Working Bees/all mail will be emailed through by our Secretary as required. If you are the Convenor, please ensure all working bees are opened up to all members - that's why they joined!

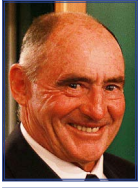

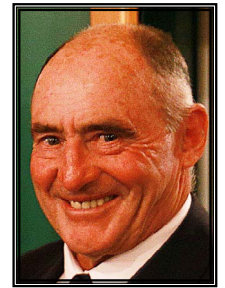


Rusty and Vern receiving their Melvin Jones Fellow Awards.
