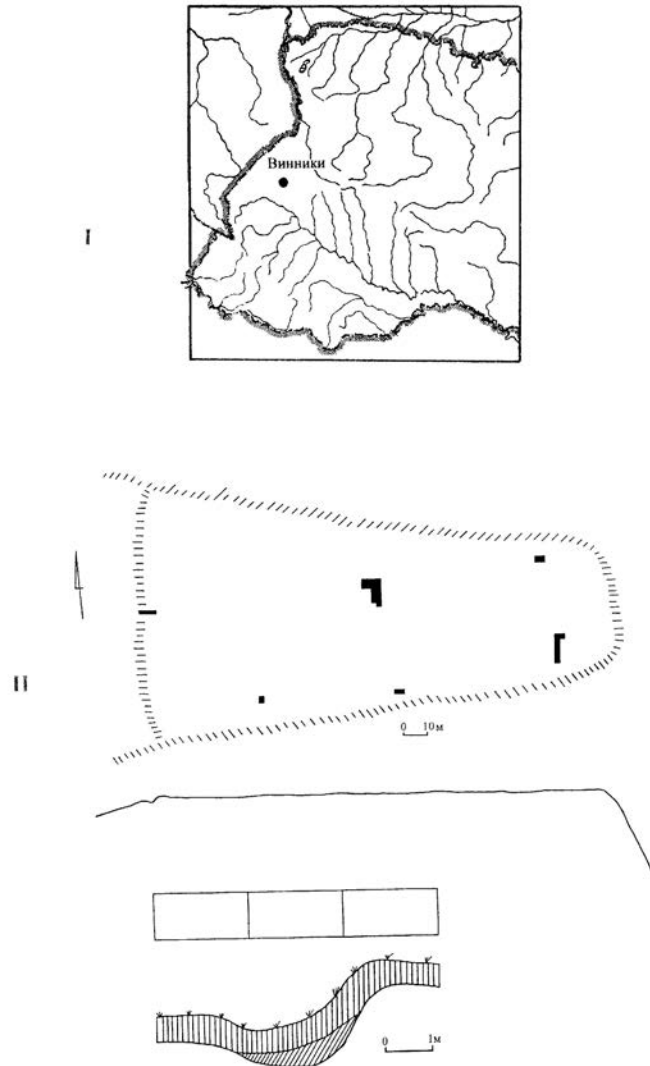


Fig. 1. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. I – location of the settlement on the map of Ukraine; II – topographic plan of site with marked places of excavations, trenches and sections of rampart and ditch researched by M. Peleschyshyn in 1963 (from archive of Ivan Krypiakevych institute of Ukrainian studies).

