria (Shah AMS Kibria): He was an economist, diplomat, a politician and the Finance Minister of Bangladesh. He was a Civil Servant of the then Pakistan and became the Director General of Political Affairs of the Ministry of

Foreign Affairs. He was actively involved in the Language Movement of 1952. He played a lead role in the War of Liberation in order to mobilized the opinion of Bangladeshi and international communities in support of Bangladesh.

Main Crops: The main crops of this district are paddy, potato, ground nut, betel leaf etc. This district is famous for growing a considerable quantity of tea. More than 20% of tea gardens of Bangladesh are located in this district.

Main Fruits: Mango (Mangifera indica), jackfruits (Artocarpus heterophyllus), banana (Musa sapientum), coconut (Cocos nucifera), lichi (Lichi chinensis), guava (Psidium guajava) and papaya (Carica papaya) are the major fruits of this district.

Traditional Transport: Palanquin, horse carriage and bullock cart, boat are the traditional transports found in the rural area of Habiganj district. These means of transport are either extinct or nearly extinct. Now a day, all the upazilas are connected with the district headquarters with metalled roads. Bus, minibus, three wheelers ply over the district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Habiganj is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 342,178 holdings of the district, 57.61% holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, jute, spices, cash crops, pulses, oilseeds and others. Various fruits like pine apple, banana, mango, guava, jackfruit, black berries, coconut, papaya, palm, lichi, dates etc. are grown. Fish of different varieties are caught from rivers, tributary channels and creeks and even from paddy fields during rainy season. Besides crops, livestock and fishery are the main sources of household income.

Habiganj is famous for growing a considerable quantity of tea which is one of the most important cash crops of Bangladesh earning a good amount of foreign exchange. More than 20% of tea gardens of Bangladesh are located in this district. The required conditions prevail in this district for growth of tea.

Non-farm activities also play a significant role in economic development of Habiganj district. The following table 1 shows total establishments in the urban and rural areas and persons engaged by sex and activity in Habiganj.

According to the above table, there are 35,121 establishments in the district in which 91,046 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 8.8% as against 91.2% of the males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity (59.6%) with 20,932 establishments and 41,897 persons engaged (46%) in the establishments of Habiganj district.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: The climate and the location of Habiganj district favour the growth and development of a diverse array of plant. For distinct vegetation and different echo system, the district remains in the evergreen and semi evergreen forest among ten divisions of its kind. The district is only a few feet above to the sea level. It is intersected by a few tortuous and sluggish rivers. Due to the existence of a bit different characteristics in nature, the trees and plants growing in the district are somewhat different from those growing in most of the other districts of the country.

The main crops of Habiganj district are paddy, tea, potato, ground nut, battle leaf etc. The district is famous for growing a considerable quantity of tea. More than 20% of tea gardens of Bangladesh are located in this district. Tea grows in moist and hot climate. It generally grows on the slope of hills and hilly regions. It requires excessive rain but rain water must not stay at the root. The basic conditions required for growth of tea prevail in this district and as such plenty of tea grows here.

Mango (Mangifera indica), black berries (Syzygium cumini), jack fruits (Artocarpus heterophyilus), banana (Musa sapientum), coconut (Cocos nucifera), orange (Citrus reticulata), papaya (Carica papaya), lichi (Litchi chinensis), dates (Phoenix sylvestris), water melons, guava (Psidum guajava), wood apples (Aegle marmelos) and palms (Borassus flabellifer) grow in the district. A good variety of flower plants like rose, palash (Butea monosperna), shimul (Bombax ceiba) and chameli (Jasminum pubescus) are found all over the district. There are several small hills covered with green grass and bamboo bushes. Sun grass and bara bamboo (Dendrocalamus lirandissli) trees are abundant all over the district.

The most valuable timber trees such as jarul or ajhar (*Legerstroemia speciosa*), chaplasta, gundroi (*Cinnamonum glauduliforum*), kurta (*Sida acuta*), rata (*Dysoxyhum binee tariferum*) and poma (*Cerdrela toona*) are largely available in the district, and are used for construction of house and boats. Simul (*Bombax ceiba*), mango (*Mangifera indica*), kadam (*Anthocephalus cadmba*) and harish (*Albizzlia stipalata*) are used for making tea boxes. The important trees like shundi (*Mechelin sh*), ping (*Cynometra pobjandra*), koroi (*Albizzia procera*), karal (*Dipterocarpus sh*), jam or black berry (*Syzygiun cumini*), gamar (*Gmelina arborea*), marai, kai-engle, banak, jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyilus*), hartakey (*Terminalia chebula*), bazang, barun, hizal (*Barringtonia acutangula*) and kuma are also found in abundance in the district. Some of these trees and plants normally do not grow in most of the other districts in Bangladesh.

