

## **A Chamber of Commerce Building.**

A special meeting of the Committee on Building of the Chamber of Commerce was held in the chamber yesterday, and to the committee were added Charles A. Schieren, Oscar S. Straus, and John D. Crimmins. It was decided to issue a circular reporting progress in the creating of a fund for the erection of a Chamber of Commerce Building to the members of the chamber. About \$450,000 has been subscribed, and the sum of \$1,000,000 will, it is believed, be at the disposition of the Chamber of Commerce in a couple of weeks, as the amount in hand came from but 80 of the 1,150 members.