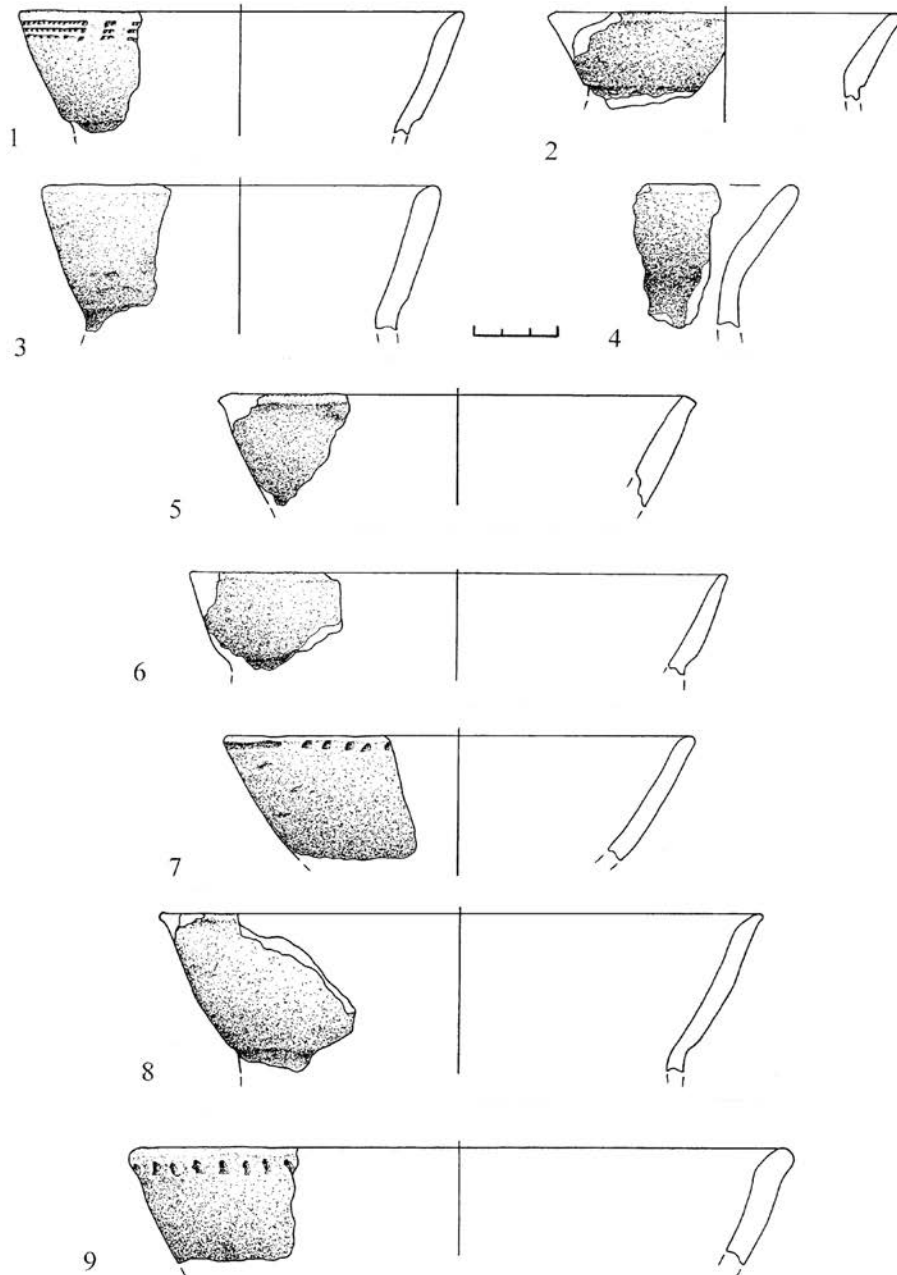


Fig. 2. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

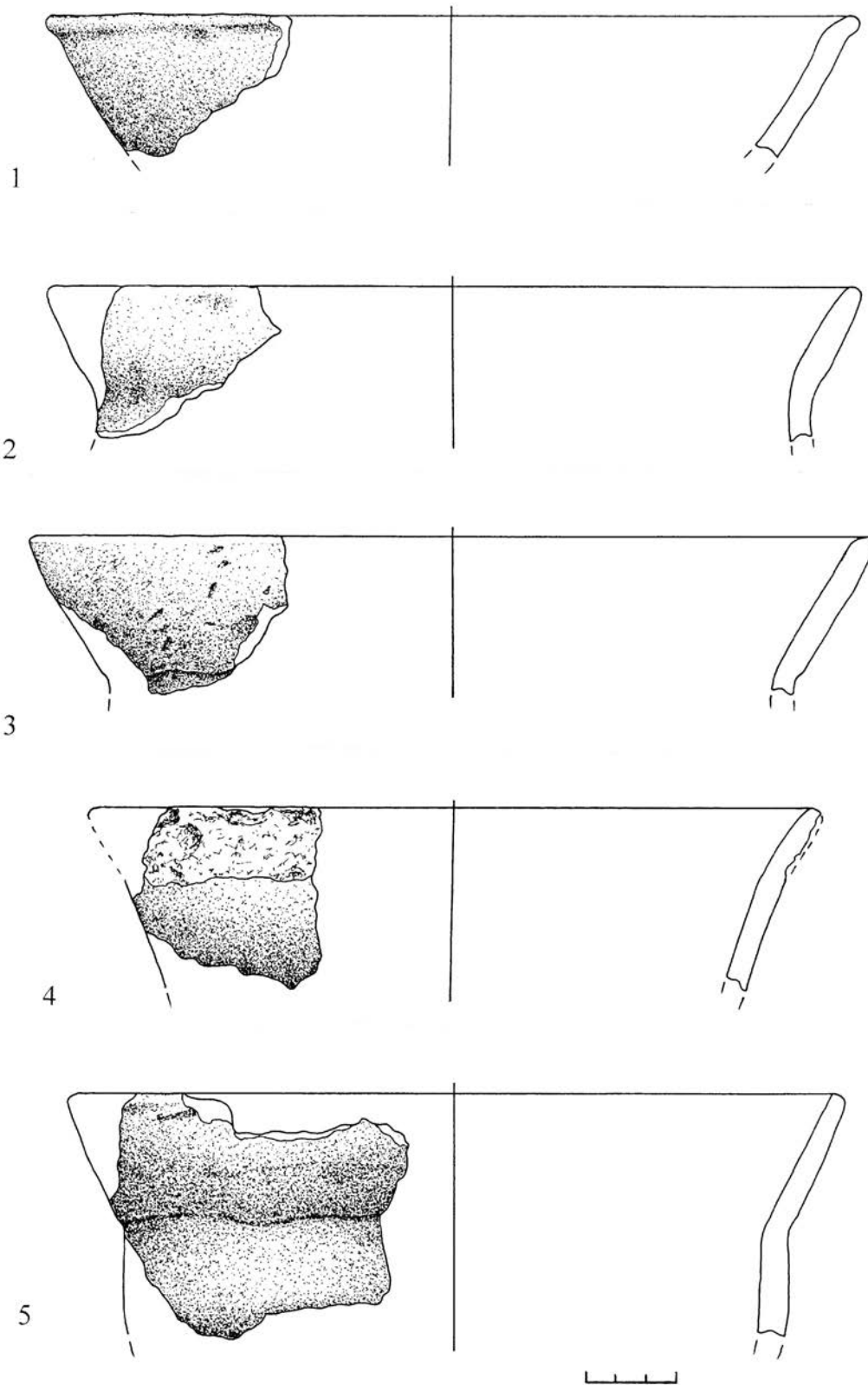


