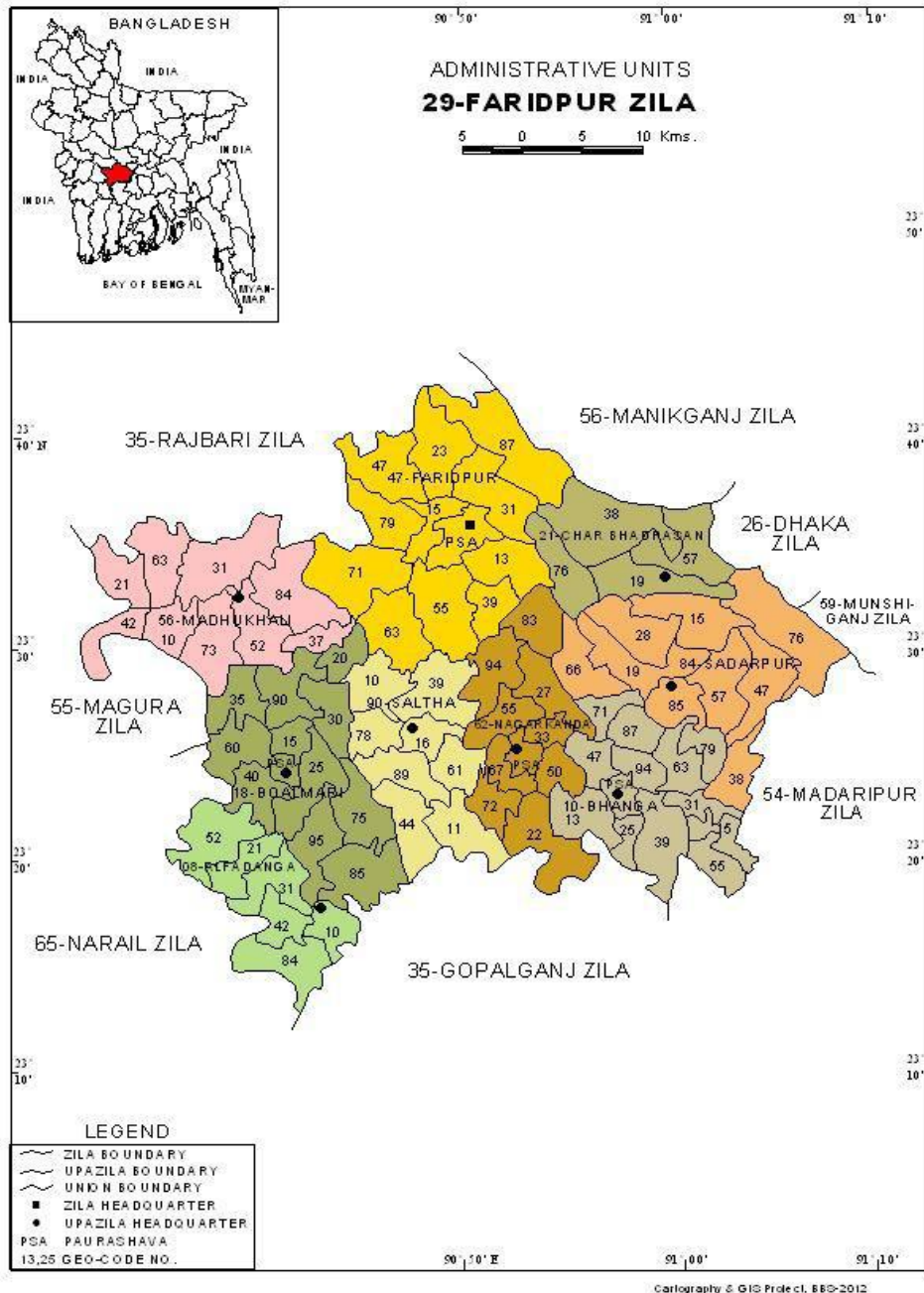

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Originally Faridpur was named Fatehabad. Subsequently, it was renamed as Faridpur after the name of a renowned saint named Shah Farid who settled here at the early thirteenth century. He was buried in the present place of Faridpur town after his death.

