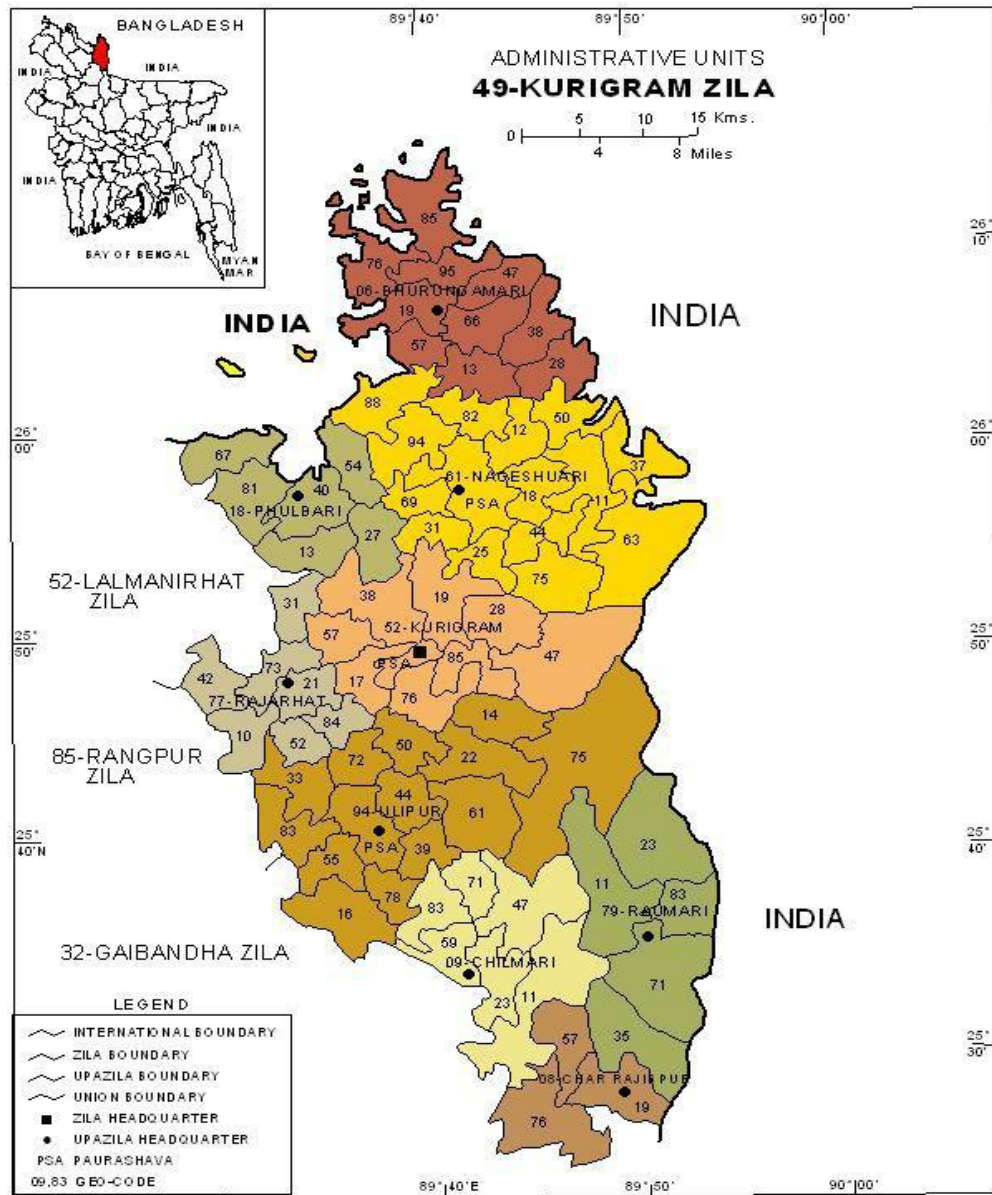

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Kurigram district is located in the northern Bangladesh and in part of Rangpur Division. Kurigram was one of the subdivisions of Rangpur District. It was upgraded to district on the 1st January, 1984. Nothing is definitely known about the origin of the district name. The most popular view is that in the long past, the present place of the district sadar was a residential area of **Kuri** (Twenty) families of the Meech tribes in consequence of which the place was named as Kurigram.

Area and Location: Kurigram is bounded on the north by Coochbihar District of West Bengal State of India, east by Assam State of India, south by Jamalpur District and Gaibandha District and west by Lalmonirhat District, Rangpur District and West Bengal State of India. It lies between 25°23' and 26°14' north latitudes and between 89°27' and 89°54' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 2245.04 sq. km.