Fig. 3. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

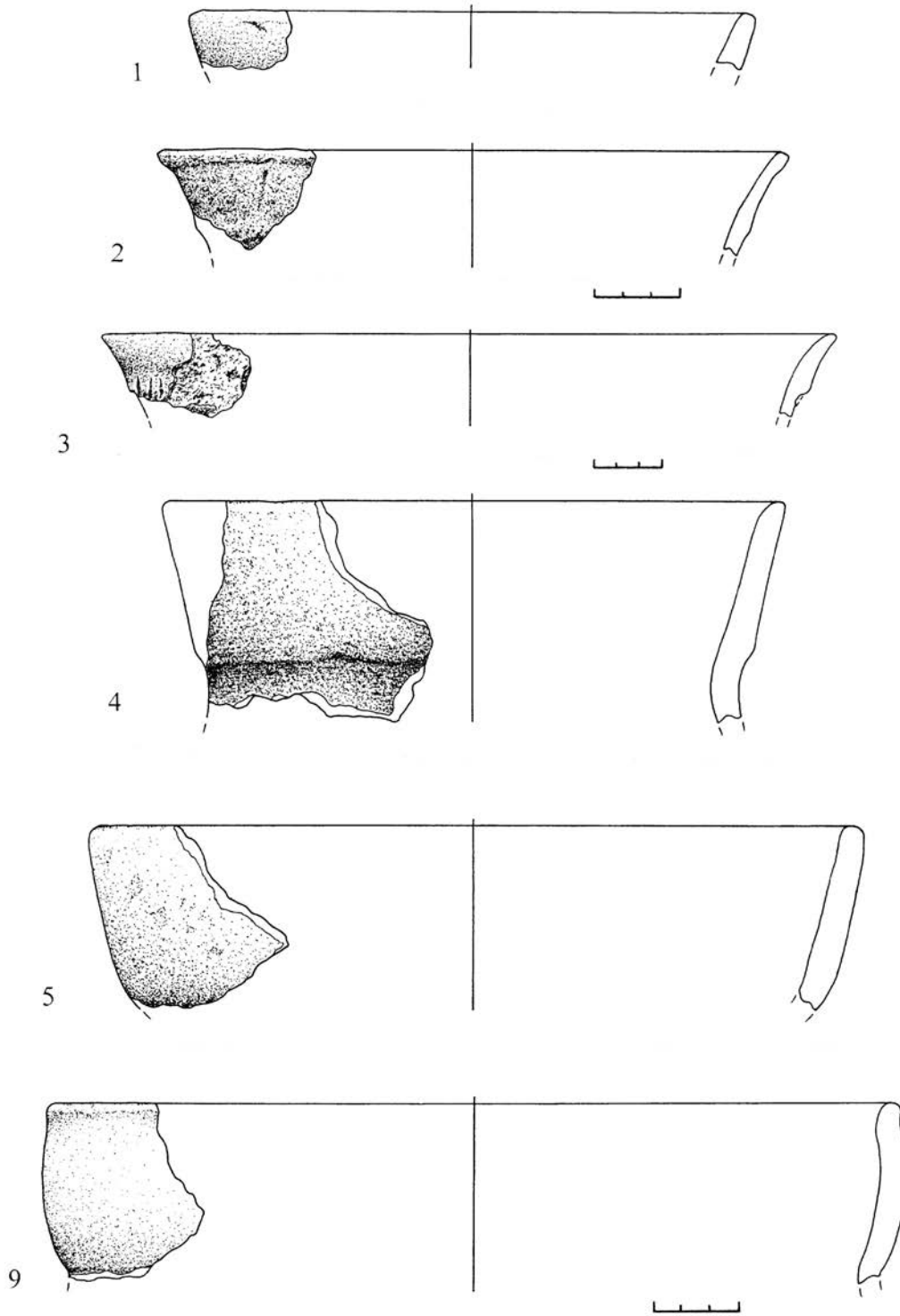


Fig. 4. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

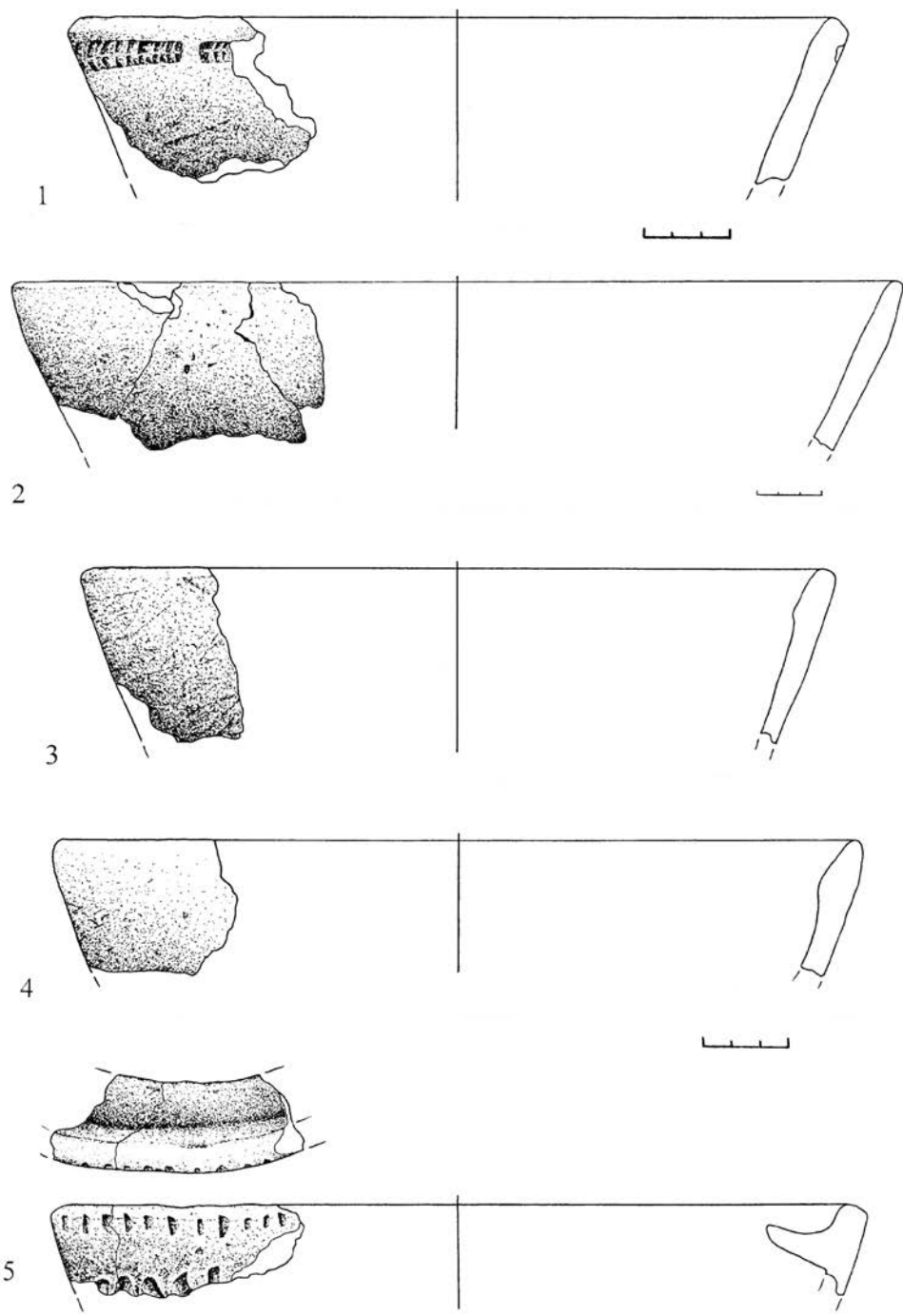