Geographic Area and Location: Faridpur is bounded on the north by Manikganj, Dhaka and Rajbari districts, on the east by Madaripur, Dhaka and Munshiganj districts, on the south by Gopalganj and Madaripur districts and on the west by Rajbari, Magura, and Narail districts. At the border area of Faridpur there are two big rivers one is Padma and another is Meghna. Padma separated Faridpur from Pabna & Dhaka districts at its north-east part and merged with Jamuna at Goalanda upazilla of Rajbari district. It lies between 23°17' and 23°40' north latitude and between 89°29' and 90°11' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 2052.86 sq. km (792.00 sq. miles).

Historical & Tourist Place: Gerda mosque (1013 AH), Pathrail mosque and dighee (1493-1519 AD), Satoir mosque (1519 AD), District judge court building (1889 AD), Bhanga munsif court building (1889) are some historical places. Palli Kabi Jasim Uddin's house & graveyard are located at Faridpur District. River research institute, Hazrat Shah Farid mazar, Gour Gopal Angina, Jagabandhu angina, Atrash and Chandrapara Pak Darbar Sharif, Baish roshi Jamidar bari (Sadarpur), Satair Masjid (Boalmari), Mothurapur deul (Modhukhali), Pathrail masjid (Bhanga) are some visiting places of this district.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: Annual average temperature varies from maximum 35.8c to minimum 12.6c and annual rainfall is 1546 mm.

Administrasion: Faridpur district was established in 1815. Faridpur municipality was established in 1869. The district consists of 9 upazila, 81 unions, 1038 mauzas and 1899 villages. It also comprised of 4 paurashavas, 36 paura words and 100 mahallas. The upazilas are Alfadanga, Bhanga, Boalmari, Charbhadrason, Faridpur sadar, Madhukhali, Nagarkanda, Shaltha and Sadarpur.

Renowned Personality: Ambika Charan Majumdar, great Politician & Social worker, Hazi Shariat Ullah, Palli Kabi Jasim Uddin, Bir Shesto Lans Nayek Munsif Abdur Rauf, Iusuf Ali Chowdhury, Politician and Humayun Kabir, Educationalist are from this district.

Constituency: There are 4 constituencies in Faridpur district. Constituency-1 consists of Alfadanga, Boalmari, Madhukhali upazilas. Constituency-2 consists of Nagarkanda, Shaltha upazilas. Constituency-3 consists of Faridpur sadar and Constituency-4 consists of Bhanga, Sadarpur and Charbhadrason upazilas.

Population: Total population of Faridpur district is 19,12,969, of them 9,42,245 is male and female is 9,70,724.

Literacy & Educational Institution: Literacy rate of Faridpur district for both sexes is 49.0%, of them male is 50.3% and female is 47.7%. Number of government collages are 8, non-government collages are 24, government high schools are 6, 189 non-government high school 254, government primary schools are 543 and registered primary school and registered primary school are 277.

Main crops: Paddy, jute, wheat, oilseed, pulse, onion, garlic and sugarcane are main crops of this district.

Industry: Faridpur sugar mill, Karim jute mills, Bs jute mill, Aziz pipes, Nur plastic pipe are some famous industries of Faridpur district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Faridpur is predominantly agricultural. Out of a total of 382,686 holdings of the district, 57.97% holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV paddy, sugarcane, wheat, vegetables, spices, jute, pulses, and other minor cereals. Various fruits like mango, banana, jackfruit, guava, coconut etc. are grown in the district. Almost all kinds of vegetables are cultivated particularly bitter guard (Karala), pumpkin (Misti kumra), potato and brinjal are abundantly grown. Psiculture and rearing of livestock and poultry adds an additional income to the rural households. Fish of different varieties abound in this district. Moreover varieties of fish are caught from rivers, tributary channels, even from paddy field during rainy season. Some valuable timber and forest trees are grown in this district. Out of total 990 sq km of the total area to the district, organized forestry is almost absent but riverine areas occupy about 96.51 sq km. (4.66%) of the total area.

