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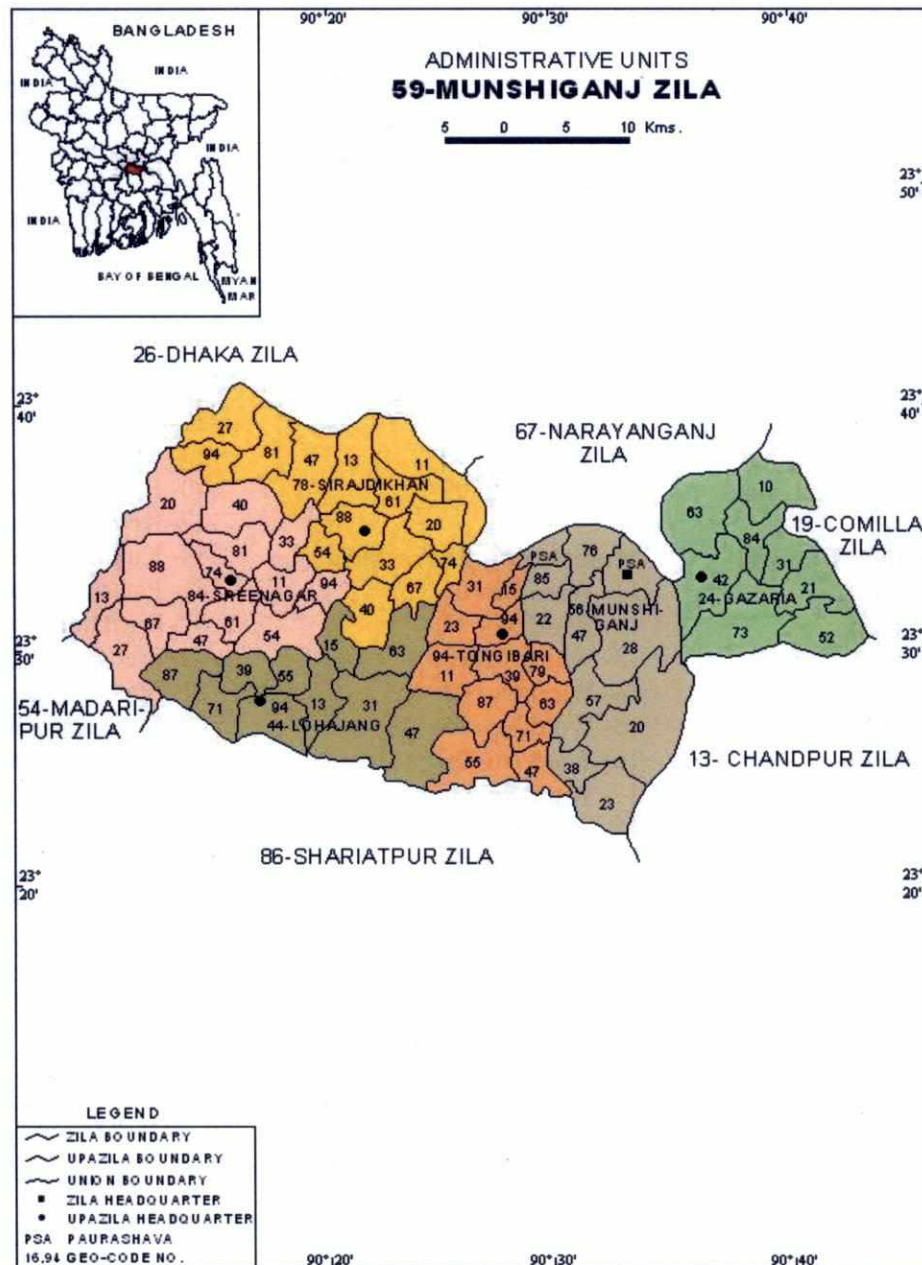
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Munshiganj was a sub-division of former Dhaka district. It was upgraded to a district on 26 February, 1984. There are different views about the origin of the district name. The most popular view goes with the fact that the present area of the district was under the jurisdiction of a Zaminder named Munshi Enayet Ali who set up a trading centre locally called Ganj in the present district headquarters. It is generally believed that the district might have originated its name from the words **Munshi** and **Ganj**.