Fig. 5. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

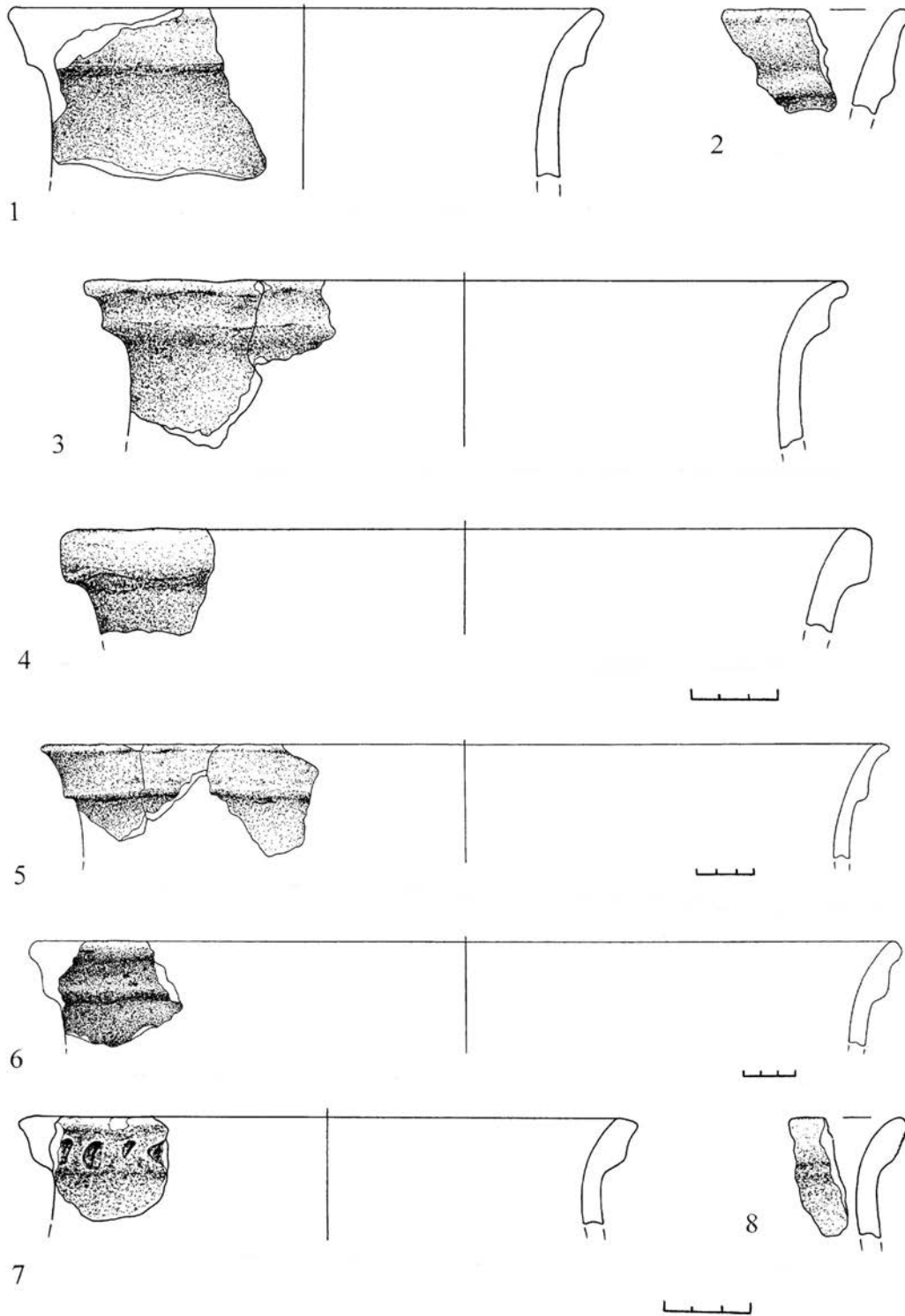


Fig. 6. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