Non-farm activities are also significant in Faridpur. The following table1 shows total establishments in the urban and rural areas and persons engaged by sex and activity in Faridpur district.

According to above table, there are 45,772 establishments in the district in which 123,352 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 7.54% as against 92.46% of the males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity (54.40%) with 24,902 establishments and 49,649 persons engaged (40.25%) in Faridpur district.

Flora and Fauna

Faridpur district extends up to the mighty Padma in the north-east and is criss-crossed by a number of small rivers, rivulets and canals. These rivers sometimes cause serious river erosion. These rivers and water bodies have considerable impact on the flora and fauna of the district. The district with fertile land falls in the Gangetic basin land area and is inundated almost regularly by rain and flood water during monsoon. Like other districts in the region, the district possesses varieties of flora and fauna.

Flora: In the farm lands, varieties of crops namely local and HYV rice, jute, vegetables, spices, pulses, oilseeds, cotton, sugarcane, etc. are produced. Rice covers about 45.42% of the gross temporary cropped area. The district is also famous for producing good quality of jute and sugarcane.

No revenue yielding forests or wild vegetable productions of marketable values are found in Faridpur. Although there is no organized forest area in the district, the plain land is mostly covered under homestead forests containing varieties of fruit trees and other trees. The southern part of the district is comparatively low lying area where one can find homestead forests with luxuriant growth. Those contain indigenous timber trees like koroy (*Albizzia procera*), haldu, bazna (*Zanthophyllum flavescens*), karobi (*Thebetia pervuviana*), sheora (*Streblus asper*), margazaj, Mehogini (*Swietenia macrophylla*), jalpai/olive (*Elaeocarpus tectorius*), bohera (*Terminalia bellirica*), amloki (*Phyllanthus emblica*) etc.

Mango (*Mangifera Indica*), betel nut (*Areca catechu*), jack fruit (*Artocarpus heterohpyllus*), banana (*Musa Sapientum*), coconut (*Cocos Nucifera*), litchi (*Litchi chinensis*), blackberry (*Syzygium cumini*) papaya (*Carica papaya*), jambura/lime (*Citrus decumana*), palm (*Borassus flabellifer*) citrus fruits, melon etc. are among common fruits found in this district. Trees found in this district are gab (*Diospyros precolorius*), hartaki (*Terminalia chebula*), keora (*Sonneratia apetala*), borai, kul (*Zizyphus mauritiana*), sonali (*Cassia fistula*), etc. Marsh plants and weeds are found in great variety and luxuriance and in the beel area, the surface of the marshes are covered with huge stretches of inundated rice or with motted floating islets of sledges and grasses and with various water-lilies, the striking of which is the makana (*Eurale ferox*). The reeds in this area are a source of income. They are made into closely woven mats, while the reed called hogla is used for roofing huts.

Lotus and blue green alga and other living organism are also seen in the district. Almond, banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), jam (*Eugenia jambolanavav*), tamarind or tetul (*Tamariandus indica*), bel (*Aegle marmelos*), kamranga (*Averrho karambola*), jafrol, dumur (*Ficus hispida*), and some other varieties are also found.

The chief species of palm are the and the betel-nut (*Areca catechu*). Date-plum (*Phoenix sylvestris*) are rarely grown in plantations, but usually on the embankments of the fields. Clumps of bamboos are found everywhere. Medicinal plants include balola (*acacia*), madar (*Erythrina ovalifolia*), bhat (*Calamus sp*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), chireta (*Swertia chirita*), dhuteira (*Datura metel*), etc. Besides, the district produces a good number of trees required for fuel and timber of local use.

