

## U.S. Jobs - February 2021

## **Overview**

The *IA Industry Indicators* (3i) Report: U.S. Jobs presents monthly insights on the U.S. job market using data from national and internet-based resources. It tracks trends in the traditional and freelance job markets and presents unique information on hiring, job openings, and online income.

## Traditional Job Openings<sup>1</sup>


- Online full-time (FT) and part-time (PT) job postings increased by 11.4 percent and 13.2 percent respectively month-over-month in January 2021.
- National job openings continued to decrease by 2.2 percent month-over-month and by 10.6 percent year-over-year in December 2020.

## **Internet Work Resources**

- The use of the internet to earn income declined by 0.6 percent and average income earned online dropped by \$3,911.25 month-over-month in January 2021.
- The use of the internet to search, apply, and get hired for a job dropped by 0.6 percent, 2.6 percent, and 5.9 percent month-over-month, respectively.