Administration: Kurigram subdivision was established in 1874 and was upgraded to a district in 1984. The district consists of 9 upazilas, 72 unions, 600 mauzas, 1872 villages, 3 paurashavas, 27 wards, 203 mahallas and 14 enclaves. The names of upazilas are Bhurungamari, Char Rajibpur, Chilmari, Phulbari, Kurigram Sadar, Nageswari, Rajarhat, Raumari and Ulipur.

Township: Kurigram Municipality was created in 1972. It was renamed as Kurigram Paurashava in 1977. It consists of 9 wards and 106 mahallas. The total area of the paurashava is 27.04 sq. km. The town stands on the bank of the river Dharala.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Among the archaeological heritage, remnants of a mosque (Mughal period, 1176 AH) at Nayarhat (Rajarhat), remnants of a mosque near Patweshwari Bazar (Mughal period), three domed mosque (Mughal period) at village Majider Par of Thanahat Union (Bhurungamari), Arabic inscription of a mosque (Hussain Shahi period, now preserved at the Rajshahi Barendra Museum), Joymoni Zamindar Bari, Naodanga Zamindar Bari and Mandir (Phulbari), Pangeshwari Mandir and remnants of the Rajbari (Rajarhat), image of Kali at Dasherhat, images of Mangal Chandi, Kamakha Devi, Laksmi and Sattanarayan in front of the Bhetarbandh Zamindar Bari, Kali Siddheshwari Mandir (Ulipur), two canons of Panga Kingdom (preserved at the BGB Gate) are the notable.

Historical Events: Devi Chaudhurani and Bhabani Pathak revolted against the British Rule. They built their secret hermitages in the deep forests. They conducted many encounters against the British and their collaborators during 1760-1783. The movements namely, Quit-India Movement, Tebhaga Movement and Satyagraha Movement spread over Kurigram. During the War of Liberation, Raumari, Rajibpur (except Kodalkati union) and Phulbari Upazilas were beyond the reach of the Pakistani Army. Many direct encounters between the Freedom Fighters and the Pak army were occurred in this district in which about 100 Freedom Fighters were killed.

Marks of the War of Liberation: There are 11 mass graves at Nageshwari Upazila, Bhurungamari Upazila, Ulipur Upazila and Kurigram Sadar Upazila; two mass killing sites at Bhurungamari Upazila and Chilmari Upazila. There are also 4 memorial monuments, one martyr memorial plate at Ghosh Para and one Victory pillar at the turning point near the College. A memorial plank with names of 18 freedom fighters in front of the Ulipur Muktiyoddha Office bears the testimony of the War of Liberation in Kurigram District.

Famous Personalities: Some of the famous personalities of this district are mentioned below:

- **Lieutenant Ashfakus Samad, BU:** A martyr freedom fighter. He was awarded Bir Uttam (BU), the second highest national award for his valour and bravery during Liberation War of Bangladesh in 1971.
- **Shaukat Ali Sarkar, BB:** He was a freedom fighter. He was awarded the title Bir Bikram (BB) for this bravery contribution to the Liberation War of Bangladesh in 1971.
- **Ahmed Ali Baksh:** An organiser of freedom fighter and social worker.
- **Mia Abdul Hafiz:** A politician and leader of Anti-British Movement.
- **Baroda Sundari:** A leader of Anti-British Movement.

Temperature and Rainfall: The annual average temperature of the district varies maximum 32.3°C to minimum 11.2°C and the average annual rainfall of the district is recorded 2931 mm.

Main Rivers: The Brahmaputra, Dharala, Tista, Dudhkumar, Phulkumar, Sonaburi, Jinjiram Gangadhar, Halhali and Jalchira are the main rivers of this district.

Main Crops: This district is essentially an agricultural district. The major agricultural crops of Kurigram District are paddy, jute, wheat, potato, corn, chilli, peanut, bamboo, betel nut, betel leaf, pulses and vegetable.

Main Fruits: The common fruits found in this district are mango (*Mangifera indica*), date (*Phoenix sylvestris*), jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*) and tal/palm (*Borassus flabellifer*).

Transport: Palanquin, horse carriage, bullock cart, gaina boat, the traditional transports found in the rural area of Kurigram District are either extinct or nearly extinct. Now-a-days, all the upazilas are connected with the district headquarters with metalled roads. Bus, minibus, three wheelers ply over the district.