Fauna: Despite importance of ecological integrity and bio-diversity, loss of species and their natural habitats are rapidly increasing in recent years. Bio-diversity is being affected by over exploitation, deforestation, inefficient forest management, agricultural and industrial pollution etc. a proper inventory of the rich biological resources of the country should be made and the economic, social, ecological and ethical values of bio-diversity are yet to be realised and disseminated by all concerned. However, in Habiganj district, there has been fairly good stocktaking of the vertebrate fauna. About 100 years ago elephants were found in the hilly area of the district. Gradually they turned rare and ultimately vanished. Tigers (*Panthera tigris*) are also

rarely found in the northern hilly part of the district. Wild boars (Sus scrofa), sambar (Cervus unicolor), hog deer (Axis porcinus), swamp deer (Cervus duvauceli) are seen in the district.

Various kinds of wild birds have increased its beauty. A good number of birds of different colour, size and habits are found here. Teasing birds like crow (*Corvus splendens*) and kite (*Milvus migrans*) are found in good number. Game birds namely dove, pigeon, snipe, heron (*Mycticarax mycticarax*) and pankawri (*Phalacrococan niger*) are found all over the district. Song birds like cuckoo (*Cuculus microplerus*), shyama (*Copsychus malabaricus*), doel (*Copsychus saularis*), koyel (*Eudynamis scolopacea*), mayna (*Gracula religiosa autra*) and nightingale (*Picnonotus cafer*) are found in different seasons. The cuckoo (*Cuculus microplerus*), the most popular song birds comes to our country at the beginning of spring. Many migratory birds come from abroad during autumn and winter. Hen(*Gallus spp.*), duck (*Caiaina sentulala*), pigeon (*Columba spp.*), dove (*Bhalcophaps indica*) are the domestic birds found almost in every household of the district. Snipe, jungle fowl and marsh partridges are also found.

Fish is an essential staple and plays a very important role in the economy of the locality particularly of the haor area. A large variety of indigenous fishes including carps and many smaller species are available in the district. In the fresh water the popular species are ruhi or salmon (Labeo rohita), mrigel (Cirrhinus mrigala), kalbous (Labeo calbasu), katla or carp (Catla catla), etc. Shoal fish (Channa striatus), scorpion-fish or singi (Heteropneustes fossilis) are also found in large quantity in beels and khals. Many other spieces of river and fresh water fishes are also found in the district. Of these the principal varieties are boal (Wallago atttu), dhain, chital (Notopterus chitala), ghona, airh (Mystus aor), bagair (Bagarius bagarius), pangas (Pangasius pangasius), rita (Rita rita), bain or eel (Mastacembelus armatus)), chapila (Gudusia chapra), bhagna (Labeo boga), nandail (Labeo nandina), bacha (Eutsopichthys vacha), pon, gargle (Arius gagora), kaulia, kapali, khorsols mehsir, gulsha (Mystus bleekeri), tengra (Mystus vittatus), chanda (Mene muculata), tekchanda (Gerres argyreus), kachki (Corica soborna), baila (Glossogobius giuris), batashi (Pseudoutropius atherinoides), ghausa, kakila (Strogylura strogylura), phalli or flat fish (Notopterus notopterus), tatkeni (Crosscheilus latius), pabda (Ompok pabda), chela (Chela cachius), gangchela, gazar (Channa marulius), koi (Anabas testudineus), kholisha (Colisa fasciatus), puti (Barbus puntius), sharputi (Puntius sarana), taki (Channa punctatus), walking fish (Ophicephaalus striaxtus), malandi, bashpata (Danio devario), kakra (Scylla serrata), bheda or meani (Nandus nandus), shrimps and prawn (Farfantetenaeus aztecus) are found in the district. However, some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.

In addition, some exotic varieties of fish such as telapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), silver carp (*Hypophthalmicthys molitrix*), grasscarp (*Cteopharyngodon idella*) are also cultivated in the district and they are also becoming very popular.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza**: Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) Village: Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) Mahalla: Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

- i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.
- **ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). This year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large**: Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

Intensity of cropping =
$$\frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