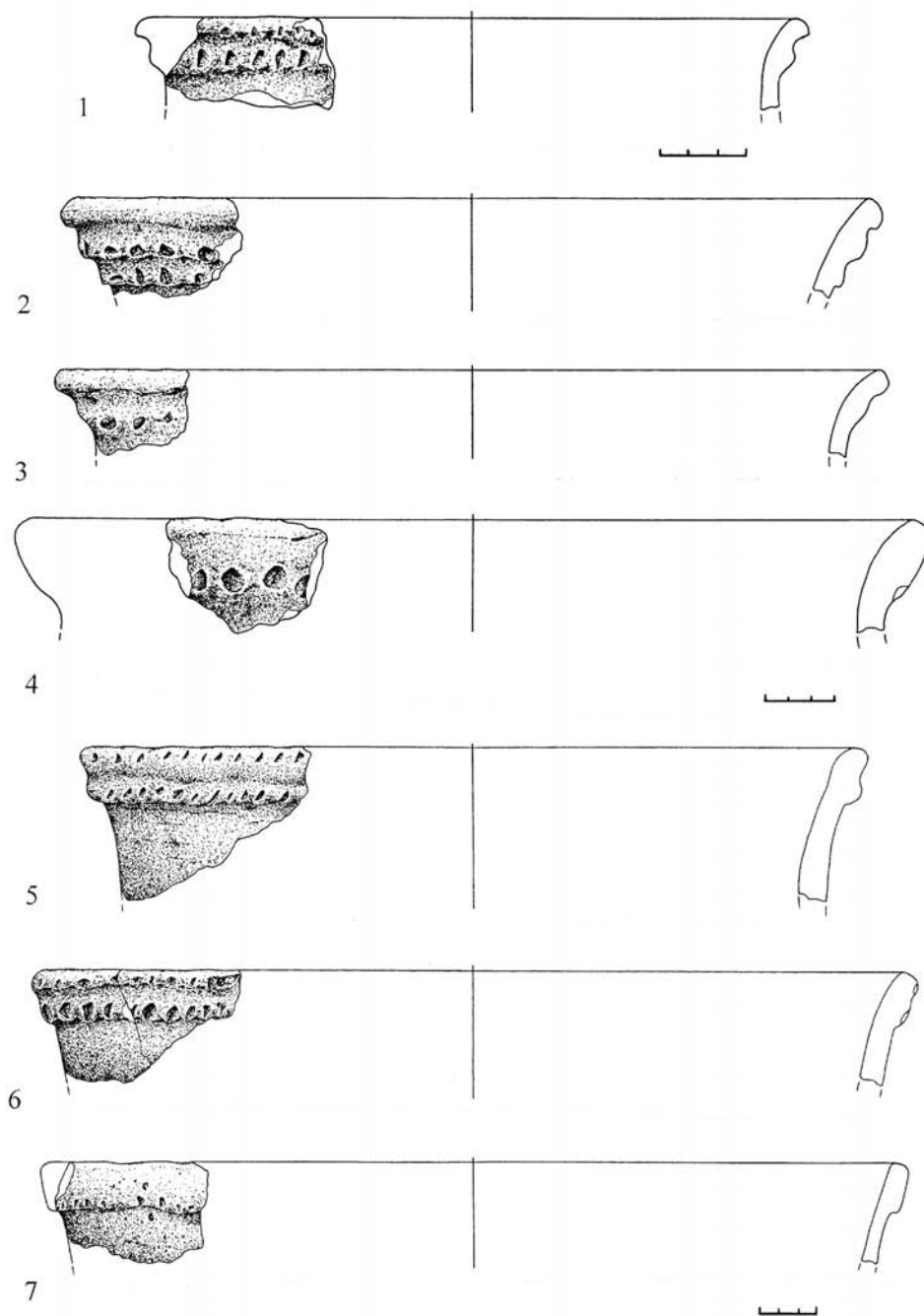

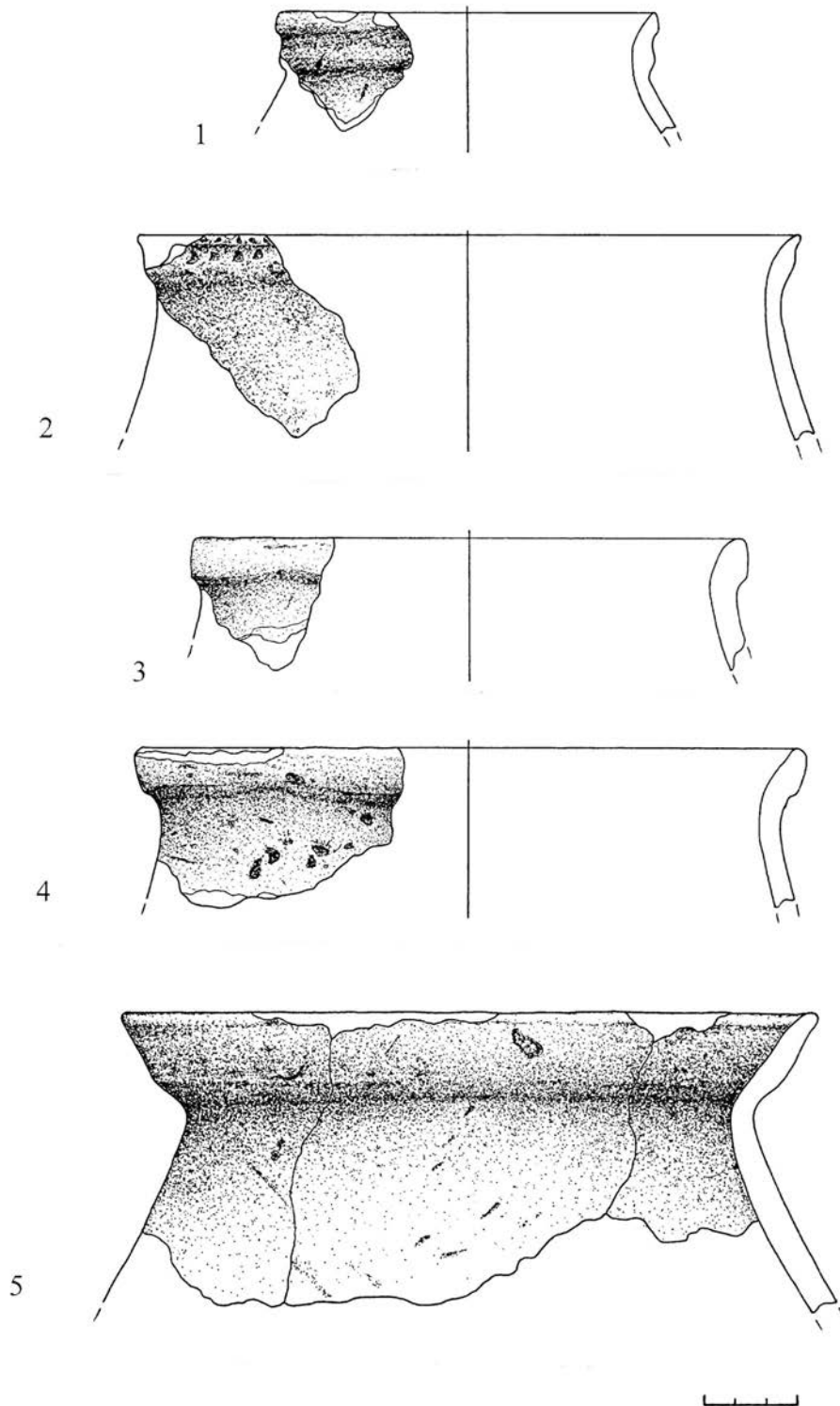


Fig. 8. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