Locally published Newspapers and Periodicals: There are some daily and weekly newspapers in this district as Daily Jagobahey, Daily Ajker Kurigram, Daily Kurigram Khobor and Daily Shokaler news, Daily Charideka Protidin, Daily Banglar Manuse, Weekly Dharla, Weekly Gonokotha, Weekly Tato kotha etc.

NGO: Operationally important NGOs of this district are BRAC, RDRS, Care, ASA, Save the Children, Swanirvar Bangladesh, Jibika, Diganta Samaj Unnayan Sangstha, Chinnamukul etc.

Economic Situation: The economy of Kurigram District is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 469,713 holdings of the district, 58.69% household are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV paddy, sugarcane, wheat, vegetables, jute, pulses spices cash crops, oilseeds, maize and other minor crops. Various fruits like pineapple, banana, jackfruit, mango, guava, coconut, papaya, palm, lichi, blackberries, dates etc. are also grown in the district. Fish of different varieties abound in the district. Varieties of fishes are caught from rivers, tributary

channels and creeks and even from paddy fields during rainy season. Besides crops, livestock and fishery are the main sources of household income.

Non-farm economic activities are also significant in Kurigram. The following table-1 shows total establishments in the urban & rural areas and persons engaged by sex and activity in the establishments of Kurigram district.

According to the above table, there are 42,621 establishments in Kurigram District in which 110,191 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 6.56 % as against 93.44% of the males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity (57.62%) with 24,560 establishments and 45,806 persons (41.57%) engaged in the establishments.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: Kurigram lies above then northern tropic and has common border with the districts of Lalmonirhat, Rangpur and Gaibandha. Besides the entire eastern and northern boundary line touches India. The district is a reverine one. All these factors influence the growth of plants and trees in the district. Practically there exists no reserve forest.

The district possesses a great variety of trees. The shady banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*) and the stately papal (*Ficus religiosa*) attain a very great size. Jackfruit trees (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*) are numerous and the timber is in great demand for the manufacture of furniture. The wood takes a

very fine polish. Mango wood is not as good, but is often used for the shatters of doors, windows and for ploughs.

The sisoo (*Dalbergia sissoo*) is very common in the district. The timber is of excellent quality and is much used for furniture, rafters, beams and door frames. The karay (*Albizia procera*) has hard wood which is principally used for constructing the framework of corrugated iron roofs. The sal (*Shorea robusta*) grown in the district is inferior to the hill trees. It is used for pillar or support and frame work of houses and for building boats and cart wheels. The babul (*Acacia arabica*) is found all over the district but does not reach a great size. The wood is hard and durable and is largely utilized in making cart wheels and ploughs. The jarul (*Lagerstroemia speciosa*) is much, sought after for boat building, and the jam (*Eugenia jambolanavav*), another myrtle (*Eugenia jambolana*), is largely used for cheap furniture and boxes. Among the other timber trees mention may be made of the simul (*Bombax ceiba*), the haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), the bakul (*Mimusops elengi*) and the raktachandhan (*Pterocarpus santalinus*). The jaga or jeul (*Jatropha gossypifolia*) is a tree of rapid growth and is used for hedges and boundary fences.

The trees of the genus citrus are usually called jamir or nebu (*Citrus limettoides*) in the district. The neem (*Azadirachta indica*) is found all over the district. The tejpata is cultivated on account of its aromatic leaves and is used as seasoning for food. Among the ornamental trees are the nageswar (*Mesua nagassarium*), the hijal (*Barringtonia acutangula*) and the sonali. The champa (*Michelia champaca*) is a favorite tree in gardens and villages on account of its sweet smelling flowers.

The tamarind tree (*Tamarindus indica*) is now found all over the district. A species of tamarix locally known as jhau (*Casuarina littorea*) is common. Among other exotics, of which a few plant types exist are mahogany (*Swietenia macrophylla*), teak (*Shorea*) and the raintree (*Samanca saman*).

Many varieties of palms (*Borassus flabellifer*) are found in the district, the chief being the betel nut (*Areca Catechu*). The coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), date (*Phoenix sylvestris*), palm (*Borassus flabellifer*) and palmyra palm also growth in the district. A few varieties of bamboo (*Bambusa bambus*) namely bara bans, talla bans, beru bans, makla bans grow in plenty. The canes of the district are of inferior quality while the reeds are of more importance. The beels and marnhes in the district are usually covered with a variety of aquatic vegetation. In the rains a species of andropogon (*Spear grass*) locally known as char kanta grows abundantly in every open space and is roads and pathways to the great discomfort of the pedestrians. Bhang (*Bufo melanostictus*) or wild hemp grows as a roadside weed. In the woods giant creepers of the thickness of cables are found.

