

Mifepristone Ordering Information

There are two distributors of the medicine mifepristone in the United States. GenBioPro is the distributor of the generic mifepristone pill. To order the generic through GenBioPro visit their website www.MifeInfo.com. Danco is the distributor of branded mifepristone, called Mifeprex®, in the United States. To order mifepristone (Mifeprex®) from Danco visit their website www.earlyoptionpill.com.

Some important information to know when ordering mifepristone:

- Mifepristone is only sold directly to health care providers, not directly to pharmacies.
- The first time you place an order for mifepristone, you must read and sign the distributor's prescriber agreement and account setup form. - Fax the completed Prescriber Agreement and Account Setup Form to the distributor. Danco will also need a copy of your state license number and DEA#.
- After your account is set up, future orders can be made over the phone by calling the distributor directly. You can call GenBioPro at 1-877-239-8036. You can call Danco at 1-877-432-7596.
- Payment is by credit card or established line of credit.
- Shelf life of mifepristone is 18 months.
- Any unused, unopened Mifeprex® pills can be returned to Danco for refund or exchange up to one year after expiration date.