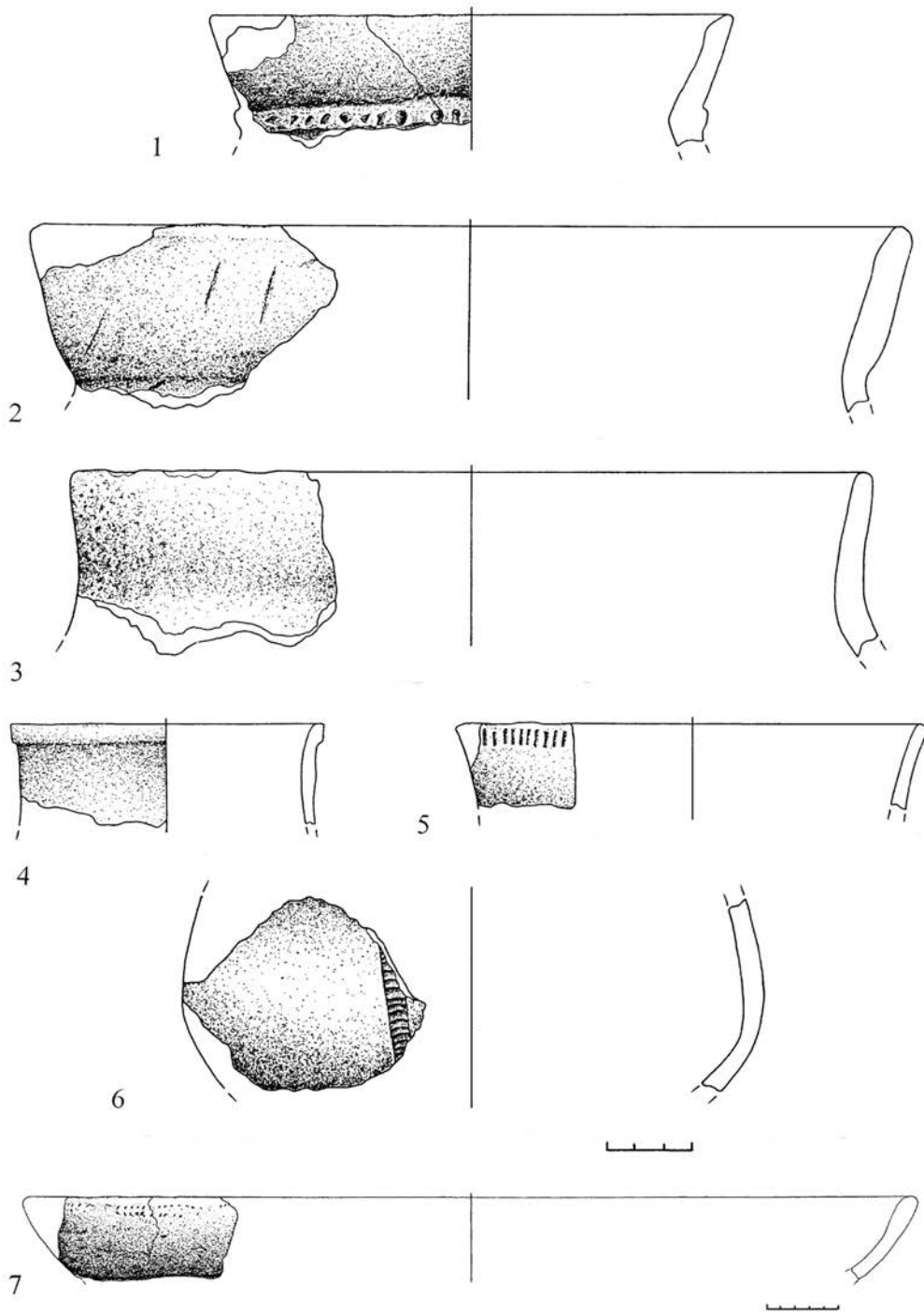


Fig. 9. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

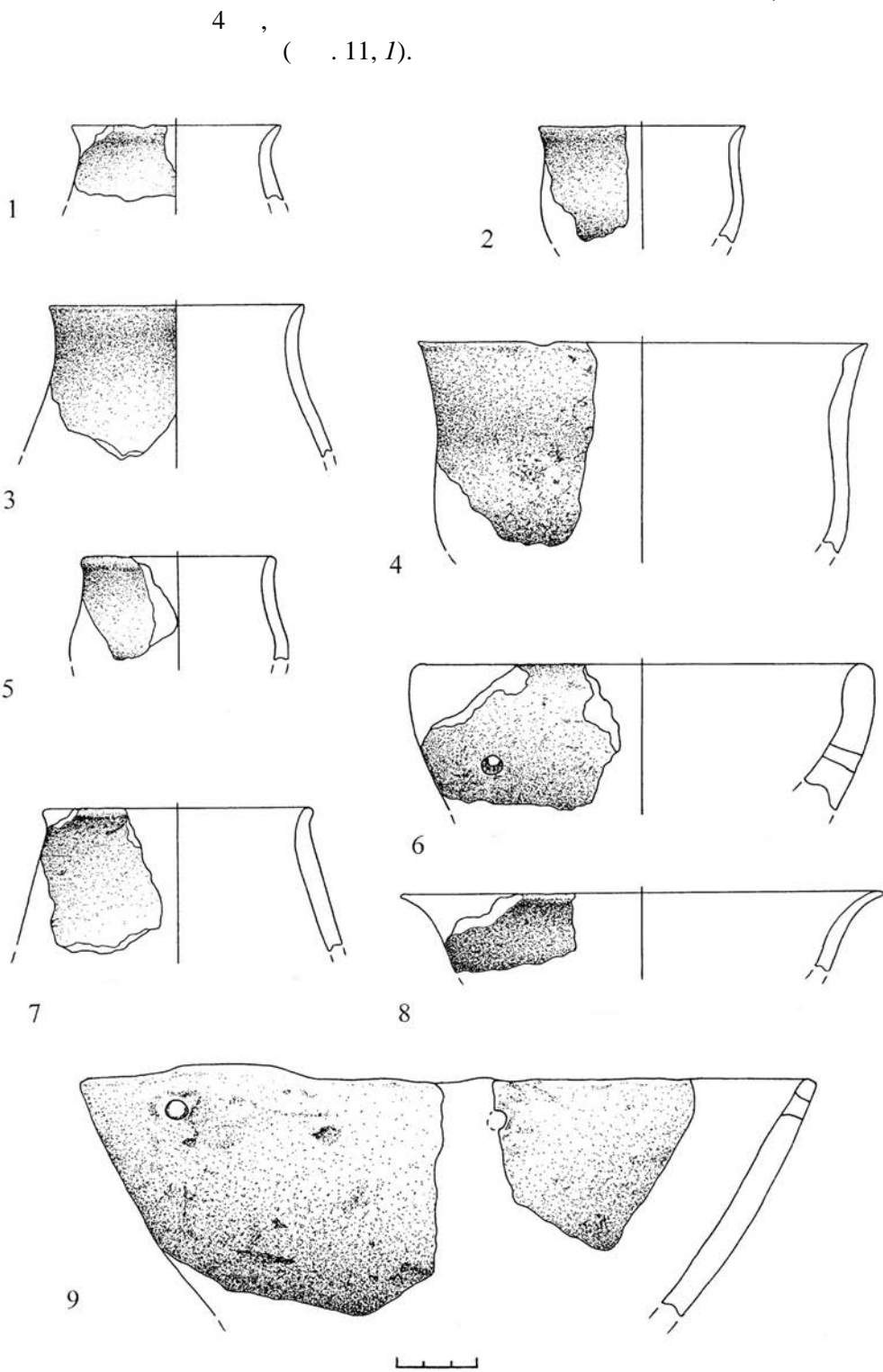


Fig. 10. Vynnyky-Lysivka – 1963. Ceramic.