Fauna: In early times tigers (*Panthera tigris*), buffaloes (*Bubalus bubalis*) and elephants (*Elephas maximus*) were not uncommon all over the district. But the spread of humane habitations and the destruction of jungles have compelled their retirement to more secure abodes in the forest of other hilly district now in India. Among the carnivore the leopard (*Panthera pardus*) is the only one that is found rare in the jungle. Jackals (*Canis aureus*) move about the villages in large number. Wild pigs (*Sus scrofa*) are common, especially in the char lands. The fox (*Vulpes bengalensis*), several

species of the mongoose (*Herpestes edwardsi*) family and hares (*Orvctulagus cuniculus*) are found in the forest jungles. They invade the fields at night in large number and are haunted down by the villagers. Bears (*Ursus thibetanus*) and deer (*Muntiacus muntjak*) which were once common are no longer met with, and monkeys (*Macaca mulatta*) and porcupines are rare. Squirrels (*Callosciurus pygerythrus*), mice (*Mus musculus*) and rats (*Rattus rattus*), represent the rodent tribe.

The district has a great variety of birds. The beels and marshes are tenanted by a large aquatic population including rails, coots, water hens (*Oriolus xanthornus*), storks, herons (*Mycticarax*), cranes, cormorants, divers, dabchicks, waders, gulls, terns and paddy-birds. In the cold weather great flights of duck (*Cairina sentulata*) and teal visit the district. The most ordinary varieties are common teal, whistling teal, blue-winged teal, common wild duck (*Cairina sentulata*), widgeon, gadwali, white eyed pochard and shovellers; pintail, red-headed pochard and crested pochard are rare. Geese (Grey and bare-headed) and the brahmani duck (*Cairina sentulata*) are frequently seen on the banks of the local rivers. Snipe of the common, painted and jack species are fairly numerous and there are many varieties of sand pipers, stains and snippets. Black partridge and quail are met with. Plover of the golden and grey varieties are also found. Ortolans are netted in large number. Jungle fowl and florican are now very seldom seen. There are several varieties of vultures (*Gyps bengalensis*), owls (*Bubo leyleensis*), kites (*Milvus migrans*), hawks and buzzards. Shrikes take their toll of the smaller birds all over the district. The common and the carrion crow are seen everywhere.

The golden oriole adds a brilliant touch of colour to the sombre mango (*Mangifera indica*) groves. The bamboo (*Bambusa bambus*) plantations are the home of numerous doves (*Streptopelia chinensis*), finches, warblers and tits. Bulbuls (*Pycnotus cafer*) enliven the low thickets with their typical music. Plum trees are often covered with hanging nests of the weaver bird (*Ploceus baya*). Swallows (*Ploceus philippinus*), martins, woodpeckers (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), cuckoo (*Cuculus micropterus*), wagtails, munias, sand-larks, bush-larks, sparrows (*Passer domesticus*), paradise flycatchers are numerous all over the district.

Reptiles are abundant in the district. The common cobra (*Naja naja*) and the krait are the chief venomous varieties of snakes and are the cause of frequent fatalities. Turtles and tortoises (*Kachuga tecta*) abound in the rivers. Lizards (*Hemidactylus brooki*) are seen everywhere.

The usual varieties of fish found in the watery plains of the country are well represented in the district. Several species of the carp are found; the most prized being the ruhi (Labeo rohita), Katla (Catla catla), mrigel (Cirrhinus mrigala), chanda (Mene mukulata), chela and puti (Barbus phutunio), shoil (Channa striatus), taki (Channa punctatus), koi (Anabas testudineus), khalisha (Colisa fasciata). Among varieties with smooth and lubricous skins are the baghair, bheda (Nandus nandus), kachki, baccha, rita (Rita rita), and the tengra (Mystus vittatus) all members of the pimelodus species and the kalbaush (Labeo. calbasu), boal (Wallago attu), magur (Clarias batrachus), chital (Notopterus chitala), pabda (Ompok pabda), shing (Heteropneustes fossilis) of the silurus species. Among other well known varieties are the bain or eel (Mastacembelus armatus) and the chingri or prawn (Partante penaeus agtecis), dhain, baghair, pangas (Pangasius pangasius), chapila (Gudusia chapra), kachki (Carica soborna) etc.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
