Common Native Wildflowers in Conejo Open Space Areas

Open space areas in the Conejo Valley host a broad diversity of flowering plants thanks to the variety of habitat types that are present in these areas. This guide identifies native wildflowers and flowering shrubs commonly found along trails in open space areas managed by the Conejo Open Space Conservation Agency (COSCA). Bloom times for some species occur as early as January, while others occur as late as September. The plants below are arranged by general color group (White/Cream, Yellow/Orange, Pink/Red, Blue/Purple) and then alphabetically by plant family, genus, and species.