Geographic Area and Location: Munshiganj is bounded on the north by Dhaka and Narayaganj districts, on the east by Comilla and Chandpur districts, on the south by Shariatpur and Madaripur districts and on the west by Dhaka and Faridpur districts. The total area of the district is 1004.29 sq. km (387.00 sq. miles). It lies between 23°29' and 23°45' north latitudes and between 90°10' and 90°43' east longitudes.

Climate: The climate of the district is tropical in nature. The temperature is almost uniform throughout the year. The maximum and minimum mean temperatures during the winter vary from 25.8°C to 12.1°C. During summer the maximum and minimum mean temperatures vary from 34.6°C to 25.6°C. The dry winter season starts from November and continues up to the end of February. Summer begins from mid of March and continues up to mid of June. The rainfall is generally heavy during July and August. The annual rainfall of the district recorded in 2011 was 2376 millimeters. The level of humidity is around 70 percent in January and around 84 percent in July.

River System: The main rivers flowing through the Munshiganj district are the Padma, the Meghna, the little Brahmaputra, the Dhaleswari, the Ichamati and the Sitalakhya. They are non-tidal and most of them are navigable throughout the year. Total flowing length of all the rivers in the district is about 64 kms. The southern and eastern parts of the district often fall victim to erosion caused by the mighty Padma and the Meghna respectively. Main depression is Arial Beel covering an area of 4330 hectare.

Administration: The district consists of 6 upazilas, 67 unions, 662 mauzas, 919 villages, 2 paurashavas, 18 wards and 73 mahallas. The upazilas are Gazaria, Tongibari, Serajdikhan, Lauhajang, Sreenagar and Munshiganj Sadar.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Idrakpur Fort (1660) in Munshiganj town, Panditer vita (birth place of Atish Dipankar) at Bajrayogini, Baba Adam's Mosque, Dighee of Raja Haris chandra, home stead of Raja Ballal Sen, home stead of Raja Sreenath at Rampal, Rampal Dighee, Kodal Dhoar Dighi, Shyamsiddhi Math at Sreenagar, Hasara Dargah, Sholaghar Math, Bhagyakul Rajbari, residence of Jagadis Chandra Basu at Radhikhal, Jora Math at Sonarang, Kalibari at Tongibari, Taltala Pancha-shikhara Mahadeva Temple, Talukdarbari Mosque at Kusumpur, Tajpur Mosque, Patharghata Mosque, Kazishal Mosque, Palghata Bridge, Panch Pir Dargah are notable archaeological heritage and relics of Nunshiganj district.

Historical Events: The area comprising the district of Munshiganj stretching on the west of the Meghna and Dhaleshwari had been included in the kingdom of Vikramapura in the ancient period. During the Sena rule Vikramapura in East Bengal had been the second capital of the Senas in addition to their capital at Nadia. After the fall of Nadia in the hands of Bakhtiyar Khalji (1204) the Sena King Lakshmanasena fled to Vikramapura and began to rule East Bengal. After the death of Lakshmanasena (1206) his descendants Visvarupasena and Kesavasena ruled in Vikramapura till at least 1223 AD. Some historians postulate that the sons of Lakshmanasena ruled in Vikramapura up to 1243-45 AD. Raja Dasarathadeva Danujmadhava (Danuj Rai), the Deva king of Chandradvipa, ousted the Senas from Vikramapura in the third quarter of the thirteenth century and ruled the south-eastern Bengal till the end of the thirteenth century. During the Mughal rule the present Munshiganj town including the outlying areas was known as Idrakpur which was named after the then Mughal faujdar Idrak. A village on the outskirts of Munshiganj town is still known as Idrakpur. During the British rule Idrakpur was renamed as Munshiganj after the name of Munshi Enayet Ali, the local Zamindar and the inhabitant of the village Kazi Kasba in Rampal. During the War of Liberation of 1971 the Pak army raided Munshiganj and Kewar on 9 and 14 May respectively and killed some youths there. They launched an attack on the innocent villagers at Gazaria upazila on 5 May and killed about four hundred villagers by gun-shot. The people of Narayanganj in alliance with youths of Munshiganj resisted an attack of the Pak army on Narayanganj on 31 March. Hundreds of youths were recruited as freedom fighters and were given military training at Dhalgaon area in the month of July and they took part in various operations against the Pak army.