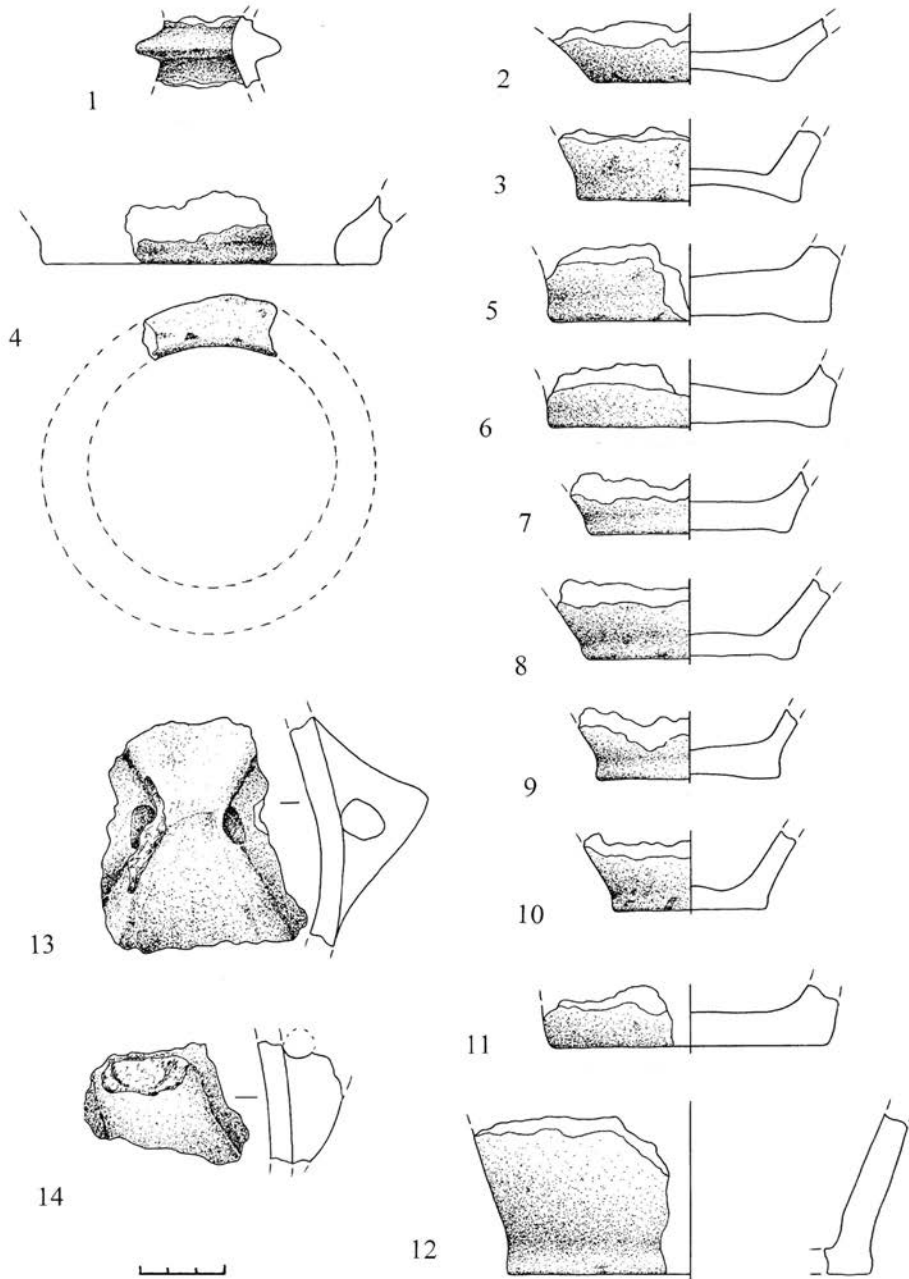


Fig. 11. Vynnyky-Lysivka - 1963. Ceramic.