Fauna: Faridpur district has a rich diversity of land invertebrate mammals, amphibian birds, reptiles and fresh water animals, spiders, multipedes and innumerable insects. Leeches, earthworm slugs, snails, silk moths are commonly found in the district.

Mammals: The mammalian fauna that are usually seen Faridpur district comprises domestic cow, goat, sheep, buffalo and horses. Carnivorous animals include fox, dog, boar, pig, etc are also found.

Birds: Many kinds of colorful and singing birds are seen in the district include the national bird magpie robin (*Copsychus saularis*), shalik (*Acridotheres tristis*), kokil/cuckoo (*Cuculus micropterus*), halde pakhi (*Oriolus xanthornus*), kingcrow (*Dicrurns adsimilis*), myna (*Sturnus malabarica*), shyama (*Copsychus malabaricus*), sparrow (*Passer domesticus*), several species of pheasants, quails, pigeons and dove, duck (*Cairina sentulata*), balihash, cocks, and hens (*Gallus spp*), kingfisher (*Alcedo atthis*), lark (*Eremophila alpestris*), swallow (*Hirundo rustica*), crow (*Corvus splendens*), crane, pelicans, woodpecker (*Picus myrmecophoneus*) and many other varieties of small birds. Raptorial birds include king vulture (*Trogos calvus*), laner falcon or baj (*Falco Biarmicus*), gochila (*Circus aeruginosus*), cheel (*Migyans lineatas*), several species of stork. Some migratory birds like greenleg laxmi pencha (*Tyto Alba*), khuruley pencha (*Athene brama*) etc.

Fish: With large water area the district is well stocked with fish , of which hilsa is found found so abundantly in the river Padma that it earns good amount of foreign exchange apart from meeting domestic demand. Some of the commonly available fishes are ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalbous (*Labeo calbasu*) katla (Catla catla) etc. soalfish/magur (*Amblyceps mangois*) scorpion-fish/singi (*Heteropneustes fossilis*) are also found in large quantity in beels and khals , Many other spieces of river and fresh water fishes are also found in the district. Of these the principal varieties are koral/vetki (*Lates calcarifer*), tapasi (*Polynemus paradiseus*), dhain, chital (*Notopterus chitala*), ghona (*Labeo gonius*), airh (*Mystas aor*), bagair (*Bagarius bagarius*), pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*), boal (*Wallago attu*), ritha (*Rita rita*), bain or eel (*Mastacembelus armatus*), chapila (*Gudusia chapra*), bhagna (*Labeo boga*), nandail bacha (*Eutropichthys vacha*), pon, gargle, kaulia, kapali, khorsols mehsir, golsa (*Mystus bleekeri*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chanda (*Mene muculata*), tekchanda, kachki (*Corica soborna*) baila (*Awaous gutum*), bheda (*Nendus randus*), batashi (*Pseudoutropius atherinoides*), kakila (*Strogylura strogylura*), phalli (*Notopterus notopterus*), tatkeni, pabda (*Ompok pabda*), chela (*Chela atpar*), gangchela, gazar (*Channa marulius*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), khalisha (*Colisa fasciatus*), puti (*Barbus puntius*), malandi, bashpata (*Ailia punctata*), lengra, kakra (*Scylla serrata*), meai, shrimps, and prawn (*Farfantepenaeus aztecus*) are found in the district. However , some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.

In addition, some exotic varieties of fish such as tilapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*), grass carp (*Cteopharyngodon idella*) are also cultivated in the district and they are also becoming very popular.

Reptiles: The district contains in its area few species of reptiles and amphibians. The reptiles include different species snakes, lizard (*Hemidactylus brooki*), and tortoises (*Trionyx hurum*). iguano, python (*Python monerus*), cobra (*Naja naja*) and other varieties of poisonous snakes are found almost all over the district.

Amphibians: The amphibians consist of toad, frogs and tree frogs.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

- i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.
- ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). This year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