Marks of War of Liberation: 3 Mass killing sites, 3 memorial monuments and 1 mass grave are marks of the war of liberation of this district.

Main Crops: Potato, jute, rice, betel leaf, wheat, mustard, sesame, gram, lentil, pea, chilli, coriander, ground nut, maize, patal, karalla, tomato, sweet pumpkin, vegetables etc are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Banana, mango, papaya, jackfruit, litchi, melon, watermelon, black berry, pomegranate, guava, wood apple, shaddock, plum, palm, coconut etc are main fruits of this district.

Main Export Items: Potato, banana, paddy, patal, jute, betel leaf, sweet pumpkin, vegetables, milk, milk food, sack, cotton yarn, copper utensil, bamboo and cane materials are main export items of this district.

Economic Situation: The rural economy of Munshiganj district is predominantly agriculture. Farm holdings that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV rice, jute, wheat, vegetables, spices, cash crops, pulses and others. Munshiganj district is famous for the production of potato and pumpkin. Various fruits, like banana, guava, etc, are grown. Varieties of fish are caught from rivers, channels and from paddy fields during rainy season. Live stock farming is another source of income of the people of Munshiganj district. Most of the milk that produces varieties of sweets in Dhaka city is supplied from Munshiganj district.

The status of non-farming activities in the district is neither high nor low. The following table-1 shows the number of establishments, persons and their distribution by major activity.

Flora

The district of Munshiganj is located in the old ganges flood plain under Mature Delta. The soil conditions here are different at different locations. The soils are heavy dark clays in Sreenagar upazila while they are yellowish, friable silt loams, silty clay loams in sadar, Tngibari and Lauhajang upazilas of the district. In the south-eastern part of the district, soils are mainly olive-brown silt loams to silty clays. There are extensive man-made raised land near Munshiganj and a large depression known as Arial Beel.

The major agricultural crops include broadcast aman, aus, boro, jute, wheat, pulses, spices, vegetables, sugarcane, tobacco, betel leaf cheena, kaun, sweet potato, different varieties of kachu etc.

Munshiganj is one of the largest potato growing areas of the country. It is the main cash crop of the district. The district has a great reputation for producing varieties of bananas, the popular variety being sagarkala. Other varieties are kabri, sabri, chinichampa, martaman, agniswar, amritabhog, etc.

The homestead flora of the district is largely similar to that of adjoining district. The villages seem to be buried in groves of mango, figs, bananas, and bamboos with the betelnut palm, palmyra, date palm and coconut palm. Other trees that surround the homesteads are Jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), kamranga (*Averrho karambola*), bel (*Aegle marmelos*), pepe (*Carica papaya*), black berry (*Syzygium cumini*), boroi (*Zizyphus mauritiana*), jambura (*Citrus decumana*), sajna

(*Moringa obifera*), dalim (*Punica granatum*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), bokul (*Mimusops elengi*), mandar (*Erythrina variegata*), palash (*Butea monosperma*), shimul (*Bombax ceiba*), Boro bans (*Bambusa falcooa*), baria bans (*Bambusa vulgaris*), kadam (*Anthocephalus cadamba*), pitraj (*Aphanamixis polystachya*), jarul (*Lagerstroemia speciosa*), bhadi (*Lannea coromandelica*) etc

Besides, road side trees and the trees that have been planted within the compound of Govt. offices and residential buildings include bot (*Ficus benghalensis*), neem (*Azadirachta indica*), akashmoni (*Acacia seholarsis*), raintree (*Samanca saman*), arjun (*terminalia arjuna*), tentul (*Tarmariandus indica*) etc.

The floating macrophytes like kachuri pana (*Eichhornia crassipes*), topa pana (*Pista stratiotes*), khudipana (*Lemna paucicos*), singara (*Trapa bispinosa*) etc. are often found in different village ponds of the district. The shallower water vegetation namely, shapla (*Nymphaea nouchali*), padma (*Nelumbo nucifera*), kalmi (*Ipomoea aquatica*), helencha (*Tilanthera philoxcroides*), etc are also seen there.