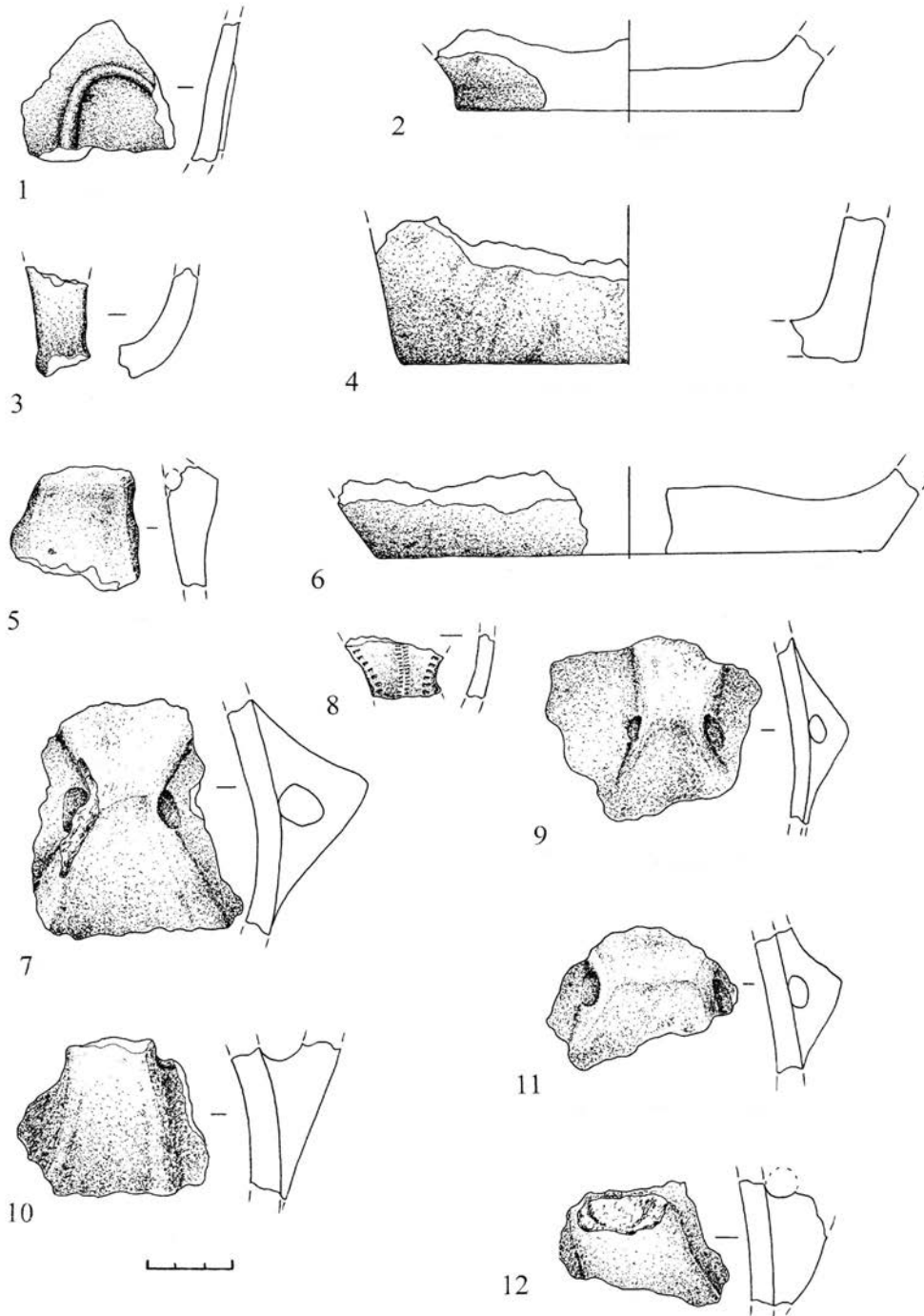

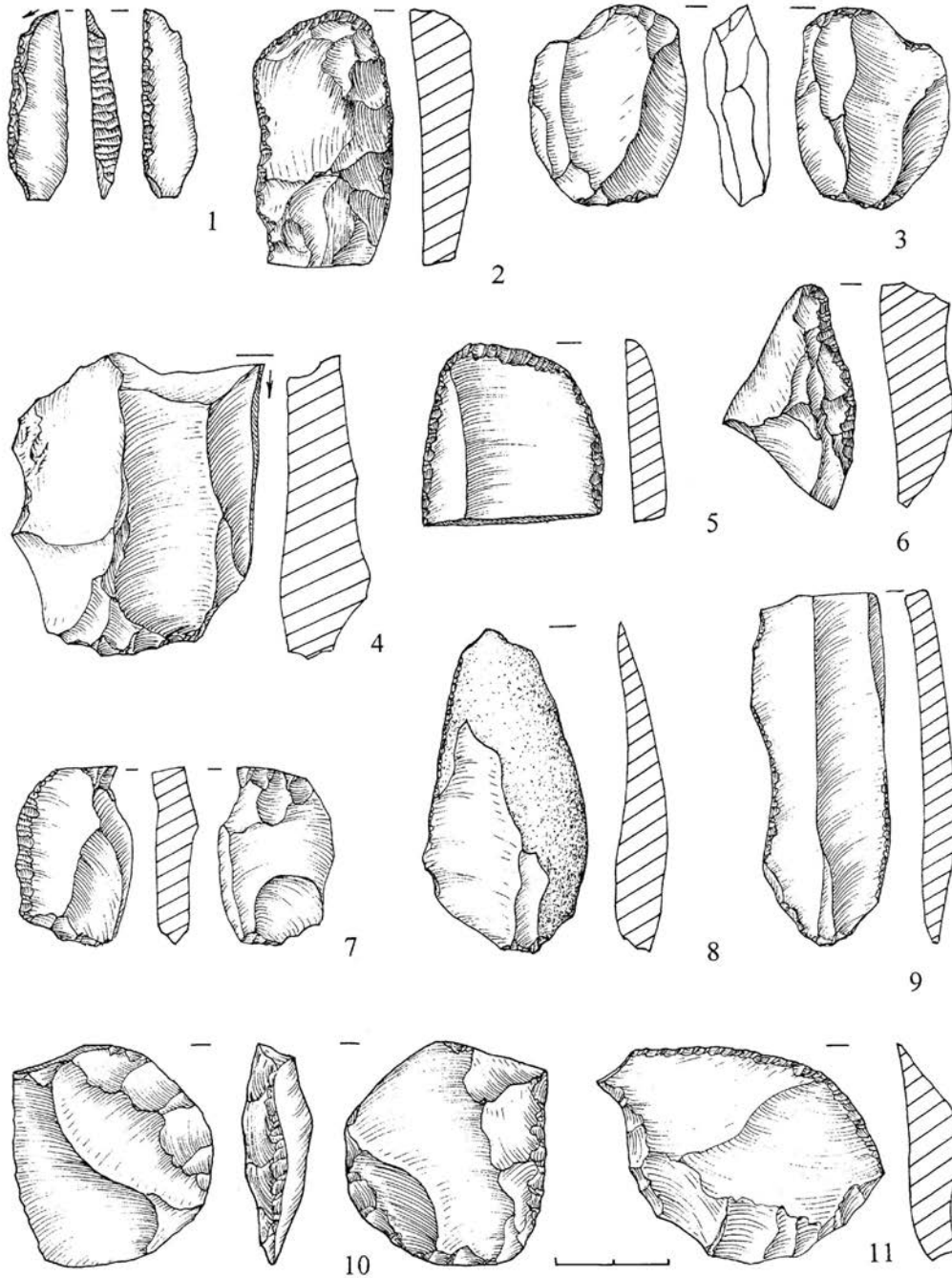

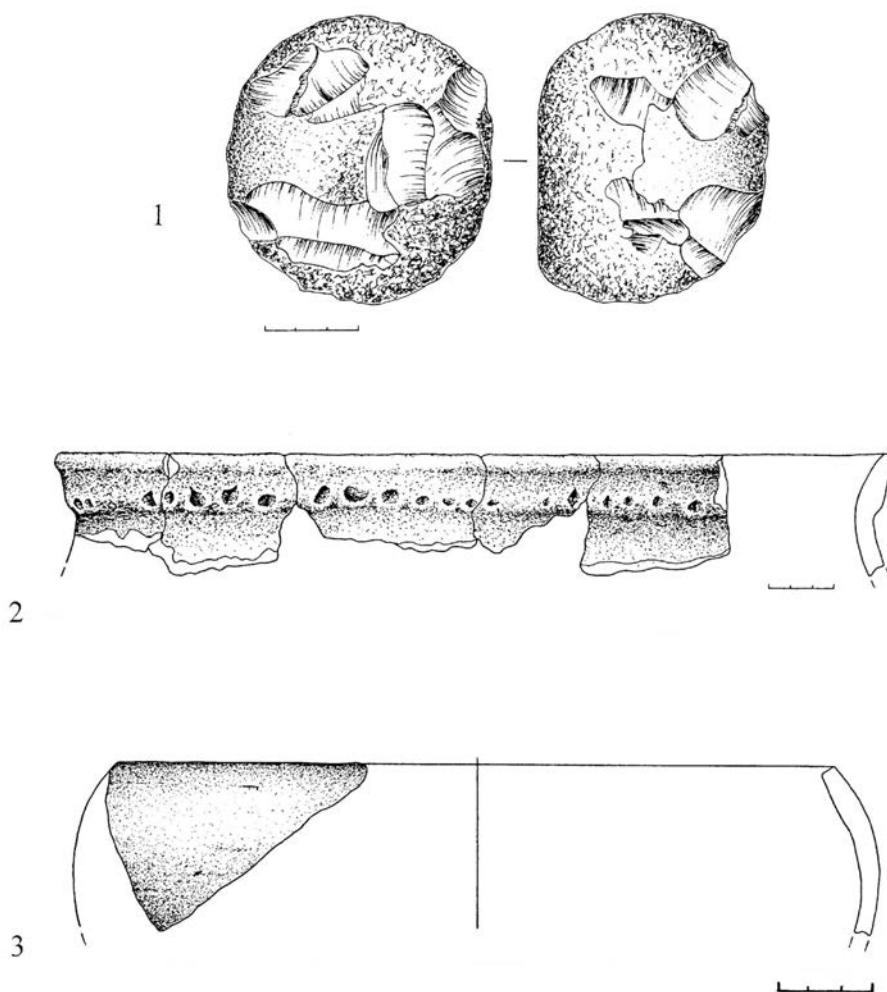