Few species of epiphytes and parasites are seen living on larger trees like rain tree, seedlings of bot and ashotha are also frequently found parasitizing on other trees.

Homestead thickets and shrubberies often give support to many climbers and twiners namely, shim, pui etc. Besides, some flower plants are also grown for aesthetic purposes.

Fauna

Mammals

Of the mammalian fauna the most familiar species that are found in the district are: Pigmy pipistrelle (*Pipistrellus mimus*), tickel's bat (*Hesperoptenus tickelli*), beji (*Herpestes edwardsi*), rat (*Rattus rattus*), house mouse (*Mus musculus*), metho mouse (*Musbooduga*), shial (*Canis aureus*), ud biral (*Aonyx cinerea*) and dura Katbrali (*funambululus pennanti*).

Some species of mammals are now rarely seen in the district. These are banar (*Macaca mullata*), fox (*vulpes bengalensis*), khargosh (*Lepus nigricollis*), sajuru (*Atherurus macroourus*), khatash (*Viverra zibetha*), large bandicoot (*Bandicota bengalensis*), jungle cat (*Felis chaus*) etc.

Birds

Different species of birds that are commonly seen in this district are: Little cormorant (*Phalacrocorac niger*), kana korchy bok (*ardeola grayii*), machranga (*Alcedo atthis*), kaththokra (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), kali pencha (*dicrurus adsimilis*), choto finky (*Dicrurus macrocercus*), bhat shalik (*acridotheres tristis*), charui (*Passer domesticus*), holdey pakhi (*Oriolus Xanthornus*), laxmi pencha (*tyto alba*), tila ghuga (*Streptopelia chinensis*), dahuk (*Amaurornis phoenicurus*), tia (*Psillacula Krameri*), robin bird (*Copsychus saularis*), babui (*Ploceus phillippinus*), crow (*Corvus splendens*), common hawk cuckoo (*Cuculus varies*), river tern (*Sterna aurantia*), cotton teal (*Nettapus coromandelianus*), lesser whistling teal (*Dendrocygna javanica*), water rail (*Rallus aquaticus*) etc.

The migrant birds that come to visit different swamps of the district are Tibetan shrike (*Lanius tephronotus*), little ringet plover (*Charadrius dubius*), common sand piper (*Tringa hypoleucos*),

pintailed snipe (*Gallinago stenura*), fantail snipe (*Gallinago gallinago*), grey wagtail (*Motacilla cinerea*), brown shrike (*Lanius cristatus*), large pariah kite (*Milvus migyanlineatas*), graylag goose (*Anser anser*), brahminy duck (*Tadorna ferruginea*), common shelduck (*Tadorna tadorna*), Common teal (*Anas crecca*), tree pipit (*Anthus hodgsoni*), common pochard (*Anas farina*), plover (*Charadrius alenasdrinus*), Common tern (*Sterna hirusdo*), marsh harrier (*Circus aeruginosus*), herring gull (*Larus argentatus*), gadwall (*Anas strepera*), etc.

Reptiles and amphibians

Reptiles usually found in the district include peacock soft shell (*Trionyx hurum*), common house lizard (*Hemidactylus frenatus*), yellow turtle (*Morenia petersi*), yellow speckled wolf snake (*Lycodon jara*), smooth water snake (*Enhydrus enhydris*), common krait (*Bungarus fasciatus*), and bengal cobra (*Naja naja*).

Amphibians like common toad (*Bufo melanostictus*), Indian bull frog (*Rana tigrina*), ornate microhylid (*Microhyla ornata*) and skipper frog (*Rana cynophlyctis*) are also found here. And skipper frog (*Rana cyanophlyctis*) are also

Fishes

A wide variety of indigenous and exotic fishes are available in this district. In the fresh water, the popular species are ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), katla (*Catla catla*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalbaush (*Labeo calbasu*), airh (*Mystus aor*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), magur (*Clarias batrachus*), sar punti (*Puntius sarana*), pabda (*Ompok pabda*), pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*), chital (*Notopterus chitala*), bacha (*Eutropichthys vacha*), and hilsa (*Hilsa ilisha*), etc. Besides, exotic varieties of fishes namely, silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), tilapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), grass carp (*Cteopharyngodon idella*), etc. have also been introduced in the district.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). This year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
